1. Regulations for Release from the Army, 1945 paragraph 326 is being amended to permit voluntary deferment of release by Officers, Warrant Officers, Staff Sergeants and Sergeants of all arms for a period of six months calculated from the first day the Age/Service Group is due to be released.
2. The conditions of deferment for six months are identical with those now operative under GRC 541/45 but eligibility is at present restricted to personnel in Groups up to 35 inclusive.

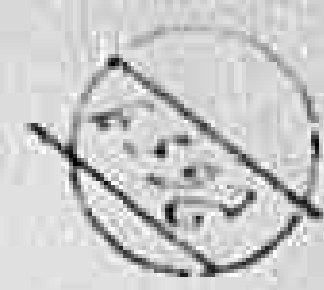

1. Regulations for Release from the Army, 1945, paragraph 326, is being amended, and the following conditions for deferment of release will apply.
2. An individual may now volunteer to continue serving in the Army for one of the following periods:
 - a) one year } calculated from the first day of the period
 - b) two years } in which his Age/Service Group is due to be released.
 - c) until general demobilization is ordered.
3. Applications will be forwarded in accordance with para 14 of ARHQ Release Instructions.
4. The confirming authority for both officers and ORs will continue to be laid down in paragraph 326 of Release Regulations, except in the following cases, when the War Office will confirm the retention of the individual:-
 - a) Officers of the rank of War Substantive Lieutenant Colonel and above.
 - b) Men who have rendered previous service on normal regular engagements in the Royal Navy, Army or Royal Air Force.
 - c) Men who are now serving on regular engagements.

5. Officers and ORs volunteering to continue to serve on the terms laid down in paragraph 2 above will make their applications on the forms attached at Appendices "B" and "C" respectively which will be substituted for Appendices "B" and "C" to ARHQ Release Instructions.

6. An officer or OR who before the publication of this order had submitted an application under paragraph 326 Release Regulations to continue to serve until general demobilization, may now rescind such application and volunteer instead to serve for one or two years. Those to whom this applies will submit a new application on Appendix "B" or "C" as the case may be and the words "CANCELLED ORIGINAL APPLICATION dated" will be written in red ink across the top of the form.

If no new application is received by the confirming authority by 30 June, 1945, the original application for retention until general demobilization

3. Applications will be forwarded in accordance with para 14 of AFHQ Release Instructions.
4. The confirming authority for both officers and GPs will continue to be laid down in paragraph 326 of Release Regulations, except in the following cases, when the War Office will confirm the retention of the individual:—
 - a) Officers of the rank of War Substantive Lieutenant Colonel and above.
 - b) Men who have rendered previous service on normal regular engagements in the Royal Navy, Army or Royal Air Force.
 - c) Men who are now serving on regular engagements.
5. Officers and GPs volunteering to continue to serve on the terms laid down in paragraph 2 above will make their applications on the forms attached at Appendices "g" and "v" respectively which will be substituted for Appendices "g" and "v" to AFHQ Release Instructions. 2429
6. An officer or OR who before the publication of this order had submitted an application under paragraph 326 Release Regulations to continue to serve until general demobilization, may now rescind such application and volunteer instead to serve for one or two years. Those to whom this applies will submit a new application on Appendix "g" or "v" as the case may be and the words "CANCELLING ORIGINAL APPLICATION dated" will be written in red ink across the top of the form.
7. If no new application is received by the confirming authority by 30 June, 1945, the original application for retention until general demobilization will stand.
8. An individual who volunteers to continue to serve for one or two years will become due for release at the earliest opportunity after the expiration of this period. He will not be liable for further retention under paragraphs 320 or 324 of the Release Regulations.
9. A volunteer may be released or discharged from the Army during his extended term of Service on medical or disciplinary grounds, or on grounds of inefficiency. He may apply for release on compassionate grounds. The same terms will apply, in these respects, to volunteers as to those who are awaiting release under Class "A".
10. A volunteer will be eligible for normal release and overseas service leave at the end of his extended term of service.
11. An individual will not in any way prejudice his rights under the Reinstatement in Civil Employment Act by volunteering to continue serving for

any of the periods prescribed in paragraph 2 above, but it must be clearly understood that the continuance of balance of civil salary or wages is a private matter between the individual and his employer, and that the rights of individuals under the Act do not extend to such matters.

11. Applications may now be made to continue to serve in the Army under the terms of paragraph 2 above by individuals in the following Age/Service Groups:-

- (a) Officers and ORs (men) in age/service groups 1 to 26 inclusive.
- (b) ATS and VAD in age/service groups 1 to 43 inclusive and married women of these services in any age/service group.

12. Separate instructions are being issued for officers, including women officers of the RMG, AD Corps, CMG, (R), TMS and TMS (R).

9. The following procedures will be adopted for the restriction of private correspondence:-

(a) GAC units will ensure that before leaving the unit all personnel complete a Re-direction Card for entries by the unit, giving one column in the UK to which all mail is to be forwarded. Such mail will not be re-directed to the Assembly Centre and personnel will be instructed that this column will not be used.

PAY.

All units should be warned that no lire, or be taken into the UK and that under the Defence (Finance) Regulations no person may take into the UK more than £10 sterling. Facilities will be made available immediately before embarkation for exchange of lire up to £10 sterling. Amounts in excess of £10 sterling must be surrendered to the Paymaster of the unit, and arrangements will be made to remit such amounts to the UK for credit to the individual's pay account.

(b) Cash Payments.

(1) The limitation on the amount of money which may be taken into the UK should be borne in mind by GAC units when making payments to GRs due to be passed to the Assembly Centre.

(2) For the same reason, arrangements should be made to regulate their cash drawings accordingly, prior to proceeding to the Assembly Centre.

ROUTING.

(a) As soon as the railway between LEVERNOY and GUYENNE is in operation, personnel arriving by rail will be routed to GUYENNE, where the Draft Conducting Officer or HCO will report to the HCO. Notification will be made of the opening of this line.

(b) Until the line from GUYENNE to GUYENNE is opened, personnel moving by rail will be routed to GUYENNE and then report to the HCO.

RELEASE- DISPATCH OF SURPLUS BAGGAGE OF OFFICERS AND OTHER RANKS

Officers.

1. The scale of personal baggage to accompany an officer returning to UK for release under Class "A" will be limited to 1 cwt, and NOT 2 cwt as stated in para 7 (b) of the above quoted GRC which will be amended accordingly.

2. Surplus baggage will be disposed of through the MILITARY FORWARDING ORGANISATION in accordance with the provisions enumerated in the paragraphs following:

3. Officers will take ALL their baggage within a maximum entitlement of 4 cwt to the Assembly Wing.

4. Before leaving the unit however the baggage will be sorted into two lots, viz:-

- (a) the maximum of 4 cwt to accompany the Officer on the journey, and
- (b) the surplus baggage to be forwarded through MFO. This baggage will be securely packed and marked in accordance with the instructions contained in para 5 of GRC 457/45.

5. On arrival at the Assembly Wing the baggage will be taken over by a representative of the MFO, a signed receipt issued to the consignee and a Customs Declaration Notice 28 completed in accordance with para 1 (d) of GRC 457/45.

6. All surplus baggage will be despatched in the same ship or convoy as the owners.

7. Presents, souvenirs, arms and ammunition, alcohol, etc, may NOT be forwarded by MFO. Articles of this nature will be included in the accompanied baggage and passed through Customs by the owner, the MFO portion being confined to personal kit, clothing and articles as defined in para 3 of GRC 457/45.

8. Other Ranks.

The scale of baggage to accompany an other rank is limited to the kit carried on the individual plus 56 lbs.

Any excess within a further limit of 56 lbs will be forwarded through MFO.

9. (a) Officers and other ranks shipping articles through the Military Forwarding Organisation are advised that such shipments are carried out entirely at their own risk, and that in the case of loss reimbursement will NOT be made except for that caused by enemy action.

(b) Attention of personnel forwarding surplus kit through the Military Forwarding Organisation to the UNITED KINGDOM is drawn to the insurance facilities available under AGI 94 of 20 Jan 45, details of which are given in GRC 297/45.

The only clothing that soldiers will be permitted to retain as their own property is not more than 4000 (four thousand) items from the Army, 1945, Appendix "A", Section 1, para 13, which is attached as Appendix "A" to this letter. All issues in excess of 4000 (four thousand) items, except in so far as deficiencies have been due to the exigencies of the situation, will be made to complete this scale. No charges will be made in respect of such issues.

(b) Officers will take to the Assembly Centre their personal arms and equipment. Personal baggage will be limited to 2-wt. Any baggage in excess of this quantity will be forwarded through HQ. Officers will make their own arrangements for disposal of any surplus baggage before leaving their units.

(c) Prior to departure of officers and GPs from units, kit will be checked and deficiencies noted on page 4 of AB 1003 (Release Book - Officers) and page 4 of AB 1004 (Release Book - GPs).

(d) Ammunition will not be carried.

SUBJECT : Conditions during Post-Hostilities Period. ALLIED FORCE HEADQUARTERS

G.1(B)/229/DAG

7 May 1945

1. It is probable that as soon as hostilities with GERMANY end, there will be certain expectations and anxieties in the minds of soldiers in this theatre. These will probably include:-

- (a) A desire on the part of those due for release to get home as quickly as possible;
- (b) An expectation, among those remaining in the theatre, of increased leave to the United Kingdom;
- (c) An anxiety amongst those who are not eligible for early release to know whether or not they are likely to be sent to the FAR EAST;
- (d) A hope that it may be possible to allow a certain number of families to join troops in areas of occupation in EUROPE.

It is of the utmost importance that during the period immediately following the end of hostilities with GERMANY, that troops should, as far as possible, be taken into the confidence of those in authority, and every effort made to explain the factors which govern the fulfilment of their hopes or fears. It should be made clear to them that their interests are closely watched and every reasonable step taken to secure those interests.

2. The main factor which conditions all post hostilities plans is that of shipping. There is a world wide shortage of personnel shipping, and in spite of the fact that the war with GERMANY is over, the claim on that type of shipping are increasing rather than decreasing.

Personnel shipping will be required for:-

- (a) amphibious operations, both British and American, during the war against JAPAN;
- (b) Re-deployment of British and American forces from EUROPE to the FAR EAST including Indian formations from EUROPE to INDIA;
- (c) Repatriation of British and American soldiers to their own countries for release. This includes repatriation of large numbers of Dominion and Colonial personnel, the direction of whose movement is entirely opposite to that of UK and US personnel;
- (d) Movement in connection with FIFTH, THIRD, SECOND, etc;
- (e) Miscellaneous movement of PA, displaced persons, etc.

3. In theory it is desirable that all the above movement should, if possible, be simultaneous, but, in fact, this is impracticable. Shipping

to join troops in areas of occupation in EUROPE.

It is of the utmost importance that during the period immediately following the end of hostilities with GERMANY, that troops should, as far as possible, be taken into the confidence of those in authority, and every effort made to explain the factors which govern the fulfilment of their hopes or fears. - (c) repatriation of British and American soldiers to their own countries for release. This includes repatriation of large numbers of Dominion and Colonial personnel, the direction of whose movement is entirely opposite to that of UK and US personnel; **2422**
- (d) Movement in connection with UNION, LING, LIAO, etc;
- (e) Miscellaneous movement of PW, displaced persons, civilians, etc.

3. In theory it is desirable that all the above movement should, if possible, be simultaneous, but, in fact, this is impracticable. Shipping is literally not available to compete with all these demands. Moreover, many of the ports which we would wish to use have been gravely damaged either by the enemy or by ourselves, mines have to be swept, wrecks cleared, and so on; for this reason there are likely to be, for some time, considerable limitations on berthing and loading or unloading ships, quite apart from the availability of the shipping itself.

4. The Army Council have, in consequence, found it necessary provisionally to define the priorities of certain classes of non-operational movements, which will considerably affect personnel in this theatre. This order of priority is as follows:-

- (a) Class 'A' Releases;
 - (1) By order of priority in Age and Service Groups;
 - (11) Within any particular Age and Service Group, on the basis of Age only;
- (b) Compensate cases for transfer to the Home Establishment, unless of

such exceptional urgency as to warrant priority over Class 'A' releases;

- (c) Delayed PITON personnel;
- (d) LIAOP personnel;
- (e) PITON personnel;
- (f) LIAF personnel;
- (g) Class 'B' releases.

The above order of priority may, of course, change from time to time.

5. It may be contended that troops in the Mediterranean theatre should not be dependent on the shipping for their movement; that facilities exist for rail and possibly air movement, which should be adequate to cope with the requirements of this theatre, for example, in respect of leave to the United Kingdom. The use of the railways in SUEZ is under active consideration, but it must be remembered that extensive demolitions and destruction of lines and rolling stock by bombing will seriously affect the capacity of these railways for some time; moreover, they will have many and extensive commitments to meet in SUEZ. As regards aircraft, there will be big demands for the way in the FAR EAST, and furthermore, there is a projected scheme for using aircraft to supplement shipping for carrying troops to the FAR EAST. It will thus be realized that it may be some time before we can extend the use of railways and aircraft to cover such requirements as leave, which must necessarily be given a lower priority than redeployment, release, PITON, etc. However, the whole question of movement in CENTRAL and WESTERN EUROPE has recently been the subject of conferences at SILEY and in LONDON at which much has been represented. It is hoped that it may be possible to issue some information on this before long.

6. As far as can be foreseen at present, assuming that 'A' pay will be the day on which releases start, the table shown below gives some idea of the probable progress of release. The date of sailing forward in GUP of the various release groups is likely to be some 3 weeks earlier than that shown in column (b) of the table below.

As far as can be foreseen at present, assuming that 'A' Day will be the day on which releases start, the table shown below gives some idea of the probable program of releases. The date of release is given in column (a) of the various release groups is likely to be some 5 weeks earlier than that shown in column (b) of the table below.

It will be noted from the above table that only some 6% of the total UK forces in GEF is likely to be released by 'A' + 6 months, and a very large proportion of this consists of officers. The high proportion of officers is due to the fact that early release groups include many 'veterans' of the last war and men in their 40's. The rate of release during the second 6 months is likely to be slightly accelerated, and numbers are much higher than those shown during the first 6 months; in addition, the proportion of officers to GIs drops very considerably. It is not possible yet to give any figures for the second 6 months on a percentage basis, since the theatre ceiling is bound to have decreased considerably by then.

It must be made clear to all concerned that the lack of personnel assignments is not the only factor which means limitations on the rate of release. Even if

it were feasible to move large bodies of troops home quickly, it would not be possible to absorb them immediately or satisfactorily into employment in the UK. It must obviously take some little time for the country to re-adjust itself to the change in conditions which will necessarily follow the defeat of GERMANY: any large-scale return of personnel to the UK must therefore be reasonably phased.

Finally, release as a whole must be conditioned by the need for retaining enough men to carry on the war against JAPAN. From such evidence as has been obtained up to date, the necessity for bringing this war to a quick and successful end is not seriously questioned.

7. As regards service in the PAR EAST, the target for the qualifying period for PYTHON at which we are aiming, is 3 years and 6 months. The Secretary of State for War has said in the House of Commons that he would like to see the global qualifying period reduced to 3 years; this must be regarded as a hope, and NOT as a promise. So long as the proportion of the British (UK) Army serving overseas materially exceeds that serving at home, it is doubtful whether the manpower situation will allow the turn over under PYTHON to be based on a qualifying period of 4 years, or a few months less, in the PAR EAST, and 4 to 4½ years elsewhere.

The criterion of eligibility for service in the PAR EAST is that no one should be sent there who has less than one year to serve on arrival. This rules out all personnel in Release Age/Service Groups 1-26, and, under the most optimistic hopes of a reduction in the qualifying period for PYTHON, might be deemed to rule out all personnel who have been abroad for just under 2 years. For this reason 1 year 9 months service abroad has been taken by the War Office, for the time being, as a limit above which an individual is not eligible for service in the PAR EAST. If the qualifying period for PYTHON in the PAR EAST remains at a few months less than 4 years, then the limit of 1 year and 9 months service abroad might be raised to 2 years and 6 months.

The fact that an individual is eligible does not necessarily mean that he will be posted to the PAR EAST. An indication of the formations and units required from CEF for the PAR EAST, viz, 3 Indian Divisions, plus certain additional units, has already been given in para 6 of AFHQ letter CH/229/V.1(Pr) dated 15 Apr 45. The filling up of these formations and units will not necessarily use up all eligibles of all arms in CEF. Those who are taken will, as far as possible, be selected with due regard to their battle service, i.e., those with the most battle service will be taken last.

The War Office have ruled that, no matter how long or how **2421** period they have been overseas, all British service personnel are to have 28 days leave in the UK before being sent to the PAR EAST. GHQ INDIA have ruled that all British personnel of the Indian Army who have been less than 3½ years overseas shall receive 28 days leave in the UK; all those who have been more than 3½ years shall receive 61 days, unless they have, within the last year of their service, proceeded on UK leave under the Indian Army leave schemes.

1. Owing to the rapid advances of the Armies in N. Italy, culminating in the simultaneous occupation of the four industrialized Northern Regions, and to the call up at the same time of officers for the Austria team, the Allied Commission is faced with a serious problem with regard to officer personnel.
2. It must be apparent to all that in the present circumstances the reduction in officer strength in the Northern Regions cannot be contemplated for many weeks. Therefore, the question of the immediate release of British officers under the early age service group has had to be seriously considered at this Headquarters, and I am reluctantly compelled to make recommendation to A.E.H.Q. for the temporary retention of the large majority of British officers, who normally would be eligible for almost immediate release.

3. In favourable circumstances it is anticipated the present emergency will, to some extent, be eased within the next 3 months, but, based on this, we intend to recommend that the majority of British officers eligible for immediate release be retained until 31 July 45 under para. 3 of the Release Regulations, which is the paragraph dealing with "operational necessity".

4. At the same time it is realized that this may occasion cases of hardship to certain officers whose civilian livelihood may be involved. To meet this possibility a board of senior officers has been set up at this Headquarters to examine all applications for immediate release, on domestic or business grounds, of those officers who come under the age service group 1 to 7.

5. Will you please inform all British officers of this decision and instruct those wishing to put their cases forward under para. 4 above to do so **BEFORE**.

1. Release Regulations have now been amended to permit individuals to volunteer to continue service as follows:-

(a) Until general demobilization.

(b) For one year beyond normal time of release.

(c) For two years beyond normal time of release.

2. Individuals volunteering for one or two years will not be liable for further retention on operational grounds.

3. Volunteers will be subject to normal release leave (including overseas leave) at the end of their extended term.

4. Those who have already volunteered until general demobilization will be allowed to change to the terms in para 1 (b) and (c) above.

5. Applications are now acceptable from individuals in Army/Service Groups 1 - 26 (men) and 1 - 43 (women), but immediate action is only required in Army/Service Groups 1 - 7 who have not already volunteered and who now wish to do so for one or two years.
