1. Reference G-13/16120/785/0 dated 2 March, 1945.
2. The approval of the Director General, UNRRA and the London Office of UNRRA is in effect an application for the services of Lt. Colonel C. F. FOTHERGILL. At the same time UNRRA ITALY is submitting a request for the release of this officer.
3. As this officer's services were needed for a specific post, Assistant Chief of UNRRA Italian Mission, it was necessary for UNRRA to ascertain from LONDON and WASHINGTON if Lt. Colonel FOTHERGILL would be acceptable for this post prior to submitting application for his release.

Lt. Colonel FOTHERGILL informed me as soon as he knew that this application would be made.
4. His letter asking for the approval of the Army Council to his secondment to UNRRA under the terms of Royal Warrant 1940, Para 99, CLASS A was to assure that if his release was sanctioned it should be covered by special terms rather than those stated in Daily Bulletin No.7 dated 7 January, 1945 Para 6.
5. Might Lt. Colonel FOTHERGILL be informed if his secondment to UNRRA will receive approval of Allied Commission when UNRRA submit final applications for his service.

1. I have been interested for some considerable time in refugee and rehabilitation problems and for the past year have dealt directly as Deputy Director of Displaced Persons and Repatriation Sub-Commission, with some of these problems at first hand.
2. As a result of my practical experience regarding refugee and rehabilitation problems, I have been asked by Commander Jackson, Deputy Director of U.N.R.R.A. if I would accept the post of assistant Chief of U.N.R.R.A. Italian Mission. My name for this appointment has been approved by the Director General of U.N.R.R.A. in Washington and is concurred in by the London Office of U.N.R.R.A.
3. I request that special approval of the Army Council be obtained to authorise my acceptance of this appointment and that I be seconded to U.N.R.R.A. under the terms of Royal Warrant 1940, Para 99, CLASS 1, such period of secondment to U.N.R.R.A. to reckon as service as a commissioned officer of the Regular Forces and count towards retired pay.
