Subject: Laws Concerning Hotels.

To : Admin Sec.

1. The attached papers are passed to you as they appear to have strayed from the correct channel. The message center having (owing to the manner in which 3/6084/1 of 2 Mar was addressed) thought the Legal Sub Comm would be the appropriate branch to deal with the legal points raised.

2. To attach Legal's Comments on the case. In this connection we presume that if these powers are sought it will be from the point of view of keeping 'trade' going. It would appear therefore that the Econ Section will desire to consider para 29 before deciding whether these powers are generally desirable.

3. If such legislation is required the procedure suggested at 29 would appear to be correct. Inquiry has been made of the Italian Government and it appears that they will if requested be prepared to continue the application of these laws for the duration of the war.

4. We presume that one of the Economic Sub Commissions would approach the Italian Government as the matter does not appear to concern any of the Admin Sub Commissions.

In accordance with verbal instructions, I append hereto a list of proclamations and orders promulgated by AMG pertaining directly or indirectly to local government.

Interior Sub-Commission

1. The following proclamations and orders promulgated by AMG and pertaining directly or indirectly to local government organization and administration shall remain in full force and effect, with only such changes therein as are hereinafter indicated, when the Italian National Government assumes control for the Allied Military Government:

- (1) Proclamation No. 7: Dissolution of Fascist Organizations and Repeal of Laws (amendments will substitute the appropriate officer, agency or tribunal for the terms "Chief Civil Affairs Officer", "Allied Military Government" and "Allied Military Court" now appearing in the proclamation)
- (2) Proclamation No. 13: Legal Rights of the Italian People 17 August 1943.
- (3) General Order No. 8: Labor Relations (abolishing Fascist labor organizations and establishing Regional and Provincial Labor Offices)

2. Local government officials appointed, suspended or removed by, or under the direction or with the approval of, AMG, shall not be removed, or restored to office, as the case may be, without the approval and consent of the Allied Control Commission in each case.

3. The "Astorato Provinciale" and the "Consulta Comunale", abolished under AMG, shall not be revived or re-created. The "Deputazioni Provinciali" and the "Giunte Comunali", with such functions, powers, and duties as are now vested in them, or as to may hereafter be vested in them with the approval of the Allied Control Commission, shall be retained as agencies of provincial and communal government respectively. Additional offices, agencies or bodies of local government may be created with the approval of the Allied Control Commission.

4. That the organization set up by Allied Military Government for administration of food rationing and price control be retained until such time as an approved national organization is brought into being by the Italian Government.
