1. Reference your 7/AB of 13 June 46.

The statement regarding E.G.L.I. was made in the hope that it may have been of some assistance in tracing the missing files, and was written before we had received Brig. Dunlop's letter LOMB/CLO/1 of 9 May 46 in which he explained that Property Control files had in fact been transferred to the Rome Office in November last.

I believe it is correct to say, however that E.G.E.L.I. existed under the Fascist Regime and was concerned in the management of all foreign property confiscated by the Italian Government at the outbreak of war. They should therefore be in possession of their own files on the six British and three French Nationals mentioned in your letter of 8 April 46, 7/AB.

They may also have correspondence with Allied Commission on the same subject.

It is clear from the statement of the Verona Agents that they have never had any AC files transferred to them.

The statement regarding S.G.L.I. was made in the hope that it may have been of some assistance in tracing the missing files, and was written before we had received Brig. Dunlop's letter LOMB/CLC/1 of 9 May 46 in which he explained that Property Control files had in fact been transferred to the Rome Office in November last.

I believe it is correct to say, however that S.G.E.L.I. existed under the Fascist Regime and was concerned in the management of all foreign property confiscated by the Italian Government at the outbreak of war. To avoid any further misunderstanding, I must explain that this Liaison Group office has no responsibility for the disposal of Region XII files.

This Office opened up as a completely separate organisation and only took certain administrative files with it.

The disposal of Region files was in the hands of the Region Staff, none of whom are now available at this Office, and the dispatch of these files, took place at Padua, not here.

I am therefore unable to explain the whereabouts of files listed as not received, but I am endeavouring to obtain receipts from outside organisations who are known to have received Region files.

2. A thorough search has been made at this H.Q. for the 58 missing files mentioned in your letter, but without success.
3. All personnel i/c of Archives A.M.G. Liguria Region have left the H.Q. and can consequently give no clues.
4. It would appear that LUCCA APUANIA Province was formerly a part of TOSCANY Region, and it is suggested that the 32 files of that Province were held by TOSCANY Regional H.Q.
5. The 26 files pertaining to A.M.G. Liguria Region are most certainly not at this H.Q. and it can only be assumed that the N.C.O. i/c of Archives, A.M.G. Liguria Region has placed them inadvertently in the wrong box or has confused the lists of files submitted.
6. It is greatly regretted that this H.Q. can be of so little assistance in the matter.

I telephoned Captain AYLING (AFHQ Records) this afternoon who stated that the question of the Memorandum and its micro-filming are being represented amongst other matters at WASHINGTON by Col. JACKMAN.

He is expected to return on January 1st, when a ruling upon these subjects can be given. In the meantime they are acknowledging our letter.

I had visited Mr. Angus MALCOLM (British Embassy) earlier in the day and explained our position.

Whilst not expecting much practical difficulty in the idea of taking Archives Staff under their wing, (apart from the question of accommodation in Rome) he suggested that we should first obtain the agreement of AFHQ as to future policy.

I later telephoned him what Captain Ayling had said and he agreed that 'the ball was with us'.

I called on the American Embassy and, at Mr. Divenuti's suggestion, contacted Mr. AINSWORTH. He was of the same opinion as to the future of Archives and promised to inform Mr. Wesley JONES (Pol.Ad.) how things stand with Property Control.

PROPERTY CONTROL. British "case" files for Region IV (Rome) were handed to Lt.Col. LAIBBY this afternoon and receipts obtained.

American "cases" are ready and will be accepted by Mr. Ainsworth when a question in their internal policy has been settled.

French Embassy (M. GABRIEL, Attache Commercial) will be contacted this week.

I will telephone Captain AYLING again next Tuesday (Jan 1.) re Col. JACKMAN's return.
