1. It has been decided to form what may be called a Claims Commission consisting of an American and a British Officer to investigate the circumstances in which requisition by AMG/AC officers were carried out and to make recommendations as to which cases demand special action.
2. A vacancy accordingly exists for a British Officer as a Claims Officer. The qualifications considered necessary are integrity, some degree of G or administrative experience at either staff (preferably) or Regimental level, and considerable determination.
3. This is a suitable assignment for a good officer (Capt. or Major) who would otherwise become surplus, and who wishes to remain in Italy. It will probably continue for an extended period of many months. Will you suggest as soon as possible please any names you consider suitable stating when they will be available for assignment.

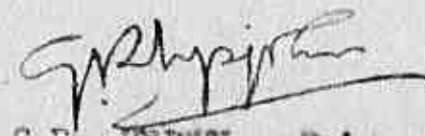
