1. The reduction in qualifying service for PYTHON has produced a large backlog which cannot be cleared immediately.

2. It is not possible at present to make firm promises, but provided the latest movement forecasts are fulfilled and there are no major breakdowns in the proposed rail and air lifts, the following figures are given as a guide for the future movement of PYTHON personnel:-

August	15,000
September	11,000
October	5,000

3. The effect of this will be that everyone due for PYTHON by the end of September, including the total backlog due to shortening of overseas period, should have left for UK by 30 September, and that everyone due for PYTHON during the period October - December should have left for UK by 31 October.
