1. The following is an estimate, which is subject to confirmation of the allotment of officers to the staff of the Headquarters Commandant, Salerno, on completion of the move of the Brindisi Detachment to Salerno.

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2. Will Headquarters Commandant, Salerno, please give his views on the following:

Will an additional American Officer be required permanently as second in Command, American Detachment? If so, efforts will be made to find a suitable officer, but it is suggested that Capt. Volstad should be able to devote some of his time to such duties as you will have two officers for the organization and supervision of air and motor transport.

b. Is a full time Reception and Information Officer (See Para. 1 above) really required? If so, Headquarters Commandant, Salerno, should report to this Headquarters when Capt. Jones is expected to be fit for duty, and whether or not a replacement is required in the meanwhile.

c. Reference para. 11. above. The name of the officer finally selected (as to which Headquarters Commandant, Salerno should consult Major Doe, Brindisi Detachment) as Mess Secretary and Treasurer should be reported to this Headquarters as soon as possible. It is understood that Major Doe has agreed that Capt. Buckley would be a suitable officer for such duties and it is considered, in any event, that the officer detailed as Security Officer can easily undertake, if qualified to do so, the duties of Mess Secretary-Treasurer in addition to his Security duties. It was suggested at one time that an officer for Security duties in connection with classified documents in the offices would be required in addition to a Security Officer for general duties under the Headquarters Commandant. On reconsideration, this is not now considered necessary; one officer under the orders of the Headquarters Commandant can well perform both functions.

d. Under the organization proposed above, is a British Quartermaster or Quartermaster Sergeant considered essential?

3. Capt. Sirota (A), at present employed on duties with O.C. American Detachment, will revert to command of Property Controller as soon as possible under arrangements direct between Headquarters Commandant and Property Controller.

4. Capt. Slaughter (A), at present Acting O.C. American Detachment, Salerno, will probably be required to join the Secretariat at Salerno (See para. 5a below). If so, paragraph 4, Special Orders No. 21 Fwd., Headquarters, 2675th Regiment, Forward Echelon, Allied Control Commission, dated 27 January 1944, will require amendment.

5. The provisional organization of the Secretariat-General will be as follows:

a. At Naples.

If so, paragraph 4, Special Orders No. 21 Fwd., Headquarters, 2675th Regiment, Forward Echelon, Allied Control Commission, dated 27 January 1944, will require amendment.

6. A Secretary for independent Sub-Commissions is to be instituted. Lt. Col. Quin-Smith, at present employed at Brindisi, will be required for this post at Salerno.

7. Capt. Haslam (B), at present employed on British Army Records at Brindisi, will be required at main Headquarters, Naples to join the G-1 Staff.

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8. Will Headquarters ACC, Brindisi, please notify Headquarters Commandant, Salerno, and this Headquarters the dates on which the officers referred to in Paras 1, 5, 6 and 7 above, can arrive at Salerno and Naples to take up their new duties. This information is required as soon as possible.

9. It is not yet possible to give the organization of the AG Department at Salerno and the allotment of personnel therefor as this depends to some extent on reorganization questions now under consideration.

Subject: Move of Headquarters, ACC, Rear Party From Palermo

To : Headquarters Commandant
Allied Control Commission
Salerno

1. The First Echelon of Headquarters, ACC, Rear Party, departed Palermo 31 January at 0700 hours by Motor Convoy No. 013101-E with thirty one motor vehicles, including two motorcycles, and personnel consisting of six (6) officers and fifty eight (58) enlisted men or other ranks. The vehicles in this convoy consist of the following:

- 10 - Trucks, 1/4 ton
- 5 - Staff Cars
- 2 - Trucks, 3 ton
- 12 - Trucks, 15 cwt.
- 2 - Motorcycles

2. This convoy should arrive Salerno on 3 or 4 February and the Convoy Commander will report to your officer for further instructions.

3. All officers, enlisted men and other ranks, of the above personnel in this convoy will proceed on to Naples, with the exception of Private R. C. Jones, British, who is assigned to the Public Safety Sub-Commission and who should be retained in Salerno.

4. All motor vehicles, office furniture, office equipment and other equipment in the convoy will be dispatched to Naples, where the proper distribution will be made. In this connection, the ratio of distribution of available motor vehicles between Salerno and Naples Headquarters is now being calculated and the actual distribution of additional vehicles to Salerno will be made immediately after the arrival of the Palermo convoy in Naples.

5. B. Payment of Salaries.

Employees' salaries, including the Superintendent and Director. The salaries were paid directly by the Government through Provincial Treasuries and the Director of Public Works, from which the Government salaries are paid.

Salaries of employees and consultants were paid directly by the Superintendent of Districts in the amount of \$100,000 per month. The salaries were available for the purpose of the Plan.

Payments were made monthly. Salaries of employees were paid by the Director of Public Works and the Superintendent of Districts.

In some cases, the salaries were paid quarterly. Payments of salaries were made after the end of the month.

Salary lists should be secured from Superintendent, ^{or other responsible officials,} ~~on a~~ ^{divided} ~~by~~ ^{provinces}, in duplicate, one for file and one for forwarding. When approved by Regional Hq. the latter should be sent to the Provincial Finance Officer for approval and transmittal to the Provincial Treasuries.

Minutes of Conference, 20 Nov. 1943

The Conference considered whether it would be desirable and practicable to arrange for the move from Fidi Durou to Sicily of all or part of the elements there.

Attention was particularly drawn to the fact that the issue of T.E. and G1098 stores and equipment had not yet been completed for all personnel. It was, therefore, considered that if the move was made before they were fully equipped the arrangements for the purpose would be rendered exceedingly difficult and that to equip them after they had left would be a complicated and lengthy process, if any of the equipment had to be obtained from North Africa.

Col. Brown stated he was satisfied that there were ample T.E. and G1098 stores, supplies and equipment on the Island which had been left by American and British troops previously here and which were available for issue.

These supplies, with small exceptions were sufficient for American and British requirements and could be issued locally if the Regiment and B.C. were moved here. The small deficiencies could be obtained without difficulty from North Africa.

Col. Parkin was prepared to delegate power to hold the Regiment's records at Palermo.

It was AGREED that:

1. (a) An advance echelon of HQ 2675 Regiment will move forthwith to Palermo where it will join HQ AMG. The advance echelon will have authority delegated by the Commander of 2675 Regt. to keep and maintain all records of personnel other than those remaining from time to time in North Africa. The advance echelon will also draw as far as is possible all equipment authorised by the T.E. from sources in Sicily and Italy. (b) British Adm. H.Q. will send an officer for G-4 duties to Palermo to join HQ AMG. He will draw, so far as is possible, all equipment authorised by G. 1098 from sources in Sicily and Italy (This officer is separate from the British G-4 (Staff) Officer requested some time ago). (c) Both HQ's will exchange all necessary information copies of letters, etc., with HQ AMG, HQ JCC and HQ 413 15 Army Group both in respect of personnel and equipment. For purposes of coordination of information, details

(c) Both HQ's will exchange all necessary information copies of letters, etc., with HQ AG, HQ JCC and HQ AG AG 15 Army Group both in respect of personnel and equipment. For purposes of coordination or information, details will be worked out between all HQ's concerned.

(d) Details of the foregoing to be issued by Administrative Orders.

(e) Details of the foregoing to be issued by Admin HQ. will join its immediately

2. Each HQ (i.e. 2675 Regt and Brit. Admin HQ.) will move as soon as superior HQ is soon as possible.

3. Remainder of unassigned personnel at Tidi-Ouzou will move as soon as possible to Sicily or Italy.

4. Rear party AGC, with proportion R/OR with records, documents maps etc will move to Palermo as soon as possible.

5. Any changes of officers between Regions under 15 Army Group will be by way of Attachment and not of transfer.
