MEMORANDUM FOR: Executive Commissioner, Hq. ACC

1. I have informed the Undersecretary of the Presidency of the Council of Ministers, Sig. Penatca, that Ministerial Undersecretaries now in Rome may now be permitted to enter their respective Ministries. Their functions will be limited to personnel reorganization, "house-keeping", and related organizational problems in order that when the government is transferred from Salerno to Rome, the Ministries will be set up and ready to function. In the meantime, the Government will continue to operate in Salerno.
