1. Confirming conversation (Major Audas/Harrison), since these files appear to be part of one or more series and not from a Region, procedure is now altered as regards Executive Commissioner Memo No.7, para 9, in connection with all AC Headquarters files and is as follows:-

- (a) In order to assess and arrange in continuity the Headquarters Files in their series for Microfilming, a "Master List" (in triplicate) is prepared from the present Office Lists by Archives Typing Pool of ALL files of that Branch or Section whether current or archived.
- (b) One copy is held by the Branch and two by Archives, all bearing a coloured signal denoting the present location of the files (Blue - Branch, Red - Records in Archives).
