LUCCA communists growing among unemployed. Christian Democrat, Socialist, and Action parties very active. Organization of Govt in Province and communes satisfactory. Memorial service for Partisans sponsored by Germans held at FORNO by communists. No incidents.

1- ~~BF~~ LUCCA all attention focussed on Italian Government crisis. Local atmosphere calm. PISTOIA all attention on Rome. APUANIA Christian Democrats increasing in number and influence but Communism tends to increase amongst unemployed. PISA political activity still on increase. Meetings held in peaceful and orderly manner. Democratic Party appears to be getting stronger. *Food - Distribution* ~~BF~~ APUANIA pasta went into manufacture June 1. Increased supplies anticipated by mid June. Improved ration of 300 grams weekly issued by FLORENCE sufficient grain in warehouse until mid September at present ration scale. *Supplies - Satisfaction* ~~BF~~ LUCCA general supply position shows progress. Consider all communes position fair for June. APUANIA 1000 tons flour allocated to Province. 25 miles arrived, 20 tonnes expected. LIVORNO resetting of tony nets now assures good supply of tony. Progress made towards having fishing boats unloaded catch at LIVORNO instead of PIGGINO. FLORENCE normal operation of several *4253* held up owing to non availability of coal. Movement of raw materials, finished goods, and fuel (lignite) lessened by lower gasoline allocations. High cost of lignite, due to road haulage costs, is causing trend to higher prices of manufactured articles.

PISTOIA RICE SITUATION presents only problem. AS APUANIA too high but downward trend apparent. PISTOIA slight rise continues.

INCCA examination of CARPIGNANO discloses considerable rebuilding possibilities. General condition on CARPIGNANO line communes deplorable.

SUBJECT : Situation Report on Refugees, Toscana Region, 11 May 45.

TO : Executive Commissioner, A.C.
G-5, 15 Army Group.

1. A truck company of about forty trucks was reported to the Provincial Commissioner's office about noon today for a trip to ROME. This truck company left at 1600 hrs carrying about 800 refugees mostly former Italian soldiers. Due to instructions given the commander of the convoy by someone outside of Toscana Region the convoy commander did not leave until G-5, 15 Army Group insisted that he go in spite of instructions which were causing unnecessary delay.

2. Colonel HENSLEY went to Livorno, consulted G-4 PBS and saw the telegram received by them. The telegram does not instruct PBS to supply transport and food on an emergency basis as previously reported, but puts the responsibility on 5th and 8th Armies respectively to do so. A conference is being held with 15 Army Group and others concerned, to make the necessary arrangements for obtaining food on an emergency basis as needed and to arrange the use of motor transport in an emergency.

3. In a telephone conversation with the Executive Commissioner, I asked that he obtain for us the permanent use, during this refugee emergency, of a truck company. I also asked him to insist in obtaining rail transportation and water transportation I had asked for. The request was made by my Transportation Officer to the Transportation Sub-Commission. The request was for rail transportation for 300 refugees per day and for the use of one LCT to take approx 700 refugees from Livorno to Sicily.

4. During the morning I was assured by G-1(B) of AC Hq, Col. Jones, that he was sending two officers of the Displaced Persons & Repatriation Sub-Commission at once to Toscana Region in addition to Lt. Col Yeo and that he would also send a Lt. Col for refugee duty. I agreed that if these officers were present they would be sufficient for the time being.

5. The greatest needs of the present moment for the handling of these refugees are:

- a. Permanently assigned MT (at least one truck company).
- b. At least four officers (see par 4 above).
- c. Arrangements for rail transport on a daily basis to take at least 300 refugees from Florence area to points south of Rome.
- d. Space for additional billets for refugees in Florence. This space is now being sought by the Provincial authorities.

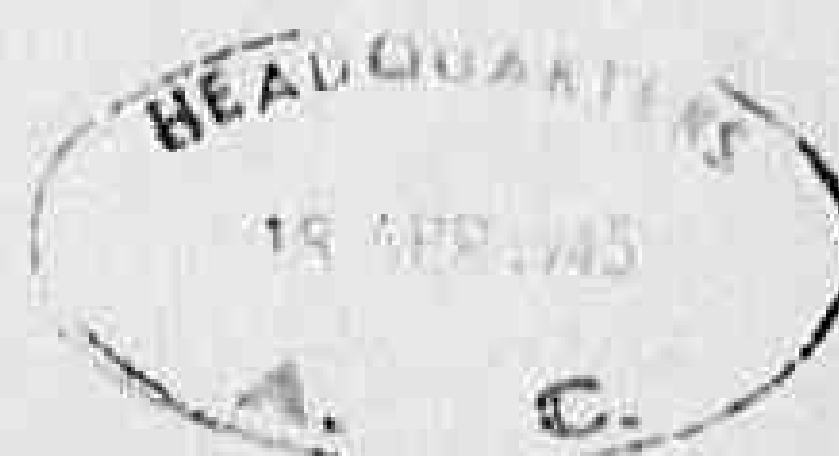

P.C. arrived on foot 1100 hrs 3.II.44 and took charge of excellent arrangements made by P.P.S.O., official of A.R.O. and Provincial team. All military units, many in bad trouble themselves, rendered assistance to best of ability. Reconnaissance by duck left Grosseto 1300 hrs 3.II.44 to report situation on N. banks of mouth of Ombrone, under P.P.S.O. accompanied by V. Prefect Inspector and Partisan representatives. Reconnaissance showed flood here rose comparatively slow much stock saved but all lower stores of farms inundated. Aircraft landing ground suffered by flooding and consequent disorganization. In city order prevailed,

small isolated incidents of looting are reported and under investigation. After first sudden flood situation was well in hand and the people have behaved splendidly, in particular the Sindaco, showing a healthy Provincial and Communal Administration proving its worth by clear orders briskly obeyed. I am very well content with work done by all hands. Work continues with a fleet of six ducks and many small boats and six bill-dozers. Tragedy to the people exceeds in extent that caused by all previous air bombardments combined. Bridge (Ponte Mussolini) still stands and is in use but is dangerous and unlikely to last while continued height of water makes repair almost impossible. Second flood at 1500 hrs 3.11.44 was diverted in part to DIVERSIVO canal and spent itself through gaps already made, doing no further damage, except to foundations of bridge.
