- (b) In substitution, a monthly strength return of British C.A.S. will be submitted on Form ACC R.2 to this Army 9900 hours 5th of each month, made up to and including last day of previous month. First return to reach this HQ 5th April 1944.
- (c) A nominal roll to support the figures given will be attached to each return. Personnel temporarily attached or detached will be shown stating where to or from, for what purpose and authority.

3. CASUALTIES (BRITISH ONLY)

Reporting of Casualties will be given under headings as in paras 3 (a), (b), (c) and (d). A separate return, on Form ACC R.3 appended, is required for each group which will be serially numbered.

(a) Routine

All Casualties, other than those reported under para 3 (b), (c) or (d) will be included under this heading such as the following:

Promotions, appointments, attachments, transfers, pay and allowances, sentences by Court martial, leave or absence, marriage, marriage, birth or death of a child, alteration in next of kin with postal address, and alteration in Medical Category.

(b) Hospital

Reports on Form ACC R.3 will be submitted for any Officer or Other Rank admitted to or discharged from hospital as the casualty occurs. This hospital or other medical unit to which the Officer or Other Rank was or discharged from will always be stated on the form.

(c) Reports of Injuries

In cases of accidental or self-inflicted injury sustained by an Officer or O.R. whether on or off duty, a report will be submitted on Form ACC R.3. AF 2-77 will not be used when accidental injury is sustained in a Battle area, vide GSO 37 of 1944. AF 2-117 will, in all cases of self-inflicted injury, be completed in duplicate and forwarded as soon as possible to this HQ. The Commanding Officer's opinion (para 4 of AF 2-117) will be

signed/.....

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signed by a British Army Officer not below the rank of Captain. In the case of Regiments, Sub-Commissions and HQs, the Officer and the Officer's covering letter is required, signed personally by the Senior British Officer, attesting agreement or otherwise, giving reasons, of the opinion expressed in para 4.

(d) Battle Casualties (British)

Battle Casualties of Officers and G.N.s. belonging to AM/ACG will be reported immediately by signal message to G-1 (British), HQ Allied Control Commission. These signal messages will be serially numbered and each will be prefixed by the letters 'BC' in order that missing reports may be checked.

The following code will be used to describe the nature of the casualty:

Killed X Wounded Y Missing Z

Also stating the Number, Rank and Unit.

Confirmation of signal message will be sent within twelve hours on Form JOC R.3.

No Officer or G.N. will be reported as killed unless his dead body has been seen and identified.
