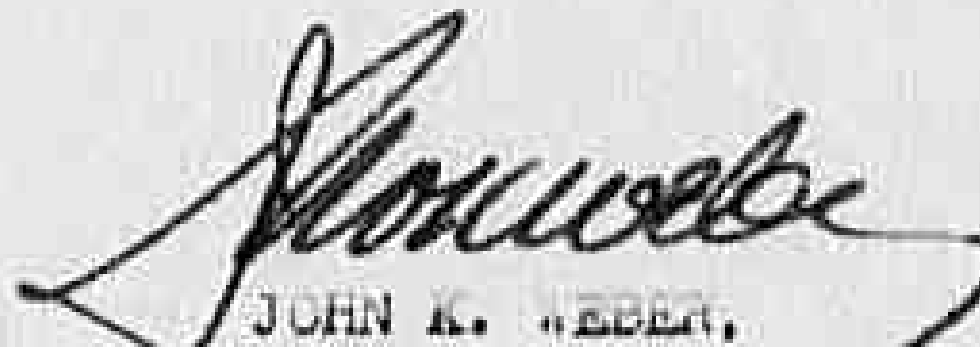

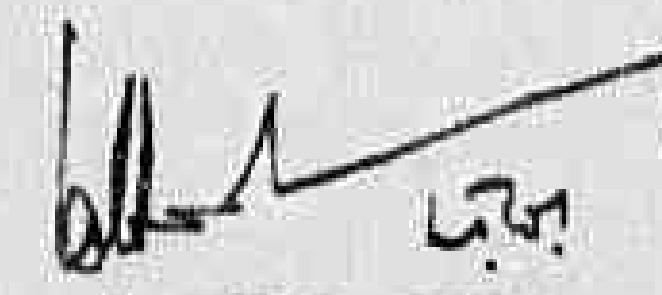

1. It is known that there is uncertainty in many officers' minds over the reasons which prompt AFHQ to authorize most applications for Voluntary Deferment of release until General Demobilization, whereas a considerable number of applications for voluntary deferment for one or two years are rejected.

2. The following extract from a letter recently received by this HQ from AFHQ is accordingly forwarded for information:-

"1. It is not possible to give a firm statement of policy, except in general terms, since each case of deferment has of necessity to be treated individually and on its merits.

2. It should be noted that, whereas deferment until final demobilization may be terminated at any time that an officer's service may no longer be required by the Army, deferment for one or two years is in the nature of a contract which guarantees employment for the period stated. This means that the cases of volunteers for one or two years must be more carefully considered than those for the more indefinite period."

If that happens he will be notified and told that he will be promoted immediately if the Allied Commission are prepared to let him return.
