As a member of the Commission of Epuration of 1st Instance for the "Federazione Italiana Consiglieri Agrari", I should like to report to you the following matters:

- 1) That this Commission of epuration has met only twice since 21 July, and at one of those meetings it passed no judgment.
- 2) That the Administration of the above-mentioned Federation, and in particular the Commissioner Sig. Spezzano (communist) and one of the Vice Commissioners, Sig. Piacentini (socialist), make use of members of their own party who are in the civil service in order to corrupt the epuration proceedings. This interference is to be seen especially in the proceedings regarding Visco, despite it being known that the record of Visco was purposely torn. (enclosures 1, 2, 3).

I have been forced to observe how difficult it is to epurate the fascists who have the true spirit of the regime, and how any attempt to resist such injustice only brings threats and reprisals. On 21 August last I wrote to the Ministry of Agriculture informing them of the matter but without reply. Possibly the Minister of Agriculture is the same colour as the Commissioner of the Federation. Now I ask if this situation in which factional persons impose their will over honest, impartial citizens can be allowed to continue against the democratic principles of government of which our country is so much in need and for which the Allies have fought and won.

I have enclosed a copy of the letter mentioned and a list of the violations committed by Commissioner Spezzano. SENTENCE AGAINST VISCO

This Commission, at its meeting of 13 July, examined the case of Dr. Giovanni VISCO and took the following decision:

Visco Giovanni has been subjected to expiation proceedings for having held the position of Federal administrative inspector at Taranto. This position alone is sufficient to justify the sanction of art. 12 of Law 159 of 27 July 1944. The Commission deems it desirable to point out the following matters:

A) In the records of Visco regarding his family status, it is reported that he held the position of Federal administrative inspector of the Federazione dei Padri di Catanzaro.

Sig. Prigorio Angelo, official of the Federazione Italiana dei Consonni Agrari, declared that he received these particulars from sources which he is not now in a position to specify and which have been reported to him verbally.

B) There is a sheet among his records which gives the particulars of his professional activity and management. This sheet in turn and evidently the part removed must have shown his fascist merits.

C) In October 1944 Visco was promoted to the 2nd category of 1st grade managers, by order of the Commissioner of the Federazione Italiana Consonni Agrari, Avv. Francesco Spazzano, with effect from two years before the date of the order. Avv. Spazzano, questioned by this Commission, declared that he made the order for Visco's personal reference and in view of his professional capacity, but that he ignored the past political activity of Visco, not having consulted his records, and considered him to have nothing against him as he had been appointed Commissioner of the Consonno Agrario of Cosenza since the fall of Fascism.

For these motives

The Commission proposes that Visco be removed from his position.

This decision has been taken by Cons. Cassazione Piermonti, Signor LaBd JJ
Morara and Vincenzo Cavallaro.

HIGH COMMISSION FOR REVISIONS AGAINST FASCISM

SUBJECT: Arguments against appeal for revision of sentence against Visco.

TO : THE COMMISSION OF REPARATION

1) In his records, Visco declared that he held the position of: Federal Administrative Inspector of the fascist federation of Catanzaro, federal inspector of Taranto, head of Prices Office in the fascist federation of Taranto, etc. etc. Commander.

It is hardly likely therefore that he did not accept the first position, or he would not have had it registered.

2) Visco omitted to declare these positions in the questionnaire for expiation purposes (except that of head of the Prices Office). The part of the record which has been torn off concerns precisely his political activity.

- 5) He had Dr. Alberto Strighi appointed Commissioner of the Consorzio Agrario di Littoria, in spite of knowing him to be accused of collaboration with the Germans (the trial is pending before the High Commissioner for expatriation and the High Commission for the punishment of fascist crimes);
- 6) He favoured Dr. Zeffiro Petrogrande by not presenting to the Commission of 1st instance all the evidence against him (denounced by sig. Corinaldesi for bad custom);
- 7) He engaged accountant Ferretto Filippo and Rodini Alfonso, subjected to expatriation trial before the Commission for expatriation for bad custom, collaboration and adherence to fascism;
- 8) Violated art 17 of the law on expatriation by re-engaging some thirty employees who went north with the Italian social republic, without adding or receiving authorization of the Deputy High Commissioner for Expatriation;
- 9) Denounced Dr. Giovanni Durante to the High Commissioner for expatriation shortly after appointing him Governing Commissioner for the Consorzio Agrario di Soanese (his own city);
- 10) He annulled some of the measures taken during the anti-fascist designation, although such measures should be null in accordance with D.L. of 3 October 1945.

1. Although Italian Nationals, Neo-Fascists and members of the Republican Army who are confined in Prisoners Camps for which the guards are provided by the Italian Ministry of War they are not necessarily Military Prisoners.

2. This HQ does not therefore agree with the proposals in your above quoted letter that enquiries concerning such persons should be passed to Ministry of War, through M.M.I.A. ; but is of the opinion that such enquiries should be dealt with through Public Safety Sub Commission, by Ministry of the Interior who should undertake any liaison with other Ministries as may be found necessary.

3. The terms of reference of M.M.I.A. lay down that this HQ is responsible for passing to the Ministry of War the Commands of A.F.H.Q. in so far as they concern the present Italian Army. - 1 It is felt that as enquiries about Italians in Allied hands are addressed to the AFIC (Provost), as enquiries about Italians in custody guarded by the Italian Army should be channelled through Land Forces to the Ministry of War, as it would not be appropriate for other branches to approach that Ministry.

The High Commissioner for sanctions against fascism has denounced you to the High Court of Justice, asking for your removal from office in accordance with art 8 of MIL 159 of 27 Jul 1944.

The charges advanced against you are those referred to in group 3 of the proposal for your removal. Two categories of senators come within this Group, including those senators whose appointment was not ratified by the Plenary Assembly of the Senate.

Hence only those who have held their office unlawfully should be removed. However, since the law which we must apply is not a law of epuration of the Senate but one of punishment, we must consider the date and the circumstances of the appointment of this group of senators. They were appointed on 6 Feb 1943, that is, during the war, with the evident purpose of strengthening the Senate with the admission of new fascists which followed the dictator and his warlike policy.

Therefore they all fall under the sanctions of the law; the removal from their position must be declared for this reason.

To the above must be added the Senators who were deputies or national councillors after 1929 and were admitted into the Senate after having supported the fascist regime and the war in the Alta Camera.

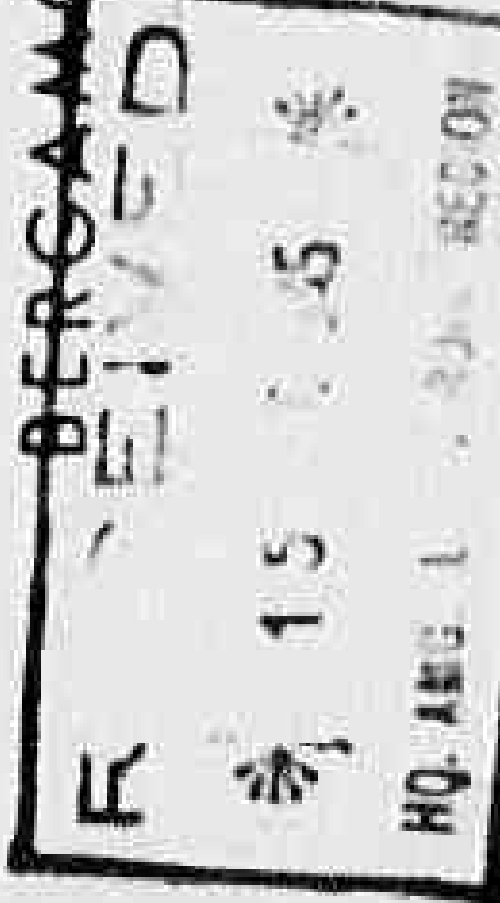
The file concerning your case is in the Chancellery of the High Court of Justice and it will be kept there for a period of 15 days beginning from the date of the communication of the present.

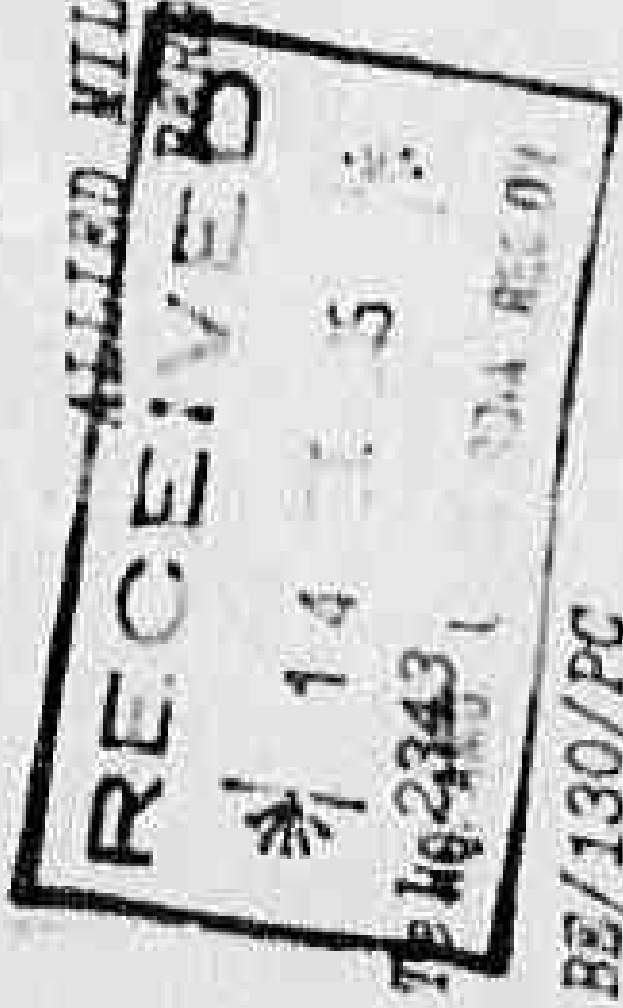

Giovanni ALESSI fu Pasquale, aged 82, residing in Taurinova (Reggio Calabria) about 60 years ago received from Marchese Genovese Zerbi Paolo a farm of olive-grove on a metayer basis; with the permission of the Marchese he planted vineyards in the farm and payed for all the required improvements. After 29 years Marchese Zerbi has deprived the farmer of half of his land without reimbursing him the expenses for the said improvements; moreover, it seems that he intends to evict the farmer from the entire property.

Giovanni Alessi appealed to the civil tribunal of Palmi and after many years was informed that the tribunal had passed a decision in his favor; however, the Marchese Zerbi has sued him in Catanzaro in the name of his mother, Marchesa Zerbi.

At present the old man is unable to leave his home since he is suffering from chronical bronchitis and rheumatic pains and unable to pay the expenses of the proceeding because of his very poor conditions. The Allied Commission is therefore asked to see that Sig. Giovanni Alessi be granted the indemnity for the expenses which can be certified by a legal expert.

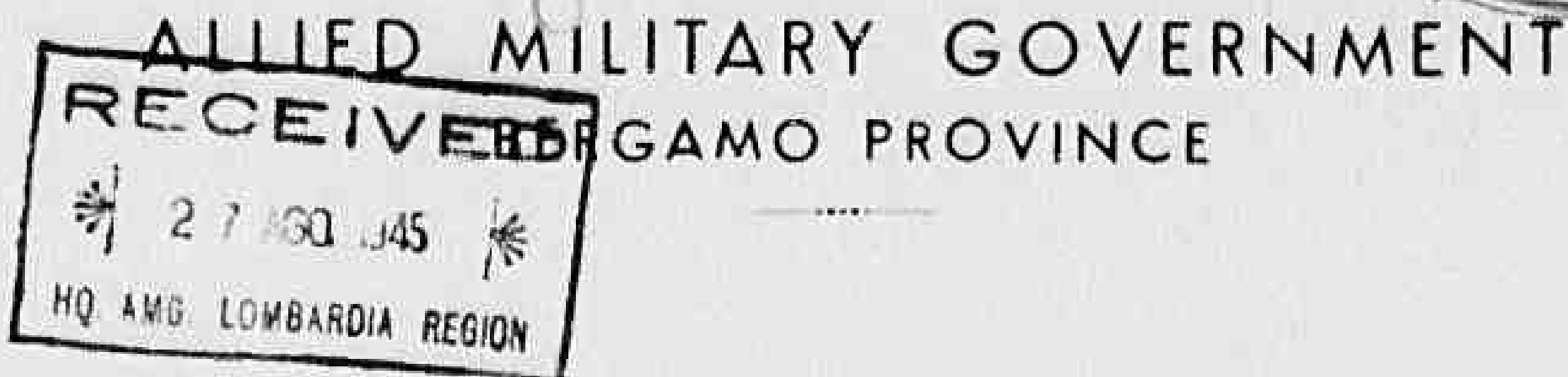

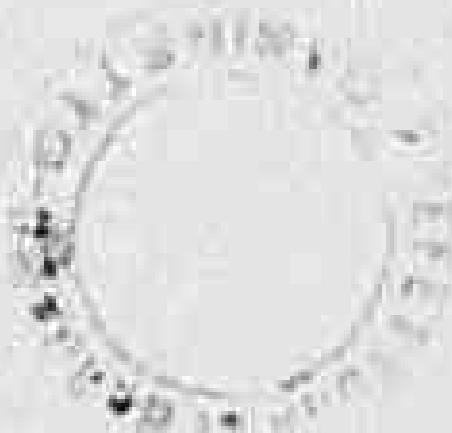

Sir,

I take the liberty of asking you to read the enclosed memorandum. It contains enough material to judge impartially my work as an Italian and an ex-fascist. Favourable to the intervention, I am a veteran of the 1915-1918 war which I fought at the side of the Allies. At 16, I enlisted as a volunteer in the Italian army against the Germans, but I was arrested by the Livorno questura. After 1918, chaos reigned in Italy and the nation turned against the veterans, disabled soldiers and volunteers guilty of having fought with the Allies.

A great number of the rioters of that time are now accusing me. It was necessary to safeguard victory and make the most of the veterans; I became fascist to bring back some order to Italy which seemed doomed to ruin.

I have always been in good faith, served gratuitously and obeyed because I am a soldier, but I never killed nor had anyone killed.

It isn't my fault if the fascist leaders made mistakes; they betrayed our good faith and led us to disaster. Today, my personal enemies try to strike me by every means; I am unable to defend myself, considering the position in which I am, and I cannot find anyone who has the courage to speak up for me.

In the name of my family, I appeal to you, asking for your interest in the matter, and for liberty, to be able to collaborate in the reconstruction of the country.

I offer my services to the Allies as technician.

The charge, besides that of collaborating with the enemy, was to have been present when torture was inflicted to a partisan, Mr. Badino Luciano (art. 51). The Supreme Court of Milan refused the appeal.

The charge was made by a certain Dr. Lando, who, it seems, belonged to the local black brigades, and is supposed to have saved himself in time by playing the double game. It appears that the arrest of Badino took place by order of Lando who sent two soldiers to arrest him. It seems that the part played by Dr. Lando has now been discovered and that he has been arrested.

Among the documents of the trial, there is a statement by Badino (who was tortured) saying that Mr. Prisco who simply attended the torture, helped him as much as his strength allowed him to, (Prisco has only one lung) to go up stairs and nursed him in a brotherly way.

All the documents show how human Prisco was, and how little on the side of the enemy. There are documents stating the following facts:

The black brigades sequestered the truck of a woman (whose name we do not at present remember); the poor woman appealed in vain to superior officers to recover the truck or get an indemnity; she met Prisco by chance and explained her case; disinterestedly, he did all he could and finally obtained an indemnity of L. 40.000 for her.

The Gbi and the De Micheli Firms of Genoa hid four or five young draft delinquents; Prisco knew this fact and the people in question, but he never denounced them.

A few partisans and also a few friends of Prisco sank a few crafts in the Genoa harbour, for sabotage; Prisco knew all about this and about the people; not only did he not denounce them, but also he did all he could not to have them suspected.

Prisco became a member of the Black Brigades because he had to choose between being sent to Germany or becoming a member of the black Brigades; he chose this second solution which was less prejudicial to him, for thus, he remained with his fiancée, who is now his wife, and he was able to go on helping his own family.

In the Black Brigades, Prisco was in charge of the foraging and never participated in any razzia, patrolling or perquisition. A young man of 30, Prisco comes of a numerous family of 10 children. He is the eldest, and ever since he was 15, he gave all his earnings to support the family, helping also his sister who is housed in the Materdomini nursing home, and sacrificing

himself in every way. While doing service in the Milizia Portuaria, he used to bring his meals home to help his family.

It must be remembered he did all this in spite of his bad health. Prisco has one lung only, for he had the operation of pneumothorax to his left lung. All this proves that he is a morally and socially sound young man; this is true for, having seen that the milieu was against his moral and social principles, he asked to be allowed to go, claiming that his health was bad; as a matter of fact, he saw a doctor in the S. Martino Hospital in Genoa but was only given a months leave.

Prisco's family is poor but has very sound ^{and straightforward} principles; he cannot have modified them for he was very much attached to them.

Three of his brothers took part in the war:

Nicandro of the 1916 class died in Greece

Armando of the 1920 class, is still doing service with the Allies in the Air Force; he was a partisan with Colonel Canago.

Antonio of the 1922 class is still doing service with the Allies, as soldier.

Prisco Manfredi is married and has a baby daughter of 35 days; the priest who blessed the marriage stated in writing that it was most extraordinary that a young man of such sound moral and religious principles could have belonged to the Black Brigades.

The courage and clear conscience of Prisco are well shown by his love for his family and small daughter as well as by the fact that he does not grasp the tragical seriousness of his position.

In the Marassi prison of Genoa, everyone likes him, as can be ascertained by asking.

Without drawing any conclusion, these facts speak for themselves.

So much Italian blood has already been shed! Now clemency cannot but benefit everybody.
