1. I request relief from active duty, United States Army.
2. The Education Sub-Commission is now overstrength, and will be rendered further so by the expected early addition of a British Deputy Director and by the promised arrival soon from the United States of Major Joseph Murphy, who has been picked as a Roman Catholic representative and dispatched by General Hildring.
3. The work which I have been directing has evolved beyond the stage where I can be of the greatest use. Policies are now well set both within the Sub-Commission and with the Ministry of Public Instruction. It is this policy work which I came into the Army to do, and which alone I do to best advantage. TO : - VP Administrative Section.

With further reference to signal from NATOUSA regarding availability of Lt. Col. Williams DDPH, for assignment elsewhere, suggest reply to Col. Spofford embodying following:

1. This Sub-Commission wishes to make every possible contribution to winning the war and to permit its personnel all possible latitude in military assignments. However, information as to proposed date of release and type of work (foreign, domestic, etc.) involved is not available hence this office and officer concerned are not in position to make a positive or negative commitment without further facts.

2. In view of the need for more complete information regarding all phases of this Sub-Commission's short-term and long-term policies and programmes, it is felt that a member of this Sub-Commission should confer at the earliest possible time with proper officers of the Surgeon General's Office, AGC-Civil Affairs Division, the Medical Director of WHTA, and the Director, International Health Division, Rockefeller Foundation. Each agency is directly concerned with the short-term and long-term activities.

It is believed that many of our existing problems could be simplified and future activities materially enhanced if opportunity was afforded a member of this Sub-Commission to discuss details with the groups concerned, individually and jointly.

I would recommend that Lt. Col. Williams be designated to represent this Sub-Commission in those conferences which should not require more than 10 to 15 days. This would also enable officer concerned to get more complete details regarding the proposed official assignment for himself.

NATOUSA should be asked to request T/D assignment and air transport as above to Washington D.C.

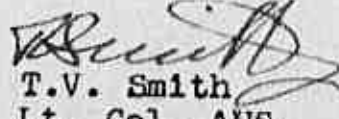
