- 4 This Section has no knowledge of any of the facts but is merely passing on the information it has received for such action if any as may appear appropriate.

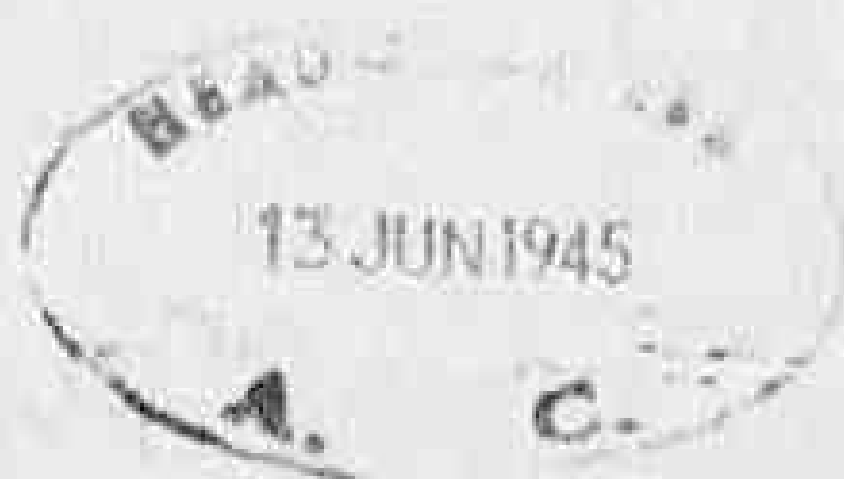

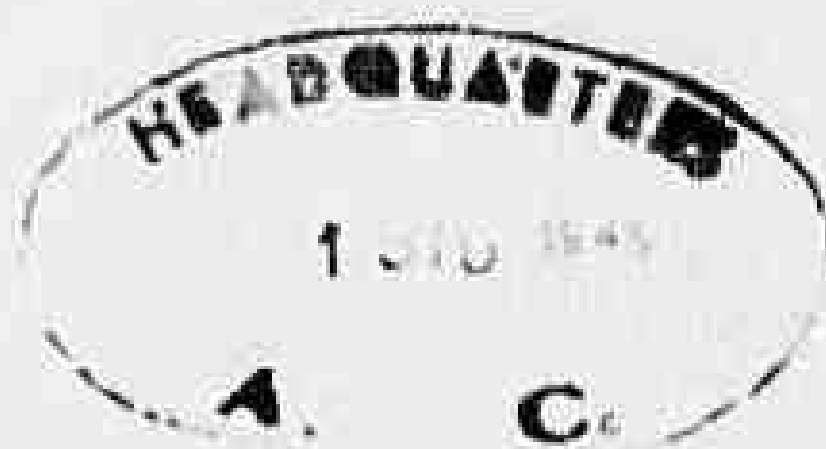

2. There are no indications, however, that there is any large scale attempt in Occupied Italy to set up a government separate from the present Italian government at the moment of liberation.

We wish to communicate for your timely information that telegram no. 1186 of 20 Jan. was never sent to the prefects of the provinces under the AMG administration until now. Art.12 of the D.L. no 2 of 4 of this month orders the prefects of every province, in conjunction with three delegates of the High Commission for sanctions against fascism, to prepare the investigation material relative to the employees to be referred to trial by the epuration Commission. In reference to a similar request made to the Assistant High Commissioner I wish to inform your excellencies that it was agreed with the Provincial Delegate of the High Commissioner, after consulting the local Committee for National Liberation, that two more persons must be designated to complete the number of delegates. If no one has been designated as delegate yet, three names must naturally be submitted. It is necessary that the persons proposed must be competent and of a spotless character. The proposals must be sent at the earliest date and not later than the day after the receipt of this telegram. S/ BONCHI

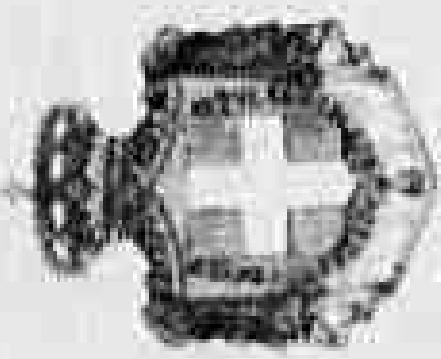

Excellency,

the writer is the man in the street, the true Italian endowed with common sense, who has been suffering four years, who does not concern himself with politics and only wishes for tranquillity peace and safety for his country.

It would be terrible if we had to regret the fascist regime, as we are doing now, because of the work of the two left parties, led by ambitious and demagogic factions which will bring civil war to Italy.

For the good Italian, the true Italian, the Allies mean salvation. The Allies must for the second time save Italy from the clutches of criminals who are not even in good faith, like Nenni, Togliatti, Saragat, Scoccimarro, who disorganized what little was left of the administration of the State.

But what I want to point out is the attitude of the press of the left towards the Allies.

Nenni who is a kind of second duce speaks venomously about the Allies making a thousand insinuations, and his article of today rails at the Allies and at their vetoes, accusing them of being the cause of trouble in Italy. He concludes his article by saying: "we are the order!"

It is not admissible that such language should be used about the Allies. The Italian nation can but blame such stupid arrogance which might in the end deprive us of the sympathy of the Allies, who, being able to do so, should forbid such publications which are prejudicial to the interests of Italy, and therefore to those of the Allies too.

As long as these men can be found in Italy, it will prove that it isn't able to administer itself. We need a government that isn't a Government of parties a military government, or the government of the Allies. This would be a thousand times better than having civil war, which will be worse than it ever was.

In reference to Churchill's speech and particularly to the great principles which safeguard the life and liberty of the individual against all the forms of tyranny under which ever aspect and with whatever slogan they wish to appear, I wish to bring the following to your attention:

Are these the "forms and principles of justice, the guarantees of life and liberty of the individual and of the systems capable of preventing the disaster of internal strife" mentioned in the speech of the English Prime Minister? Meanwhile, the honor, the individual liberties, the vital interests of innumerable families are thus sacrificed to the thirst of ruthless vengeance of extremists, and thus is hatred and misery disseminated

after so many national catastrophes, while none of the Italian Government authorities has the desire or the power to intervene.

The Regina Coeli jails are full of prisoners who are more or less in the same circumstances. Hence the intervention of the Allied military authorities is requested, on the whole general procedure and especially in the case of the special tribunal, particularly because the latter involves public figures worthy of consideration for the probity and integrity of actions and intentions which they have exercised throughout their not brief existence.

It must finally be noted that not one of the accused in question has followed the so-called fascist republic, by which some have even been persecuted and jailed for their decisively contrary attitude.

The following message was passed to you for information and such action as you may consider necessary. The message concerned a Mr. Raphael DUCESNOIS and was given to Provincial Commissioner [redacted].

Having passed the front at Telle, Arzano, where he was interned, Mr. Raphael DUCESNOIS, born and residing in Florence, class 1920 (9) 2nd Dec Legio da Train, section Couriers - Extraordinary Co 1st has presented himself to us declaring that he is German. He knew what his obligations are toward his military authorities.

Incorporated the 3rd of September 1946 described the 19th of July 1946 - a relation of these facts that had not had a reply has been sent by our means the 9th of August past."
