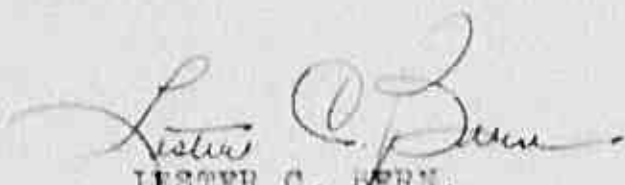

MEMORANDUM TO: Major White, Administrative Section

I am answering your note to Captain Collins, as Collins is away on a swing around the circuit. I am informed that the proper method to obtain the necessary supplies for reorganization of your files is to requisition them from your supply Officer at Salerno. I am told that the supply Officer there should consolidate the requisitions and submit them to the G-4 at this Headquarters. I am also told that it is not necessary for your supply officer to get his supplies exclusively from this Headquarters. He is permitted to deal with other agencies if he so desires. Such material as the punch requested by Colonel Spicer is not available in supply, and therefore may be purchased. I do not know whether you have a purchasing officer in Salerno. If you do not, I suggest that you submit a request to the purchasing officer at this Headquarters.

I will admit that I was a little taken aback by the number of file covers requested. Of course it is not necessary in reorganizing files to throw away all the old covers in order to use all new covers; in fact, under present conditions that cannot be done. Files of course should use the least number of folders possible; that is, divisions should be kept to a minimum. The practice of opening a new file for every new shade of color on a subject should be discouraged. Multiplicity of filing envelopes with only two or three papers in each envelope has been very common in some of the files which have been turned over to Archives. These are wasteful of folders and difficult to handle. If sufficient two-hole fasteners cannot be obtained by supply for your requirements, I would suggest that they be used as far as possible and the extension of their use provided for on a gradual basis as more become available. This will require, of course, periodically renewed requisitions. I might call your attention to the use of split tacks such as bind the Rear Headquarters telephone directory. In the absence of regular two-hole fasteners these would be very satisfactory for folders which are not too bulky.
