The following note is not intended to be taken as a precise or complete history of the internal organization of the Civil Affairs Branch, A.C.C. The sole purpose of the note is to explain, from the point of view of Archives, the storage arrangements of the files of A.M.G. 15 Army Group.

In early 1944, A.M.G. 15 Army Group was absorbed into A.C.C. The main executive portion of A.M.G. 15 Army Group was merged into the Civil Affairs Branch of the A.C.C. and certain main executive functions were exercised by the Regional Control and Military Government A.C. & M.G.) Section of the Civil Affairs Branch.

The main executive files of A.M.G. 15 Army Group were retained for a time by the A.C. & M.G. Section, who subsequently sent them to Archives more or less intact. These files now constitute Archive Group E.I.

The remaining files of A.M.G. 15 Army Group were dispersed amongst the appropriate sub-commissions of A.C.C.. These files are arranged by Archives according to the sub-commission functionally concerned with the subject matter, but the fact that the files originated with A.M.G. 15 Army Group is made clear by a separate sub-division in the records of the sub-commission concerned.
