Subject: AMG Files and papers from Catania, Lampedusa, Pantellaria.
Date: 3 June 1946

1. As desired by you the above papers will be despatched to you by fastest possible means. They are too heavy for ordinary aeroplane mail and will therefore be despatched by the through train Palermo-Rome; you will be notified by signal of despatch and expected time of arrival.
2. As I am the only Allied military personnel here I am unable to provide the guard desirable; if you object on this account to their being sent by train will you notify me by signal; I have no other means of transport.
3. The files and papers were found on my arrival on 24 May 1946 in great confusion without index, mixed up, and with many files missing apparently. With no allied staff I have been unable to put them in any good order, but am sorting them so far as is possible between duties as a Liaison Officer. File lists in triplicate follow as soon as complete.
