Dear Brigadier Upjohn,

Your letter of the 11th June, addressed to Sir Philip Game, has come to me, as Sir Philip has now retired.

I think there may have been a little misunderstanding about Sir Philip's letter to the Officers you mention. The position is that any of these officers may be selected for promotion while he is away. If that happens he will be notified and told that he will be promoted immediately if the Allied Commission are prepared to let him return. If he cannot be released straight away, he will get his actual promotion after his return to the police when a vacancy occurs, being suitably antedated for seniority and increments but not for pay.

I do not think that the prospects of the three Officers referred to in your letter will be in any way prejudiced if they are not released from their stations until 31st July.

I should like to thank you for your very kind remarks about the policemen who have been serving as Public Safety Officers. It is gratifying to learn that their work and capabilities have been so much appreciated.

I hereby appeal against the decision to compulsorily retain my services in H.M. Army until 31st July, 1945, as laid down in letter G.I.B/140/1/A of 17 May 1945, and would place before you the following facts:-

- (a) I volunteered for service in May 1943, notwithstanding that I was then over 50 years of age and had three children serving in the Forces.
- (b) At the time, I was the senior Chief Inspector eligible for promotion in the Metropolitan Police Force and could reasonably have expected to have been considered for the next vacancy.
- (c) During my absence abroad with Allied Military Government, several officers holding the rank of Chief Inspector have been promoted and in every case the officer concerned was below me in the seniority list.
- (d) I have received a letter from the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis dated 9 May 1945 which in effect offered me promotion provided I can return to the Force almost immediately to take up the position.

" I have not consulted you about your future hitherto as I saw little chance of your coming into the immediate promotion picture. But now that the war is obviously nearly over the situation may well change and more vacancies occur.

I think it would be a good thing, therefore, if you would consider how you would regard the prospect of coming back to the Force should you be selected for promotion. Two points seem to need consideration -

(1) If the Commissioner should wish to offer you promotion, would your present employers be prepared to spare you within a reasonable time, say not more than three months at most?

(2) If they were willing to do so, would you wish to come back to the Force or prefer to stay where you are for the time being and take your chance of promotion if and when you return?"

2. With a view to seeking information I submit the following facts and respectfully ask that this report be forwarded to Allied Commission Headquarters, Public Safety Sub-Commission, for a reply.

3. In December, 1942, I was one of four Chief Inspectors selected from the Metropolitan Police Force to perform Civil Affairs duties with the Army. Although, so far as I can recall, there was not a written agreement it was understood that this duty would last until the end of the war and that we should then return to our duties with the Police Service.

I was posted 'Off Pay' with the Military Forces on 31st May, 1943, and on 16th June embarked at Liverpool for Africa for duty with A.M.C. Deputy Chief of Public Safety in Region 1. On 10 June, 1944, I was assigned as S.O.A.P.O. Polish Corps with 8th Army. In September, 1944, I was posted as Regional Public Safety Officer Liguria Region, my present assignment.

4. During the whole of this period I have held the view that my services with A.M.C. would cease with the end of the war.

5. If the group system of demobilisation is to apply in my case however, it would seem that although I am over 49 years of age I fall in group 25 but I have no indication when such group is likely to be released.

6. I feel that the time has now arrived when I should ensure my future prospects and I have to ask whether information can be given which will enable me to suitably reply to the Commissioners's letter.

1. Major Smethurst reported to H.Q. D.P. & R.S.C. "on Loan". When I saw him he grouched in a tone that I did not like but being desperately in need of Officers I wasted three quarters of an hour and thought that I had got him in a frame of mind when he would do a job. I obtained a special plane and flew him and 3 other Officers to TREVISO next day to relieve four attached R.A.F. Officers who were due to leave. The Group Commander Major Hudson, was away on a job when they arrived. Major Smethurst again grouched to Major Hudson.

I saw him on the 24th and endured a spate of grumblings about everything justifiable and unjustifiable. I then came to the conclusion that he would be a detriment to any job of work or camp and informed the Regional Commissioner, Venezia, that I had no job for him in D.P. & R.S.C. and that if he did not require him, requested that he would order him back to Rome.

2. As regards Officers, D.P. & R.S.C. is strung out from Lecce to Austrian Border with an average of 1 Officer per camp, who are mostly doing magnificent jobs of work.

These Officers are cracking up one by one from overwork.

I have other Officers "on Loan" who are also a detriment to any job or any camp and my Group and Camp Commanders would rather be without them. These I am returning one by one. Some Staff Officers who sit in Offices in Rome do not seem to realise that a single Officer dealing with 3000 - 4000 refugees daily has "no time" for the "unhelpful" Officer who may be loaned to him.

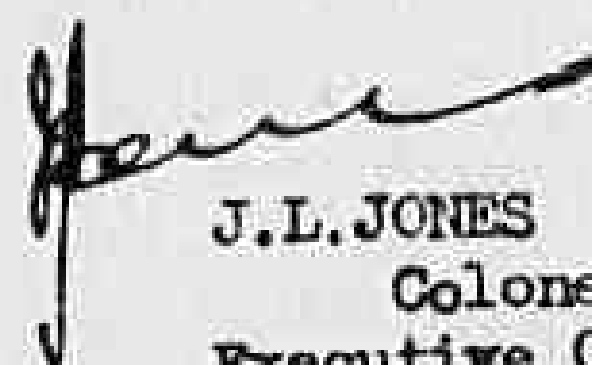
