Article 1. The total or partial remission of the penalty referred to in Article 1 of Law No. 624 of July 3rd 1940, can also be granted to those who, subsequent to the commission of the crime in question, have been involved in military service or military service in the labor service, or, in the opinion of the military authorities or the organs of the labor service respectively, give effective and continuous proofs of good conduct in the services in question.

Article 2. The following are substituted for the first in the second sentence of Article 7 of Law No. 624 of July 3rd 1940. Even in the absence of the requisites laid down by the P.N.I. Code, conditional release is also granted to persons sentenced to terms of imprisonment not exceeding ten years, if, before voluntary, or obliged, or military service, or during military service, or during military service, or, if they are volunteers or called up for the labor service, they have effectively been assigned to that service.

Article 3. The present decree will enter into force the day after the day of its publication in the Official Gazette of Italy and, during the validity of the latter, will be inserted in the Official Collection of Laws and Decrees.

- FULVIO SUVICH. Arrested 18-8-44. Was Undersecretary to Foreign Affairs 1932-36, then Ambassador to Washington. On his return to Italy left the diplomatic service to become President of Riunione Adriatica di Sicurtà.
- CESARE TUMEDEI. Undersecretary to Ministry of "Grazia e Giustizia" 1935-36, then President of Budget Committee to fascist government. Was also on various committees to League of Nations at Geneva. Joined fascist party in 1923.
- GIOVANNI STRACCA. At the time of the Fascist Revolution was Commissario in Public Safety. Became "squadrista", then Questore, then Prefect. Was chief of Mussolini's personal police then chief of police in Dalmatia.
- RICCARDO PENTIMALLI. General. Arrested on charges of Fascist crimes and collaboration with nazi-fascists. Commanded 19th Italian Army Corp.
- ETTORE DEL TERRO. General. Commanded Naples region at time of Armistice.
- DEL TAVANO. Torturer at Via Tasso. Criticized by one of his ex-victims: Brig. Angelo Joppi.

- FRANCESCO FOLLIERO. Ex-Commissario and judge in republican fascist provincial tribunal. Was very hard on Jews and denounced Patriots and anti fascist magistrates to Germans.
- FUSCO. Dr. Served with republican fascist high Commissioner Zerbini. During German occupation presided over commission for revision of position of political prisoners. Contributed indirectly to slaughter of 50 Italian prisoners turned over to Germans on March 24th.

SPIES AT BOLOGNA etc.

Zona di Imola, Province of Bologna (Emilia).

Reg. TOMBARESI - Major in the Militia. Viale Dante, largo della Rotonda - ex president of the Associazione Mutilati of Imola. (With the funds on which he built himself a luxurious villa); collaborator with the Germans and with the agents of the Italia SS.

GENTILINI - Via XXIV Maggio. Director of the Ricovero Cerchiai per i vecchi. Collaborator, together with TOMBARESI with Germans and SS.

RASPADORI Anselmo - Centurione of the Militia. Via XXIV Maggio, spy in German pay.

RAVANELLI Carlo - Via Tommaso Campanella. Acts in strict collaboration with the above.

BETTINI - Lt. of the Militia, has frequently commanded execution squads of persons denounced by himself.

BARONCINI - Called by his superiors "The Intrepid". Of the same type as the above. Used by them to terrorise the families of partisans after the latter have been arrested.

BUSCAROLI Prof. Corso - Via Patrucco n. 4 - Fascist, under the orders of the Germans; latterly director of the Fascist periodical "La Voce Repubblicana", a local publication.

GIORNELLI - Major in the Militia - Viale Dante. The most shady individual in the whole neighbourhood. Spy. Makes use of his rank as Major to arrest everyone suspected by him.

RAVIOLI - Fascist. Via Pirezzoli 4. Serves the local Fascists as spy. Given the job of torturing political detainees

SIGNORA BRINI - Piazzale delle Bande Nere 3, spy in German pay

BRINI Guido - Son of the above, officer of the Milizia, helps his mother.

THOMCONI - Via Cavour 10. Completely unscrupulous, engaged in torturing of political detainees, and like all the others persecutor of partisans.

BIVONA Carmelo - Lawyer, Via Orsini 3. Commissario Prefettizio. Collaborationist with Germans.

GALASSI - Via Apple 24. Intimate of BIVONA

TIBALDI - Questore of Bologna. Joined the partisans of the neighbourhood and then denounced all those he could to the Germans.

FOGGIA - Pietro Antonio GIUSEPPI. At one time soldier at Foggia, and afterwards warden of the concentration camp of Chieti. Barbarously killed an air force officer.

MONTEFALCONE APPENNINO - Arnaldo CIUNCANELLI. Secretary of the Republican Fascio of Serra Vignone. Spy. Murder of allied prisoners of war.

CARLIANO - ZENAVIA FUCIARELLI and MELEGA VIRGILIA. Pretended to help prisoners of war in order to betray them to the Germans.

Para 11 - POLITICAL SITUATION AT PIMONTE (Naples Province)

People are continually denouncing the leaders of the community who are all fascist. The Meyer, Casimiro DONNARUMMA, member of the Fascist party from 1923, Political Secretary for the area, Podesta' from 1939, now Mayor. Another, the Secretary of the Commune is an ex officer of the Militia. The maresciallo dei carabinieri, Nania Andrea, noted contrabandist, disliked and accused by all, is implicated now in a enquiry concerning a theft of firearms.

Para 13 - POLITICAL SITUATION AT CASTELLAMMARE.

Castellammare, together with Caserta, known always as anti-fascist centres, as "Red Cities", is now communist with 90% of the working classes in the movement. Nevertheless it is still a centre of personalities and private interest, and political intrigues is rife. The one person hated most in the area is Luigi Buonocore, employee in the Consorzio Agrario at the Municipio. Report on Conditions in Enemy Occupied Italy - No. 15.

This report does not in any way represent the political views of the compilers, but is an effort to present an accurate picture of conditions in enemy occupied Italy, and of the state of public opinion there, compiled from Italian eye-witness accounts and other information. Sources of information are quoted in brackets. The information is released by Military Censorship for all propaganda except for items side-lined.

RESISTANCEI. Guerrillas and Partisans.

All reports indicate the increasing preparation of northern partisans for full scale action when called upon by General Alexander. The "Fronte della Resistenza" communique no 79 reported that 80,000 patriots south of BOLOGNA are awaiting the proper signal for action.

From all accounts too the Germans have been obliged to bring in fresh divisions to deal with the threat to their lines of communication etc. occasioned by the partisans. It was reported from Chiasso on 23.6.44 that "the Wehrmacht has just sent to North Italy three divisions in order to replace those Kesselring hastily withdrew from this region to defend the road to Florence. These three divisions are drawn from troops operating in Yugoslavia, also occupation troops in Hungary and Bulgaria. Reinforcements are necessitated by sudden partisan uprising in ~~the mountain~~ ^{the Po plain} (P.I.D. Gazette de Lausanne).

Some idea of the scope of the partisan movement and of the German reactions to it can be obtained from the following extract from a translated German order of April last.

"H.Q. Military District 1043.

Travel on these roads is extremely dangerous. By day and night movement may only be carried out in convoys of at least five vehicles with weapons ready to fire, and alert observation of the countryside. Until a convoy protection system, using military police or patrols is organized this state of readiness must be maintained throughout the entire journey. Night travel will be undertaken only in cases of urgency. All incidents of whatever nature, will be at once reported to the nearest military post.

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Action to be taken by columns of troops in villages.

In Rome recently a column of soldiers from a certain unit, was involved in a murderous attack. The high casualties sustained are attributable to the fact that they were marching in close order. Commander in Chief SOUTH-WEST (KESSELRING) has ordered that in future all troops in large villages will march well spread out, and with advance, rear and flank protection. All weapons must be ready to fire throughout the march. Fire from houses, etc, will be returned immediately.

All local commands will therefore ensure that this order is carefully observed, in so far as it applies to their district. Military police and the routing patrols will be on the lookout for breaches of this order. Unit pickets will take the same action. (4 Brit. Div. Int. Summary No. 35).

This type of order from the German command would apply equally well, if not more so, to the northern districts of Italy where partisan activity is very strong.

Committees of Liberation

The functions exercised by the Committees of Liberation in the various districts in the partisan movement are indicated by two notices recently found in PERUGIA, which read as follows:-

The National Committee of Liberation has discovered that the responsible elements of the Republican Fascist Party, with a view to intimidation, are carrying on their unpatriotic work and in order to involve as many of the citizens as possible in their responsibility, have invited members of the Party to leave the city in order to avoid eventual reprisals. The Committee of Liberation declares that animated by feelings of ~~justified~~ great patriotism, it will never have recourse to methods professed and applied by the Fascist barbarians; moreover none of the families of Fascist Republicans, even of the most responsible ones, will have anything to fear from the authorised representatives of the new democratic Government, because the latter will avoid any form of vendetta, whatsoever.

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Partisan activities in various quarters.

Following the fighting in COMO and control exercised by Italian forces of liberation over roads, railways and lake traffic, Germans have closed railways to COMO, VARESE and SONDRIO. They have had to bring armoured formations from Bergamo to control patriots in VALTILLIN. Reports in the Swiss press again refer to bitter fighting in CUNEO region.

Seamen, industrialists, intellectuals and workers and students, elements of the army and navy have initiated Committees of Liberation. Martial Law in LIGURIA proves that the oppressors do not hide the seriousness of the situation.

It was reported from Cuiesso on 22.6.44 that at the beginning of that week patriots tried to capture TURIN and succeeded in penetrating several quarters of the town. Shortly afterwards they were expelled.

(P.I.D. Italian Region 24.6.44).

It is officially announced that the Italo-German police forces carried out a large scale operation in the region north of VICENZA. One hundred and forty partisans were killed and 60 captured. (Agence Telegraphique Suisse. News Digest 29.6.44).

Partisan activity has recently increased in the DOMODOSSOLA Region. Occupation troops are now reinforced by four Czech Battalions. Several attacks have been carried out against the MILAN - DOMODOSSOLA line and clashes between Germans and partisans have been reported. The train circulation on the DOMODOSSOLA-MILAN and DOMODOSSOLA-NOVARA line is at present completely stopped. (22.6.44).

Hatred of Fascists.

The hatred of the partisans for the Fascist Republicans is greater even than that for the Germans. At TORRE PELICE (TORINO) there were frequent clashes between Fascists and patriots, who, if the Germans had not intervened in time to restrain them, would have committed every sort of excess, leaving the city completely. At a certain point the patriots of the zone had the upper hand of the Fascists and dominated the situation to such an extent that they issued orders and orders signed by their Committee to maintain order and protect the inhabitants.
(P.W.E. Rome Sig. B.).

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Complaint of lack of recognition.

In partisan milieus it has been observed that in military allied newspapers published in Italy the operations of Italian partisans are seldom spoken of and never stressed. (8th Army 29.6.44).

II. Assassinations.

BOLOGNA A Maresciallo of the G.N.R. GIUSEPPE TINELLI, Commander of a detachment of Merzobotto near Bologna was assassinated by bandits on May 21st. (News Digest 29.6.44).

CUNEO FRANCESCO ZALI, 75 year old priest of MORRA DEL VILLAR SAN COSTANZO in Cuneo province, was killed by bandits who had demanded a large sum of money from him.

BUSTO ARSIZIO The Militiaman GUGLIELMO BONETTI was assassinated while on duty in BUSTO ARSIZIO (VARESE) on June 20th. (News Digest Pomeriggio di Milan 29.6.44).

OVADA The Secretary of the Republican Fascio GLINCARLO SCORZA of Ovada was killed near his home when returning from work - 14.6.44. The same evening two bandits guilty of highway robbery and of possessing firearms were executed. (Regime Fascists Empex).

ZAVATARELLO While carrying out their duty at Zavatarello, near BORGIO PRIOLO six G.N.R. Militiamen were killed. (Regime Fascista Voghera 20.6.44 Empex).

I/. The Folgore Parachute Regiment.

The formation of the FOLGORE Para. Regt. was completed at SPOLETO in the latter part of April and was identified south of ROME on 3rd June. The regiment was not ready for combat when it was committed since they had not completed their training. Some of the troops had made training jumps in Germany and others were given a short course in Italy. The Regiment is organised similarly to the German Inf. Regt. with 12 Companies plus an Engineer Company and a Signal Company. P.Ws. did not know if they had a 13 and 14 company.

The unit is equipped with German weapons. Each rifle Co. has 8 LMG 42 and the heavy Co. has 4 81 mm mortars plus 10-12 HMG. They carry the German rifle 98K.

Badoglio, having driven the Italians to fratricide, pronounced his own sentence. Alexander too, has lost all military honour by issuing this proclamation. That is my opinion as a soldier. As a man, I furthermore condemn the invitation to stab in the back, since immense grief would be caused to Italian families, on whom no blame can rest, by our reprisals. Up till now, I have proved with fact that to me the respect for humane principles is a matter of ordinary logic. However, as responsible chief, I can no longer hesitate to prevent, by the most repressive means, this utterly despicable and medieval method of fighting. I give warning that I shall use these means forthwith. Badoglio's followers and subversive elements are warned not to continue their present behaviour". (Italian Home Service. News Digest. 29.6.44).

X. Morale.

German troops in ASCOLI were heard expressing a desire to cut Hitler's throat (June 15th).

The morale of German truck drivers in the ANTRONOCO area was very bad (16th June) If they saw Allied bombers passing high overhead they would leave their trucks and run for cover.

One German soldier who lives in southern Germany was heard saying that all the civilians in that part of the country are tired of the war and that they were very short of food.

German troops in the TERNI area (13th June) were seen burning their clothes and breaking up their weapons. (8th Army Special Interrogation Summary 28.6.44).

There is a strong Communist organisation in Turin in close contact with the partisans.

In working class quarters in Turin the tendency to communism shows itself ever more strongly. The monarchy and the House of Savoy, which was always strongly supported in Piedmont, are now almost completely ignored.

The Italian resistance front tonight (May 24th) revealed that it is in contact with patriots in Rome who have furnished the names and activities of some of the most vicious Nazi-Fascist agents operating in the Eternal City.

A particular squad of Rome police was denounced by the front in its night programme "Italia Combattente", broadcast over Radio Naples and the Voice of Italy Network, which said that the squad, headed by a lieutenant COX and composed of patrolmen, MARIANI, PERONE, and a "well known senator who is a morphine addict", were charged with torturing all Italians whom they are able to arrest. They were said to be operating in the top floor of a building in via TOMACELLI, beside the Military Union.

The broadcast singled out VITTORIO BATTALINI, who lives at 77 via SCIPIONE. He was designated as "a German S.S. spy, now driving around the streets of Rome in one of two cars having license numbers Rome 6831 and Rome 9856.

Patriots in Rome were also warned against Captain of Militia PALMIGIANI, 406 via MEDAGLIA D'ORO, who recently arrested two anti-Fascist neighbors, ("Italia Combattente").

The people of ASOLLI were highly indignant at this breach of International Convention regarding treatment of P.Ws. and protested openly.

The Segretario Federale is the Medical Dott. OLIVIERI. He already held the post up to 26th July. The Triumvirate which replaces the old Federal Directorate is composed of the University student VERLUCCIA, tenente LANZETTA, ex 14th Reg. Lately ROMANO went to the Triumvirate of MACERATA and was replaced by a certain LEPORE, ex-Sergeant of the Compagnia Distrettuale.
