SUBJECT: Transport.

TO : Vice President, Establishments Section.

1. Owing to the rapid advance into North Italy, the Dispatch Office is receiving many applications for trips into that area and is likely to receive many more. Up to date all trips have been met but it is anticipated that vehicles will be away for longer periods, and, owing to the shortage of vehicles capable of undertaking such trips, it is recommended that a priority scheme should be introduced. It is not possible for the Dispatch Office to say what trips are more important than others and, therefore, can only operate on the principle of first come, first serve, according to the availability of vehicles for the particular trips involved.

2. Would it be possible, therefore, for Vice Presidents of Sections to be asked that all trips into Northern Italy should be passed through the respective offices and priority given by the Vice President's office concerned so that the Dispatch Office can then operate in fairness to each Section and Sub-Commission.

Report by Lt. Col. White on visit to Palestrina.

5th March, 1945.

On 4 March 1945, in company with Major Cooper of Food Sub-Commission, I was at Palestrina where I saw the Sindaco.

We inspected the food kitchen which feeds 500 persons daily.

The Sindaco asked us to see the store of clothing which had been received from America and which was being distributed. He stated that he expected to complete distribution in about a fortnight's time.

While walking through the streets he referred to a passerby named TICCA of whom he said that he had been a notorious Fascist, yet he had been able to get, apparently from A.C., new tyres for his cars whereas the Sindaco could not obtain tyres for necessary municipal purposes.

We also visited the kitchen at CAVE which serves 500 people.
