1. It is forbidden for Allied Military personnel to live in private houses, hotels or premises not under military control in Rome Area Allied Command, and no private billeting arrangements will be made with the civilian population.

2. Arrangements for the billeting of Allied Military personnel on temporary duty or in transit will be made only by the Billeting Officer, Rome Area Allied Command or 52 Town Major, Rome, except where arrangements are made for such personnel to live with units located in Rome Area Allied Command.

3. Leave personnel will live only in the Rest Center, Rest Camp or Military Hotel to which they have been assigned for the period of their leave in Rome.

The established policy, heroby reiterated, which governs the operation of RAAC controlled hotels, viz; Ambasciatori, San Giorgio and Atlantico, is as follows:

- Civilians as guests are not permitted.
- Female personnel commissioned in the armed services, American Red Cross, USO and Allied equivalents thereof, may be extended mess and bar privileges only when accompanied by officers duly registered at or holding mess membership in the hotel concerned.
- Female guests are restricted to lobbies and public reception rooms only.

SUBJECT: Admission of Officers of the Comando
Genio Militare to Requisitioned Premises.

TO : (See distribution)

1. The department of the Italian Government responsible for assessing rentals of requisitioned property is the Comando Genio Militare whose officers visit the various requisitioned premises for this purpose.

2. In spite of the fact that these officers are furnished with passes issued from this Headquarters, some units have refused them entry to their premises.

3. This obstruction will cease forthwith as it is contributing to delay in the carrying out of the duties of the Comando Genio Militare. Where any such refusal is made without good reason being given, a report is being made to this Headquarters as to the identity of the unit concerned and the circumstances of the case.

Subject: Private Rental of Property and Motor Transport.

To : See Distribution.

1. Reference letter, this Hq, AG 600, dated 21 June 1944, Subject: "Requisition of Civilian Property".

2. Numerous cases are still arising of Allied Officers making private arrangements with Italian civilians to rent apartments or villas in and around the City of Rome. Similar private arrangements are being made in connection with motor transport.

3. This procedure is resulting in increasing the difficulties in obtaining properties and motor transport by requisition as the Italian civil population naturally prefer to keep their property free from requisitioning if they have grounds for believing that they can rent it to individual Officers, and obtain immediate payment.

4. In no circumstances will Officers enter into private agreements with civilians for the rental of properties or motor transport without first making application to ROME ALLIED AREA COMMAND (Real Estate Section in the case of property, G-4 Branch in the case of motor transport), and obtaining the necessary permission. Such permission will be given only in special cases.
