TO: THE ALLIED MILITARY GOVERNMENT
HIGH COMMISSION FOR SANCTIONS AGAINST FASCISM

10 July 1945

The undersigned, ROGANI Riccardo, son of Federico, residing in Crocia (Cosenza), wishes to expound the following facts to the High Commissioner for sanctions against fascism:

I was illegally arrested in September 1943, under the charge of outrage and slander, by certain local authorities who were once ardent supporters and followers of fascism and who still have the power in their own hands in Crocia, under the protection of officials in the Rossano Tribunal. After a year in prison, I hoped to be released by an order of amnesty. But instead, although others involved in the same trial obtained their release through the action of corrupt, vehement former fascist officials, I was detained in prison and my trial postponed. After twenty years continual suffering under the fascist regime, my repeated appeals to the provincial authorities, to the Ministry and to the Allied Authorities are rejected or pushed aside.

I therefore earnestly request the Allied Commission to consider my case and take the measures so urgently called for, against those employees and officials of Crocia who, although once fascists, are still holding their former positions and taking unjust measures against their fellow citizens.

My husband, Pacini Foscariño, son of Alessio, born in 1923, together with many other men following a round up of the Germans was forced to enlist in the fascist republican guard and follow the fascist government north. When the republican army dissolved my husband was taken prisoner by the Allied troops on 30 April 1945 and detained in Piacenza. He was later released since no evidence of crime existed. When he returned to his home town, Montorio al Vomano in May he was arrested by the local partisan squads and interned in the Teramo jail where he is at present.

I therefore earnestly beg you to take this case into consideration and have my husband released as soon as possible.

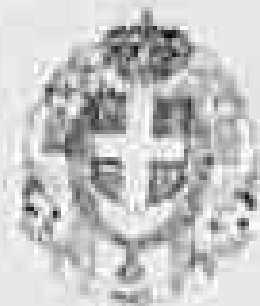

Flebani affirms also that he learnt later that the "ministre" was produced at Castella Castigliani on the property of Corradetti. Of this he was informed by three disoriented soldiers (D'Angelo Antonio, Prevanti Nicola and Collette Antonio) who were passing one day over the property of Corradetti and saw the wine distillery which worked day and night and, strangely enough, they were given two bottles of "vino". Dr. Corradetti still buys and holds all the goods he can and places them in the custody of his farmers, whom it is said, he has supplied with arms. He is a villain and a true reactionary, not only politically but with a view to protecting his illegally gained profits. He is disliked by all the town for his selfish spirit and total lack of charity.

The member Alessi Aristide declared that he agrees in every point with the distillation of the wine, of which he had no knowledge.

1. I visited the Bishop today and explained to him what is being done as to each of the points he raised in his letter. The visit was cordial and ended up in his asking for cement and lime and bricks to help rebuild his churches, as he has about 120 churches under his care. This, of course, is tied up with our inability to furnish cement in such quantities as we would like to have it. Then he asked if he could get a truck all for his own use. It is readily seen that as much as we would like to help, our means are limited. I believe that the Bishop was satisfied that everything is being done from our standpoint. He was particularly pleased about the mine removers who have arrived and also about the distribution of horses which will help the transport and work problems.

2. This particular Bishop is given to complaining, as he had written to Rome and once gave an interview which criticized the troops around Faenza for alleged wasting of wine, etc, and that people were evacuated from their homes. This, of course, was due to military necessity.

3. I believe, however, that he will be patient now. I shall try to see him from time to time and keep him informed.

In reference to the communication sent me by the Civil Affairs Section, I am sending you the enclosed 13 letters notifying Senators residing in Northern Italy or interned, of epuration proceedings against them and request you to see that they are delivered.

As I pointed out in a previous letter the Allied Offices could, in my opinion, entrust the Procure Generali del Regno with the delivery, or else the various Committees of Liberation, or better still the Committee of National Liberation of Northern Italy. The letters might even be delivered to each person concerned with return receipt.

Moreover, each senator should send as a certificate (judicial officer's report or a receipt) to be enclosed with their notes. I should then have to rely on the Allied Commands to send the notes of the senators to this Office which would see that they were forwarded to the High Court of Justice.

His Excellency the High Commissioner has denounced you to this High Court of Justice for the declaration of removal from the position of Senator under art 8 of D.L. 159 of 27 July 1944.

You are accused of the charges in the Sixth Group of the request, as follows:

Sixth Group: composed of those senators who have not helped to keep fascism alive under the groups and in the offices indicated above, but who are found to be responsible for the same offence and made war possible either by their votes or by individual acts, including propaganda in and outside the Senate, let alone the fact that some were appointed without sufficient qualification.

The documents concerning you are deposited in the Chancellery of the High Court of Justice where they will remain for fifteen days from that in which you receive the present notification. You have the right to inspect the documents collected or appoint a person to do so, and to lodge a written defense and documents within the same time limit.

Your arguments of defense may be lodged through the medium of the judicial offices of the place in which you are residing, which will see that they are forwarded, if necessary, by the Allied Authorities.

Monsignor Giuseppe Battaglia, Bishop of FAREZZA, with a letter addressed to this Ministry, reports on the very sad state of the population of that area where the war has left marked traces. Moreover, he suggests that competent technicians be sent there, considering the particular gravity of the situation, in order to adopt the necessary measures which will remove the greatest difficulties in the way of the reconstruction.

He suggests that the following measures be taken immediately:

- * 1. A specialised corps should be sent to clear the land of mines, of which the farmers are justly terrified since the number of accidents caused by them is mounting into hundreds. I am told that many farmers are thinking of not returning to their land, which would be a serious setback to the agriculture of this area and to national economy.
- * 2. Special financial aid should be sent without the delay due to long official formalities. The aid should be generous in view of the extent of the destruction. Material should be sent for rebuilding houses and churches, at least the parish churches, for none can be found here.
- * 3. Tractors or oxen must be supplied for ploughing, as well as other farming equipment.
- * 4. Temporary shelter must be found or made for the many ^{35,000} persons while rebuilding is in progress, in order to lessen the dangers and harm due to whole families living each in a single room.
- * 5. Medicinals and dressing material are urgently needed. Contagious diseases will be inevitable after such suffering and undernourishment, and after so many troops were stationed here for so long.

As the Province of Ravenna, to which the Diocese of FAREZZA belongs, is still under Allied Military Government, we refer the request of Mons. Battaglia to your Commission, trusting you will give it every possible consideration and support.
