INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE SUB-COMMISSION
and Divisions.

The original Industry and Commerce Sub-Commission has experienced several changes in its constitution.

It absorbed the Fuel Sub-Commission, which at one time had a separate existence. The original

Industry and Commerce sub-Commission was later split into two - Industry sub-Commission and Commerce sub-Commission.

The first batch of files to be received by Archives was sent in by the Industry and Commerce sub-Commission. This batch included a few of the files of the old Fuel sub-Commission. At a later date, and subsequent to the splitting of the I. & C. sub-Commission, the new Commerce sub-Commission sent to Archives another batch of files, including further files of the old Fuel sub-Commission, and additional files of the old I. & C. sub-Commission.

It is understood that the Commerce sub-Commission is continuing to use the same block of file numbers as that originally allocated to the old I. & C. sub-Commission. The Industry sub-Commission took over such files of the old I. & C. sub-Commission as pertained to its work, and have created a new filing system of their own. (Sect. 6000)

For archive purposes, it has been considered desirable and convenient to include in one archive group (N) the files of the old I. & C. sub-Commission, the old Fuel sub-Commission, and of the newly created Industry sub-Commission and Commerce sub-Commission, (and, of course, their sub-divisions).
