1. Reference 16002/G.1 dated 22 Feb 44.
2. This Sub-Commission had in its original W.E. at Headquarters 25 persons but in accordance with a broad policy of assisting to the utmost regions who were understaffed has over a long period either assigned or attached those not actually required at Headquarters to regions. This policy has proved most successful and with the recent reorganization of this Sub-Commission put the matter on a sound basis by assigning away all personnel previously attached to regions. Consequently this Sub-Commission who now only have 10 (5 British) instead of the original 25 at Headquarters cannot without seriously affecting the speed and quality of the work done, which has recently been very heavy, spare any of these 10 now employed at Headquarters. If anyone is removed this Sub-Commission will have no alternative but to insist most strongly that another legal officer be brought in from a Region, and this policy would it is suggested be extremely unsatisfactory.

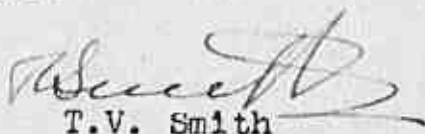

2. The Subcommission has four British officers, including the Director. Of these Capt. F.H.J. Maxse already appears in the list of 20 officers to leave at the end of February. 1. A further number of British officers is required for return to U.K. and service in another theatre. 20 have already been nominated and are leaving at the end of February, and a further 22 nominated by A.F.H.Q. will leave in mid-March.
2. The balance of 48 will be nominated by this H.Q. and will leave during the latter part of March.
3. In order to cause the least interference in the work of Regions and Sub-Commissions, Regional Commissioners will forward to this H.Q. before 28th February a nominal roll of those officers they consider suitable for return to the U.K. Specialist officers should be included in Regional Commissioners' lists and recommendations should be made without regard to rank.
4. I should be grateful if Vice-Presidents of Economic and Administrative Sections would instruct the Heads of their Sub-Commissions to submit lists. Vice-Presidents will be consulted regarding any specialist officers whose names have been recommended by Regional Commissioners.
5. Qualifications for service in ETO are:-
 - (a) Linguistic ability in French, German, Belgian or Dutch languages.
 - (b) Knowledge of, or business interests in the above countries.
 - (c) Actual field experience in A.C.C.
6. Officers recommended need not necessarily possess these qualifications, and although I do not wish Regional Commissioners to submit names of officers whose work has been unsatisfactory, there is no objection to then recommending officers who are obviously not fitted for this theatre and might be suitable for some other. Moreover, opportunity may be taken of recommending officers who, for private reasons, wish to serve in another theatre.
7. Final selection will be made by this H.Q. Regional Commissioners should, if possible, submit the names of at least six officers and Sub-Commissions

Officers recommended need not necessarily possess these qualifications, and although I do not wish Regional Commissioners to submit names of officers whose work has been unsatisfactory, there is no objection to their recommending officers who are obviously not fitted for this theatre and might be suitable for some other. Moreover, opportunity may be taken of recommending officers who, for private reasons, wish to serve in another theatre.

7. Final selection will be made by this H.Q. Regional Commissioners should, if possible, submit the names of at least six officers and Sub-Commissions at least one each.
