In view shortage US Officers in VENEZIA GIULIA it may well be advisable to place less qualified officers on duty there as a stop gap until they learn job or until they can be replaced. The fact officers senior in grade to present ones need not prevent their temporary assignment. Feel sure they will give loyal service in situation explained to all. Venezia GIULIA should have priority over liaison teams expect on northwest border. No objection to higher ratio British on liaison teams during readjustment period. Presume you are holding officers on civil affairs duties as presently authorized. With authorized strength 250 officers and present strength 230 officers you are probably better off than any other US Unit in the theater.

FROM : G-1B/H.Q., A.C.

1. Attached is a list of officers in your Section now in Venesia Giulia or earmarked for assignment there. In the case of each Sub Commission etc the number of assignments to be filled is also shown. These figures are the result of discussion between a Venesia Giulia representative and this Branch (which had already ascertained the views of Sub Commissions etc.).

2. It is requested that you scrutinise these lists and have them completed and if necessary altered. It is important to know now the names of all officers nominated, even if their immediate assignment is not contemplated, so that they can quickly be extricated from their present assignments should this become necessary in the case of further sudden withdrawals of large numbers of officers from Venesia Giulia.

3. Wherever possible all names included in the lists should be of officers who will be at least 5 months in the theatre, preferably of course longer. For parity reasons American Officers should be included whenever a choice is possible.

4. It is pointed out that the new Establishment on which these lists of assignments are based is only approved in principle by G-5 A.P.H.Q. and further modifications may be necessary. It is however expected that in the main it will be accepted.
