SUBJECT: Postal Money Orders or Personal Transfer Accounts.

TO : All Personnel of this Regiment.

1. Circular No.2, Headquarters MPOUSA, 6 January 1947, is quoted for the information and strict compliance of all concerned:

"1. Each purchase of a Postal Money Order and/or request for Personal Transfer Account service by personnel authorized by existing Theater directives to purchase postal money orders at an Army Post Office or to use Personal Transfer Account service, will be accompanied by a certificate in the form shown as Annex 1 hereto, properly completed and signed by the purchaser and purchaser's immediate commanding officer. Commissioned officers may certify their own forms as directed on the form.

"2. Money orders or Personal Transfer Account requests may not be made out for an amount exceeding that authorized by the certificate and money orders must be made payable to an individual or firm within the United States or its possessions, enveloped and mailed in the APO at the time of purchase, by APO personnel who write the order. Once mailed as herein provided the return of the money orders to this Theater is prohibited and no money order issued in the Theater will be cashed by any APO or by any Army Disbursing Officer within the Theater. No certificate will be necessary where Personal Transfer Account service is requested and the money therefor is deducted from the pay of the individual at the moment of drawing pay. This directive will be strictly enforced by the Commanding Officer of the APO and by all Disbursing Officers within the Theater and any deviation therefrom by any individual concerned will be punished by disciplinary action.

"3. The original purchase certificate will be retained by the APO and/or Disbursing Officer until the end of each month and then will be returned to the commanding officer of each purchaser for verification, e.g., check against the commanding officer's retained duplicate copy, and will be returned within 24 hours of receipt thereof to the proper APO and/or Disbursing Officer with appropriate comments. The APO and/or Disbursing Officer will, thereafter, forward certificates which disclose that purchaser has drawn money orders or has used the Personal Transfer Account service in excess of his pay and allowances, less deductions, to the Provost Marshal of the Major Command in whose area the purchaser is located. The Provost Marshal will thereupon make a complete investigation, the report of which will be forwarded to the Major Commander of the individual concerned. The Major Commander, upon receipt of such report, will take appropriate disciplinary or other action and will furnish a monthly consolidated report to this headquarters listing the name, rank, organization and action taken against each individual reported. A copy of the consolidated report will be forwarded to the Theater Provost Marshal.

TO : All Personnel of this Regiment.

1. Circular No.2, Headquarters HTOUSA, 6 January 1947, is quoted for the information and strict compliance of all concerned:

"1. Each purchase of a Postal Money Order and/or request for Personal Transfer Account service by personnel authorized by existing Theater directives to purchase postal money orders at an Army Post Office or to use Personal Transfer Account service, will be accompanied by a certificate in the form shown as Annex 1 hereto, properly completed and signed by the purchaser and purchaser's immediate commanding officer. Commissioned officers may certify their own forms as directed on the form.

"2. Money orders or Personal Transfer Account requests may not be made out for an amount exceeding that authorized by the certificate and money orders must be made payable to an individual or firm within the United States or its possessions, enveloped and mailed in the APO at the time of purchase, by APO personnel who write the order. Once mailed as herein provided the return of the money orders to this Theater is prohibited and no money order issued in the Theater will be cashed by any APO or by any Army Disbursing Officer within the Theater. No certificate will be necessary where Personal Transfer Account service is requested and the money therefor is deducted from the pay of the individual at the moment of drawing pay. This directive will be strictly enforced by the Commanding Officer of the APO and by all Disbursing Officers within the Theater and any deviation therefrom by any individual concerned will be punished by disciplinary action.

"3. The original purchase certificate will be retained by the APO and/or Disbursing Officer until the end of each month and then will be returned to the commanding officer of each purchaser for verification, e.g., check against the commanding officer's retained duplicate copy, and will be returned within 24 hours of receipt thereof to the proper APO and/or Disbursing Officer with appropriate comments. The APO and/or Disbursing Officer will, thereafter, forward certificates which disclose that purchaser has drawn money orders or has used the Personal Transfer Account service in excess of his pay and allowances, less deductions, to the Provost Marshal of the Major Command in whose area the purchaser is located. The Provost Marshal will thereupon make a complete investigation, the report of which will be forwarded to the Major Commander of the individual concerned. The Major Commander, upon receipt of such report, will take appropriate disciplinary or other action and will furnish a monthly consolidated report to this headquarters listing the name, rank, organization and action taken against each individual reported. A copy of the consolidated report will be forwarded to the Theater Provost Marshal.

"4. No exception to any of the policies herein provided will be granted except upon written authorization of the Major Commander concerned.

VI. USE OF DOLLAR INSTRUMENTS.

"1. The use or exchange of dollar instruments to acquire any currency or in payment for goods or services by any person subject to military law is prohibited except for the cashing of dollar instruments by Army Disbursing Officers authorized by Paragraph 5, MFCUSA Circular 146, dated 10 September 1946.

"2. The violation of this directive by any person subject to military law will be punished by disciplinary action. No exception to the directive set forth in paragraph 1 will be granted without written authority from the Major Commander concerned.

"3. The provisions of paragraphs 1 and 2 do not apply, to the use or exchange of dollar instruments in Greece, Yugoslavia, Albania and Bulgaria where the use of United States dollar currency by military personnel is authorized."

2. Officers will be procure forms at the Adjutant's Office when it is desired to purchase money orders or PTA's. TM will procure from the Headquarters Company orderly room.

MEMORANDUM

TO : All concerned

IMMUNIZATION

Military personnel are reminded of the importance of maintaining immunization of Dependents, as well as Army Personnel. The 306th Station Hospital will give immunization Mondays and Fridays from 1300 to 1600 hours. The following are requirements for initial immunization and maintenance.

SMALLPOX : Vaccination once yearly

TYPHOID, PARATYPHOID : 3 injections at intervals of one week and 1 injection yearly thereafter.

TYPHUS : 2 injections at intervals of one week and 1 injection every 6 months thereafter.

TETANUS : 3 injections at intervals of 3 weeks, one injection 1 year afterward. This is not required for dependents.

YELLOW FEVER, PLAGUE, CHOLERA, INFLUENZA: Immunizations are given only on special occasions, when troops enter certain geographical zones. Influenza vaccine is not now available.

RABIES (HYDROPHOBIA) : This disease is very prevalent in the Mediterranean. Dogs, cats, and other pets should be immunized by a veterinarian. This material is not usually available thru military sources, as regulations prohibit such animals around Military Organization Areas.

DIPHTHERIA : For personnel under age of 35.
Four injections as follows:
First ---
Second After 48 hours
Third After 3 weeks
Fourth After 3 weeks

Subsequent to 3 April 1946 all replacements to this theater under the age of 35 - are immunized for Diphtheria in the Z.I. Records on replacements should be checked and if Diphtheria Immunization is incomplete same should be completed.

SUBJECT: Internal Security

TO : All occupants of the Allied Commission Building

1. During the past month there have been numerous incidents of thefts and unwarranted entrance in the Allied Commission offices at night and on Wednesday and Saturday afternoon and Sundays. On the night of 5-6 October entrance was made into a room on the ground floor and the thief was apprehended on Via Veneto with one typewriter, and investigation showed that he had two more typewriters on the window sill ready for his return trip. His statement in part was: "I saw the window open and it gave me the idea to enter the building and see what I could steal."

2. The present system of internal security is definitely unsatisfactory. There are no Military Police, either British or American, available to assist in this duty, hence the following measures will be instituted effective at 0800 hours, 21 October 1946.

a. All outside doors of Allied Commission building except the main door (glass) will be locked at 1815 hours each evening; at 1300 hours on Wednesday and Saturday and all day Sunday and will remain locked until 0800 hours the following morning.

b. The main door (glass) will be locked at 1900 hours each evening at 1400 hours on Wednesdays and Saturdays and will remain locked on Sundays. It will be necessary for any officer who has essential business to enter the building during the time the main door is locked, to contact the Duty Officer, (Phone No. 433) or by bell or main door to admit him at the main door. The key to the main door will be retained in the possession of the Duty Officer, who will personally admit visitors to the building. This responsibility will NOT be delegated. No civilians and no EM or OR's will be permitted to enter the building during the hours the main door is locked unless accompanied by a British or American Officer, except those assigned to definite duty in the building, such as Message Center, telephone switchboard, etc. They will have a written pass signed by the Director of the Division for which they work, and will be checked in and out by the Duty Officer.

c. No person will be permitted to remove any article from the building without a signed authority therefor from the Camp Commandant (A), or the Adjutant, 7106th Regiment. (The custom of taking Government typewriters from this building for night work at billets, is hereby discontinued).

d. The old fire regulations requiring that offices be left unlocked are herewith rescinded. Each Division may lock the doors of their offices. However all windows will be closed and locked at the end of the day. Desks will be kept locked during non-duty hours. This is the responsibility of the personnel concerned. When doors are locked necessary arrangements will be made for admitting of cleaning personnel to clean offices by divisions.

e. The post of the Duty Officer will be in the vicinity of

the main door during his duty hours and it will be his responsibility to see that the Italian Carabinieri understand and thoroughly carry out these instructions. He will, also, during his tour of duty, by personal inspection, insure that the GCHR who patrol the different floors in the building, are performing their duties properly.

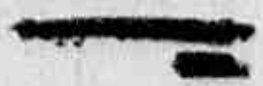

TO : Unit Commanders, each Unit this Command.

1. In order to curtail violations of current MTOUSA directives and theft of U.S. Army vehicles, the following instructions will be put into operation without delay:

a. Any Italian civilian driver of a U.S. Government vehicle who leaves his vehicle unattended while on duty, will be discharged and dropped from the payroll immediately.

b. Any Italian civilian driver of a U.S. Government vehicle who leaves his vehicle unattended while on duty, and through such negligence and disobedience of orders, caused said vehicle to be stolen, will be discharged and dropped from the payroll, and will be held in confinement pending trial by the Italian court.

c. Any American driver of a U.S. Government vehicle who leaves his vehicle unattended while on duty will be subject to disciplinary action.

d. Report of Survey will be initiated by the Unit Commander to cover the loss of a vehicle or parts of a vehicle that are stolen due to such negligence as leaving the vehicle unattended.

e. Any U.S. Government vehicle found unattended will be impounded by the Military Police, and will not be released until the day following the impoundment.

f. Each Unit Commander in Rome Area will be held responsible for the action of his drivers.



2. Whilst I have every sympathy for your request you will, I am sure, appreciate that once one exception is made it is very difficult to refuse similar requests from others, which makes it almost impossible for those responsible to keep up the duty roster.

3. I gather that in the past officers of the Establishment Section were, for reasons that are not clear, exempted from doing night duty. With our rapidly diminishing numbers things are being tightened up and Establishment officers, even as others, now take on this duty.

4. I am fully aware of the extra and valuable work you are doing and have done on holidays, Christmas, New Year, Sundays, etc., as we both frequently meet on these occasions in the building, and take this opportunity of thanking you for all you are doing.
