1. When the Italian Minister of Labor, Signer BARBARISCHI, was at LA SPEZIA about a fortnight ago he told the Prefect that the new decree relative to pay would be antedated to 1st May. This included decree number 116 which we have authority to pay only from 1st August. This declaration which the Prefect has made public has caused strikes and a lot of dissatisfaction amongst the people in LA SPEZIA who blame AMG for the non payment of the back money.

2. If in fact the Minister did say this and referred to decree 116 it is considered most reprehensible and dangerous, and steps should be taken to prevent a recurrence.

3. It is also recommended that the whole question of pay be taken up urgently with Finance SC in order to secure a solution to the present unsatisfactory situation. End signed JORDAN for CARR.

1. A state of disquiet exists in the Province of LA SPEZIA over the question of wages and a quasi general strike is in force by state and parastatal workers. It is alleged that the Italian Minister of Labor, Signor BARBARESCO, on a recent visit stated that all decrees including number 116 would be antedated to May 1st.

2. This information was made known publicly by the Prefect. Notices have been displayed in LA SPEZIA that the strike will continue until this decree is implemented with effect from 1st May not 1st August as authorized by AMG.

On 1st August 1945 3 Carabinieri were detailed to proceed on duty to FIORINO a fraction of GENOA. They left FIORINO on foot about 9 PM to return to their station at PEGLI. They were not seen alive after that time. Search parties were sent out and on 5th August their bodies were found partly buried in a hole in the mountains some 4 kilometers from the point where they were last seen. They had sustained many bullet wounds. Investigations commenced and 21 persons are being held for questioning enquiries continuing. Report will be submitted later. End signed HEFFORD.

1. With further reference to this Headquarters LIG/HQ/119 of 24 Jul 45, I have since received a letter from the MILAN office of Allied Commission (copy of which is enclosed) stating that permission for Lt. Col. ROMANETTI to remain at VENTIMIGLIA was granted by IV Corps.
2. The enclosed letter was the first time I had heard of any such agreement and I am informing Provincial Commissioner, IMPERIA Province. I presume that the further information being sent regarding this agreement may contain some details as to the duration of the stay of any French Officers at VENTIMIGLIA.

TO : Headquarters, Allied Commission (Att. Vice President,  
Civil Affairs Section)

1. I have visited recently the area of the 14 Communes in the Western end of IMPERIA Province where Allied troops relieved French on 10th July.
2. I found ~~many~~ on 21st July, the date of my visit to VENTIMIGLIA, that there is still a French Headquarters established in that town and that this H.Q. flies the French flag. The Headquarters consists of Lt. Col. ROMANETTI who was the French administrator in the area, and three other French Officers with some clerical staff. The three French Officers are: an engineer, a finance and a medical Officer.
3. When the hand-over took place the Provincial Commissioner of IMPERIA Province agreed that Lt. Col. ROMANETTI should remain for some five days after the 10th July.  
I have instructed the Provincial Commissioner, IMPERIA Province, to contact the Commander of the French Division concerned and to request from him information as to the proposed date for the closing down of this French Headquarters at VENTIMIGLIA.
4. Any further development will be reported at once to your H.Q.

Genoa was occupied by Allied troops on Friday, 27 April 1945. The Regional Commissioner and advance party arrived on that date. The main body of officers and men arrived 1 May 1945.

The Provincial Commissioner of La Spezia began his duties on 26 April; the Provincial Commissioner of Genoa on 27 April, and the Provincial Commissioner of Imperia on 4 May 1945.

Regional offices were established in the "Italian" Building, Piazza Ferrari.

C.L.M. was consulted in all proper cases, and under direction of the Commanding General, 92nd Division, Military Government has been established.

The physical destruction in Genoa has been less than anticipated. Public utilities generally were found to be in operation or susceptible of being quickly put into operation. PART II

A. Political reactions and popular opinion.

The C.L.N. is strong, active, and busily engaged in political activity. They seek to strengthen their own influence by interesting themselves in the economic and social problems of their membership and all governing agencies of this area.

A feeling of disappointment exists among them, that they can be given no executive authority under A.M.G.

Outwardly these committees appear to accept Allied Military Government, but beneath the surface there is some resentment. The Italian Government is viewed with suspicion and distrust.

Coal stocks are practically negligible, with the exception of 1000 tons of German coal at the docks, which has been placed at the disposal of S & T for railway operations.

D. Agriculture, Forestry, Fisheries.

A survey of olive oil production in Imperia and Savona has been made. It is believed that a substantial amount could be amassed. There is sharp disagreement, however, with regard to price to be paid to the producer.

Fishing restrictions have been relaxed in all areas of Liguria, except in and around the port of Genoa, under safety precautions on account of the mine fields. Some fish is arriving at the markets for the benefit of the population.

E. Labor.

Rates of pay, on arrival in this Region, were fixed at the minimum, without allowances, established for Italy. Some difficulty was encountered in employing a staff for this headquarters, on this basis. Improvements were noted when it was permitted to increase up to the minimum for Italy, without allowances. However it is believed that further upward readjustment is desirable.

Lack of coal and suspension of operations by most industries have created a vast unemployment problem.

F. Public Works and Utilities.

Electricity production, transmission and distribution are practically normal. Street cars and trams are in operation. Public utilities are working fairly normally. Gas would be available, if there were coal.

G. Public Safety and the Courts.

Proclamations 1-4 and General Order No. 1 have been posted in all Provinces. Public order is satisfactory, although there have been some murders of alleged fascists.

Very few Carabinieri were found in the Region. A total of 575 have been brought into the Region and allocated to the various provinces. A request has been made for a further 500.

Many Partisans have been disarmed, but numbers of irregular bands have still to be accounted for. In Genoa 500 have been allowed to remain armed as a police force.

Fishing restrictions have been relaxed in all areas of Liguria, except in and around the port of Genoa, under safety precautions on account of the mine fields. Some fish is arriving at the markets for the benefit of the population.

## E. Labor.

Rates of pay, on arrival in this Region, were fixed at the minimum, without allowances, established for Italy. Some difficulty was encountered in employing a staff for this headquarters, on this basis. Improvement was noted when it was permitted to increase up to the minimum for Italy, without allowances. However it is believed that further upward readjustment is desirable.

Lack of coal and suspension of operations by most industries have created a vast unemployment problem.

## F. Public Works and Utilities.

Electricity production, transmission and distribution are practically normal. Street cars and trams are in operation. Public utilities are working fairly normally. Gas would be available, if there were coal.

## G. Public Safety and the Courts.

Proclamations 1-6 and General Order No. 1 have been posted in all Provinces. Public order is satisfactory, although there have been some murders of alleged Nazis.

Very few Carabinieri were found in the Region. A total of 275 have been brought into the Region and allocated to the various Provinces. A request has been made for a further 500.

Many Partisans have been disarmed, but numbers of irregular bands have still to be accounted for. In Genoa 500 have been allowed to remain armed as a police force.

Arrangements have been made to employ 200 out of the original 400 Metropolitan. For the time being they will be in plain clothes with a "Civil Police" emblem.

The force of 1000 Guardia di Finanza is functioning, as is the Fire Brigade. The prisons are functioning, but are over crowded.

(4) ALLIED MILITARY COURTS: These have been set up in all Provinces and are in operation. Cases are being disposed of each day and the dockets are fully up to date.

(ii) ITALIAN COURTS: These courts are functioning in the Provinces of Genoa and Savona, although those in Genoa have practically suspended hearings awaiting introduction of new legislation. Italian civil law has been implemented and was in effect in Imperia on 8 May and in other Provinces on 7 May.

(iii) SPECIAL ASSIZE COURTS: The establishment of these courts has been given special attention owing to the great number of political prisoners awaiting trial, and such courts are constituted in each Province in this Region. First trials are set for 21 May 1945. A large number of alleged Fascists are awaiting trial in each Province.

#### H. Public Health and Welfare.

The general situation regarding health in this Region is good. There are no epidemics and only a few scattered cases of typhoid fever, which do not exceed the normal occurrence for this time of year.

The condition of most of the hospitals is excellent. Only a few sustained minor damage and all are well staffed and have sufficient food supplies for a short period. A few items of medical supplies, including cotton, gauze, bandages, alcohol and insulin are urgently needed. The water supply is good, though, owing to the small rainfall, it is relatively limited in amount.

#### I. Education.

All schools in Genoa Province closed on 23 April. Eleven out of the 172 school buildings in Genoa are completely destroyed.

(ii) RAIL: Rail lines are open to Milan and Turin.

(iii) TELECOMMUNICATIONS: Local telephone service is available in each Province but long distance connections are not yet available for civilian traffic.

(iv) POSTS: Civilian postal service is now functioning under restrictions of Allied Civil Censorship.

An acute shortage of currency was found in the region due to loss of a coinage of 250 million liras from Milan in April and to 20 million liras having been removed from Genoa districts as im-  
ports by Brigate Nere. To provide for immediate requirements, 320 million Liriras were obtained from AFA, Florence, and a request has been made for 400 million Metropolitan liras. Banks in Genoa were partially reopened on 7 May, withdrawing being permitted only to the extent of 10,000 liras until lists of blocked names could be prepared. 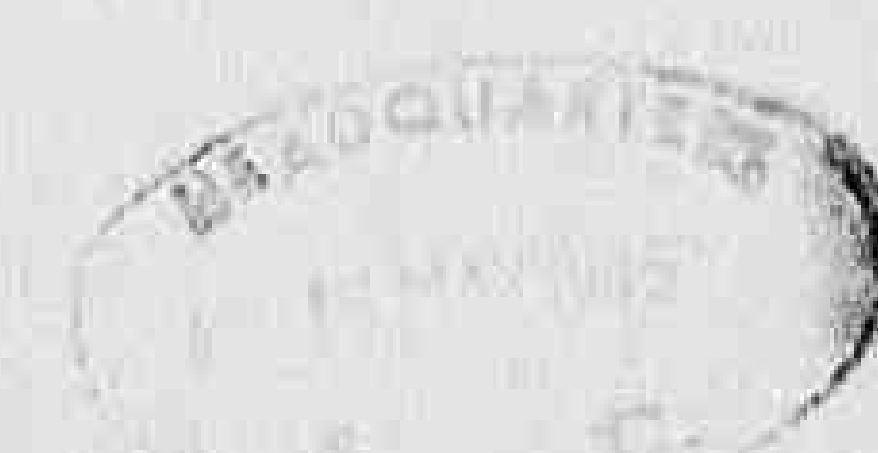
