1. The following is the text of a memo received from GH, GHF:-

"It is obvious that numbers of reinforcements sufficient to maintain even a reasonable standard of efficiency will not be made available to UK in future. All are therefore warned that present holders of WO and WOC clerk appointments cannot be replaced from resources other than their own if allowed to proceed on release or F.I.G.I.

"Although existing training facilities will continue to produce clerks of 1st grade, only in exceptional cases need we be expected to find material suitable to assume supervisory appointments. GH are reluctantly compelled to accept necessity for immediate D.O.V. action in respect of WO clerks and WOC clerks in key appointments. Nevertheless these WO's and WOC's will only be D.O.V. in cases where replacements are impossible to find and always on an individual basis".

2. Bearing in mind the fact that the provision of re-inforcements for senior clerks in Allied Commission is now almost impossible, you should consider whether or not it is necessary to initiate D.O.V. action in the case of the clerks serving at your H.Q. or in your Branch. Applications for D.O.V. action will be submitted to G-1(Br) this H.Q. on Appendix 'A' to GH Release Instructions 1945.

1. Letter AG 220.8/622 P-O, Hq MTOUSA, dated 3 December 1945 and enclosure No. 1 thereto indicates that it is desired to employ soldiers eligible for discharge as civilian employees.

2. It is requested that each unit and staff section concerned immediately submit a report as to what positions in their respective unit or section can best be filled by American civilians. All persons in the military service who, under existing regulations are eligible for discharge, are eligible for employment by the United States Army. Detailed information may be secured from Civilian Procurement Division, Adjutant General's Section, Hqs, Southern District, Peninsular Base Section, APO 782.

3. Positions to be filled include clerical positions, all types, 2485 and selected administrative and technical positions.

4. Report will be made not later than 13 December 1945 to this headquarters as to what positions in the units or staff sections can best be filled by American civilians. These positions will then be reported for analysis to the Civilian Procurement Division.

TO : Distribution: below

1. It is desired to plan for the replacement, by civilians, of British Other Rank personnel in this HQ.
2. Will you, therefore, please make a survey of Other Rank posts ²⁴⁸³ can be civilianized and forward your recommendations to this Branch giving the following information:-
 - (a) Qualifications of individuals or groups of individuals by equivalent army ranks, e.g. general duty clerks, shorthand typists, statisticians, office supervisors, specialists, etc.
 - (b) Any particular post which can be filled by an Italian civilian as opposed to a British civilian.
3. It will be assumed that civilians can be provided in equivalent army ranks from Private to V.O.I.
4. Please base your calculations on the phased programme assuming that our Sub-Commissions will remain very approximately at the same strength as at present for 3 months, but will then gradually decrease over a period of a further 3 months as responsibilities are handed back to the Italian Government.
