SUBJECT: Accommodation.

ACCOMMODATION

TO : All Regional Commissioners.

1. In the past there has been difficulty of officers of this Headquarters when visiting Regional and Provincial Headquarters securing accommodation for their drivers when these are either Italian Army or civilian personnel, and it is suggested that in order to help in the easy procurement of such accommodation, as it is necessary for this Headquarters to employ both Italian Army and civilian personnel as drivers, a list should be maintained at your Headquarters and at each of your Provincial Headquarters of suitable lodgings where drivers can be accommodated.

2. All drivers leaving this Headquarters are furnished with the rations to cover their period of absence; they also carry with them their own blankets. Consequently, all that is required is somewhere where they can be furnished with a bed and some cooking facilities.

SUBJECT : Accommodation SIENA.

TO : Executive Commissioner, HQ ACC.

1. For the time being the town of SIENA is very congested. Amenities available in the past have ceased. Sleeping accommodation for 3 or 4 Officers only is available at the Transit Mess (Prefettura) for which previous notice is essential. Since the Hostel Studente has been taken over by higher authority, visiting Italian Employees cannot be accommodated in the town. If the various branches of HQ, ACC could be made acquainted with the above conditions disappointment and inconvenience would be avoided.
