1. Reference your 73/165/CA of 2 Apr 44, received 5 Apr 44. The views of GSI (b), EIGHTH ARMY, have been sought with regard to the persons named in Lists "A" and "B" with the following result:

TO : Deputy Executive Commissioner, HQ ACC APO 394

1 As requested in our telephone conversation yesterday, 29 Mar 44, I attach a nominal roll of those ex prisoners of PADULA CAMP, who are now accommodated by the Italian authorities at Salerno and await dispersal.

2 All these are desirous of proceeding to areas under A&C control and your permission for them to do so is requested. The Security Officer is satisfied that it is in order for these persons to proceed.

3 As the arrival of these persons in Salerno was at very short notice, the Italian authorities were unable to secure satisfactory accommodation and their removal from their present location is a pressing necessity. May the matter therefore be treated as urgent.

TO : Deputy President, A.C.C.



The responsibility for prison administration under the Italian Government is that of the Minister of Justice while under A.M.G. and A.C.C. that responsibility is at present undertaken by the Public Safety Subcommittee.

It would be a logical, therefore, that responsibility for prisons should be transferred from Public Safety to Legal Subcommittee, but against this there are several practical reasons.

(1) The Public Safety personnel have been in touch with the prison administration now for some months and it would be a great mistake not to continue to make use of their expert services; further, it would at this late stage be a mistake to shift the Prison Division of the Public Safety Subcommittee over to the Legal Subcommittee.

(2) In practice the Prison and Police Services are more closely related than Prison and Law and it would be more convenient as a matter of internal administration to maintain the present arrangement in A.C.C.

Accordingly it is strongly recommended that prison administration should remain the responsibility of Public Safety Subcommittee.

On this footing, however, I suggest that Public Safety should be advised to send over an officer to contact the Italian Director of Prisons as soon as possible to make every necessary arrangement before the restoration of territory.

 - (c) That recruitment, organization and handling of prison officials is closely allied to police matters.

SUBJECT: Death of Stefano Impellizzeri, former resident of the United States.

TO : HQ. AMG.

1. In the course of investigation into conditions at the Penal Colony of Ustica, an island belonging to the Province of Palermo, certain information has been received regarding the death of the above-named, who apparently formerly resided in the United States and probably has next of kin there. The information is set out herein for transmission to appropriate authority in the United States.

2. An Italian citizen named SIAS Antonio, who had been confined at Ustica as an habitual criminal, reported with circumstantial detail that an American internee whom he called "Frankfort" had died in the Civic Hospital in Palermo from starvation and ill treatment at Ustica. No further information could be obtained about any one of that name.

3. An Italian citizen named SERMICOLI Ezio, who had been confined at Ustica as an habitual criminal, reported that he had known an American named Stephano Inbellizzer at Ustica, and previously in prison in Rome. He stated that Inbellizzer spoke little Italian, had lived in Oklahoma and Texas, had come to Italy in 1937, had been held two years in Genoa at the disposition of the Questura there (at which time the American Consul had interested himself in the case), had thereafter been transferred to Rome at the disposition of the Special Police, and after two years in Rome had been interned at Ustica. SERMICOLI did not know what had happened to Inbellizzer, but believed he had died after leaving Ustica.

4. The files of the Penal Colony and of the Questura of Palermo indicate that a person by the name of IMPELLIZZERI, Stefano di Giacomo, arrived in Ustica as an internee 30 January 1941, was disciplined on two occasions by solitary imprisonment for 1 month and 2 months respectively, was transferred to the Prison of Palermo and thence to the Civic Hospital of Palermo in November or December, 1942 because afflicted with chronic enterocolitis, and died there 12 January 1943. The only details of previous history or reasons for internment are contained in a copy of a letter dated 23 October 1940 from the Prefecture at Fiume to the Ministry of Interior, translation of which is annexed hereto.

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5. It will be observed that according to his statements Impellizzeri was born in Italy, fought in the American Army in the last war, and was deported from the United States in 1937.

6. Many persons died in 1942 and 1943 from malnutrition and ill treatment at Ustica, and members of the administration of the Penal Colony are being held on charges of ill treatment of civilian internees of Yugoslav citizenship.

With reference to your telegram No. 70425 page 300 of 11 October
I inform you that the above-named individual, after being deported
for unauthorized entry, reentered the Kingdom on the 13th of this
month despite the fact that he had been warned to stay out, and was
arrested by a patrol of Finance Guards on search.

Impellizzari stated that he could not enter Yugoslav territory
because he was too well known by the authorities of that state.

He stated furthermore that he was named Impellizzari and not
Impellizieri Stefano and that he was born at Alcamo the 19 May 1894
and not 28 May 1892.

He added also that his mother was named Bessi Anna and had
emigrated to New York in 1898 together with his father, who there-
after entered into a second marriage with one Rossi Hudson, procreat-
ing in 1901 a son who was a deaf-mute. Eventually he stated that
from November 1916 to 1919 he was in France, as a volunteer in the
American Army and then returned to the United States. In 1937 he was
repatriated into Italy, being twice condemned for ordinary crimes.

The Questura of Trapani, on further demand for information, ⁵⁰has
replied that there is no record of his birth at Alcamo in 1894.

Because any further effort to get rid of the self-called Impel-
lizzari across the Yugoslav boundaries is bound to be futile, by
reason of the close vigilance being maintained in these times by
those authorities, I propose that the above-named individual be re-
moved to Trapani to facilitate investigation with respect to his

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identity and that in case that such investigation is fruitless, he
be interned in a concentration camp until his personal identity
is finally established.

I transmit a copy of the new statements taken down from the
self-called Impellizzari.
