SUBJECT: Control of Duplicating Equipment and Supplies
TO : Deputy Chief of Staff, Establishment Section

1. It has recently been drawn to the attention of this Department that certain of the Sub-Commissions, Staff Sections, etc., of this Headquarters, have drawn for their own use, and are operating duplicating equipment.

2. a. The position with regard both to equipment proper and to expendable supplies therefor is not sound. Many items of supply, particularly on the British side (which represents the bulk of the equipment on hand) are critical items, particularly ink.

b. This situation is not improvised by the existence of a number of consuming offices, since any efforts made by this office to control wastage in paper, ink, etc., are necessarily of no avail when other consumers of the same supplies, drawing from the same sources, make no such effort, and, in effect, receive favored treatment.

c. The present situation has resulted, on several occasions when other offices holding duplicating equipment have found themselves unable to cope with their own work, (either through mechanical difficulties or the excessive volume of work piled up) in demand for work on a priority basis which cannot be considered reasonable, when coming from offices holding organic duplicating equipment, or fair to other activities of the Commission, which are wholly dependent on this Department for their duplicating requirements.

3. It is recommended, therefore, that the Sections holding such British equipment, Transportation Sub-Commission, Displaced Persons and Repatriation Sub-Commission, with the exception of the U.C. British Detachment, be required to turn it in, and that this Department, accordingly, be made responsible for the production of such work.
