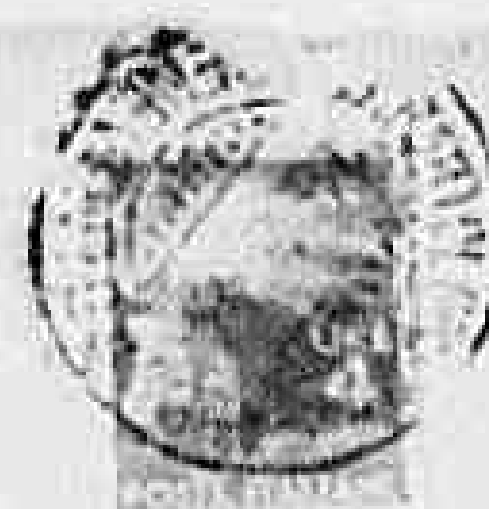

TRANSMISSION

Umbriatico, 13 August 1946

To: Honorable Allied Supreme Command - Caserta

I, the undersigned, Giovanni Giuranna, son of the late Luigi, born in 1897, am an U.S. ex-citizen and a veteran of World War I when I, as a member of the U.S. Army saw service at Hendon, London, attached to a British Unit. On that occasion I received a message bearing King George 5th's autograph signature, a copy of which is herein inclosed.

Being in Italy since a long time and having achieved a teacher's diploma I have taught in a grammar-school for four years at a stretch.

Being about to renew my application to obtain a provisional professorship for the current term, I learned that priority would be given to veterans of the war 1940-43 not to those of World War I. This means that the Allies and the volunteers of the German war will be given priority on the veterans of the glorious World War I.

Such being the state of affairs to whom am I to apply?

When the lot of the civilized nations was at stake I volunteered for service with the Americans and the English. Now that my own existence is at stake I refuse to believe that the representatives of the two great victorious Nations will not heed the prayer of the old veteran who did never ask anything and is now pleading that justice be done to him.

Therefore I am begging you to well understand my case and to timely intervene with the Catanzaro Provveditore urging him to allow me to participate in the examinations for a grammar-school professorship.

I have fine qualification; in fact I have a good teaching background and am a war displaced and stricken person and a head of family as well.

I trust that your Command will not forget, for so little, a person who performed his duties as an honest citizen in silence along with the soldier who fought for justice and civilization.

Licata 24 September, 1946

To: The Allied Force Headquarters
Caserta -

I, the undersigned, Angelo Cosentino, inform you that on 22 August I forwarded an application to your Command but so far no reply has been sent to me.

As I told you in my former letter on 10 February 1920, I was hired as a laborer by the Locomotive-Depot of Licata and dismissed on 31 December 1922 on the grounds of having participated in the strike of 1922.

On 28 July 1943 I was hired by the Allied Authorities but as soon as the railways were turned over to the Italian Administration, I was once again dismissed inasmuch as my work had been discontinued. I, a veteran of the First World War and many friends of mine as well, have been replaced by fascist elements. I have forwarded an application to the General Directorate in Rome and to the Cospartimental Office of Palermo but no consideration has been paid to my case because the offices are still run by fascists who gave me the great bounce. Herewith inclosed is my pass issued me by the American Headquarters attesting to the work I performed on behalf of the Allies.

I am applying to your Command in the hope that you will take into consideration my case.

I am Angela Pira, presently working at level-crossing No. 46 located along the railway Montecatini Licata-Agrigento. I have been holding this post for about 18 years and I have always worked in malaria zones; I am the mother of 8 children. A son of mine died in 1939 having contracted pernicious malaria.

I was lately transferred to the Trunk No 45 which is located in a zone badly infested with malaria. I have forwarded many applications to the Directorate in Palermo in order to obtain the trunk 44 but no consideration has been paid to my case. Lately this trunk was assigned to Mr. Cosentino who is completely unskilled as regards level-crossings and in addition has been a member of the Fascist Militia until the Allies landed in Sicily.

In the hope that you will take into benevolent consideration my case, I thank you wholeheartedly.

I want to point out to you that my son Giuseppe Gardone, was formerly working in the Railways Branch. When Italy declared war on Germany he joined the Italian fighting-groups to drive the Germans out of Italy. The Italian Authorities refused to give him an employment inasmuch as he abandoned his post in order to join the "Cremona" Division.

I, the undersigned, Vincenzo DI NUZZO, son of the late Giulio and of Pasqualina Elia, born at Maddaloni on 22 July 1906, a resident thereof on Via Maddalena No. 5, am applying to your Headquarters for the following:

On 9 March 1944, while I was working as a foreman in the American ammunition depot of Acerra, I was seriously injured from the blast of an explosive device so as to have my left hand amputated.

Following this accident while working, I have been granted a monthly pension of 750 lire which is not even enough to buy the daily bread for my family, composed of 3 tender-aged children and my wife. They are living in the most dire financial conditions, as I have been unemployed since the accident.

Therefore I beg your Headquarters to kindly pay benevolent consideration to my case and to make arrangements so that I may be granted a subsidy.

Further I beg you to intervene with the Italian Authorities so that I may be hired by Italian Organizations with any of the following classifications: usher, porter, beadle or caretaker. In fact I point out to you that all my applications for a job have been rejected as I am not a veteran and my disability does not entitle me to any favourable consideration.

I am certain that you will relieve my family and myself from the equalor and misery in which we are living because of an accident occurred to me while I was working under the direction of the American Command.

From: National Association of War Disabled and Veterans - Oragnano -
TO : The Allied Force Headquarters - Rome -

I, the undersigned, Maria Rosa Sorrentino, daughter of the late Giuseppe, am informing you of the following:

In the year 1943, on 23 September, about 10 hrs a.m. a German patrol composed with six soldiers armed with machine-guns came to S. Maria alla Carità, a locality of Oragnano Comune hunting for men.

My poor husband Pietro Separano son of the late Carmine, for his own family's sake and to avoid serving the lost hated foe of our fatherland tried to hide himself. As soon as the Germans noticed this they shot at him and killed him on the spot. You will never realize how great was my grief when I saw the body of my poor husband in a pool of blood; it guarded by some German soldiers lay down for 48 hours, inasmuch as the Germans prevented us from giving burial to it. The same soldiers later visited my house removing from it my linen and some furniture.

Being the mother of six sons and having to support them as a consequence of my husband's death with means of livelihood, I am applying to your Command in order to obtain a material support from you.

I am sure that you will take into consideration the dire situation I am in by granting me an adequate compensation. Accept my best regards.

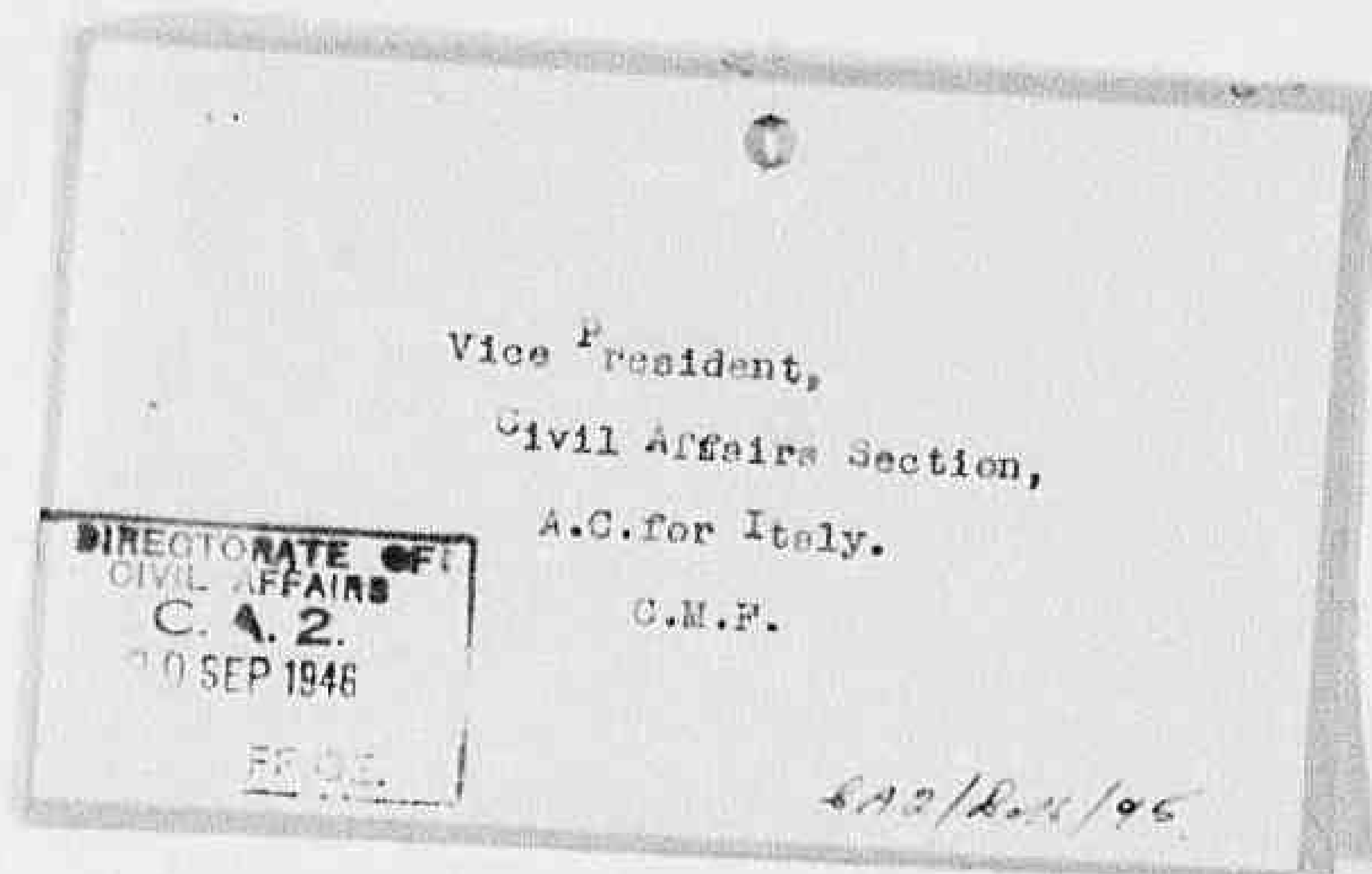

The undersigned GIAMBERTI Tommaso, with wine & liquor shop in Ancona - 2, Via S. Martino, was imposed to supply with wine & strong liquors Capt. Douglas - Director of the Welfare Command of Ancona, (although with same) had never before any relations or private matters.

For such supply Capt. Douglas has left an open account of about 60,000 lire, to recover which, personal approaches were tried but in vain.

Denounced to the 2nd District, Capt. Douglas was found guilty. After two months, investigations were being carried out by the Police when he promised that as soon as same would come to an end the due amount would be settled.

After some time a declaration issued by the Ancona Office admitted that the Claims Office has not yet given an appropriate answer to the question because it seemed entirely that of a private matter.

Never had the undersigned done any private transactions with Capt. Douglas Commander of the Welfare - as he was not even known to him, besides the most part of the supplies were being paid by the Major of the same Welfare; consequently, if Capt. Douglas acted dishonestly no fault can be ascribed to the undersigned in whom the mentioned sum had been advanced.

On the other hand if Capt. Douglas was a dishonest person he would have had no chance to fill up the delicate situation such as that at the Welfare.

But the fact remains that the undersigned has been cheated of about 60,000 lire and that he wants to be paid. The same goods were being distributed at the Officer's mess, to the Police, and at the Transit Hotel Sirois; consequently the goods were not delivered privately.

That Command is begged to provide for the payment of the a/s amount, on the contrary, action will be taken accordingly and forwarded to Gen. Alexander at the General Command of Caserta.

Your letter of 23 is acknowledged and I am looking forward for your decision because I believe charity and benevolence will not be failing in you.

I insist explaining to you that my sole child, Francesco Imbornone of late Luigi, while on duty at the Sciacca airport, wore 501 MSA, on the morning of 21 May he was hit at his lungs by several splinters, during one of your fierce bombardments and was brought to the hospital, where he died. My sorrow for his loss is atrocious. My son was a bachelor and supported me because I am a widow. It is more than one year that I keep on writing and repeatedly forwarding documents controlled by the Prefect, by the Tribunal, by the Notary Public, to the Air Ministry, Direction of Civil Personnel, 9 Section, Major de Cupis. One could not give more evidences. They claim that they have no files, but I have been sending certificates sworn before the Mayor by military people of whom my son was a dependant. And, after all, how can they expect to have files after so many bombardments, when everything was burnt down; how could files be kept when there was nobody any more, all having fled away? My son died and they did not even pay his monthly salary; and not a farthing for his funerals. After all this why are they torturing a poor mother who is so unhappy? Justice does not exist for just people? Dead people should not be so badly treated.

I appeal to your conscience asking you to wake up competent Italian authorities making them take a favourable decision to my case.

ROME

As an officer of the Italian Army which followed the Allied Armies which liberated Italy, I am turning to you to ask of you an act of justice.

In this period in which the Chiefs of Italy do nothing but recall, in all their most minor manifestations, the fact that Italy is a cobelligerent and therefore has right to a friendly treatment from the United Nations, I take the liberty of submitting to you ~~the~~ actual circumstances of many soldiers who have been an integral part of this cobelligerency.

These soldiers, entire Infantry divisions with services and units intact, combat and pioneer groups variously suited for warlike action, voluntarily placed themselves at the orders of the Allied Command and valorously contributed to the common victory. Armed and unarmed, with rifle and shovel, in reconnaissance action and in works of fortification, between the dangers of the sea or the risks of the air, they frequently faced death and left thousand of their comrades on the battlefields.

A part of this Army, after having been victorious, the ~~38391~~ have been victorious by contributing to the victory of the mighty liberating Army, now returns to civilian life without anybody showing signs of assisting them or worrying about them. It happens, instead, ironically, that they are unsuccessful in calling the attention of the so-called Authorities to themselves without having to answer for their past or without being rebuked for their mistakes and thus run up against the "screeners" who, in the majority, were respected Fascists when they went off to war.

He who hopes to finally be able to commence his life as a free worker finds that he has lost the most elementary civilian rights.

1

It is not understood how the ideological amnesty granted to the deserters during the period previous to July 25th. can be accompanied by the ruthless civilian and penal sentence for those who, after the 25th. July, far from deserting and hiding themselves, offered their work and life in order that Italy could regain her honour and liberty.

It is unhuman to ask a returned victorious soldier for excuses and sacrifices which are more burdensome and painful than those which the after war period imposes.

I am part of this army which has returned from a war of liberation, of this army of forgotten men, of humiliated men, and of offenders,

After 22 months with the English VIII Army, as shown in the enclosed documents, I have returned to my family satisfied in having done my duty. As soon as I returned I was handed over to the "screeners", who, after a lengthy and laborious enquiry decreed my discharge from the employment which I had before the war with the Credito Italiano of Sanremo. My only guilt that of having been political secretary of Sanremo, since any other guilt would certainly have been discovered by the grandiose trial apparatus and my sentence would not have been what it was.

And thus, because of this sentence, my enrolment in the Ex-service-men's Association is forbidden ! The only way to find work.

I have been refused the liberation gratuity, a gratuity which, however, has been granted to my office colleagues who swore allegiance to the Nazi-Fascists.

With a family composed of four young children I can no longer find employment because with this sentence I find the doors of the offices closed, on one hand I am refused, on the other, incriminated. No recognition at all, in fact a member of the so-called screening commission told me that my cobelligerent record meant nothing. Because, still according to the decision of the commission, I have not "distinguished myself in the struggle against the Germans". 3890

However, anyone possessing only common sense, and particularly those who must apply judicial regulations of a political importance also, cannot fail to recognise that in my abovementioned and proven military activities after the 8th. September, it is possible to identify the elements which the law ~~XXXXXX~~ admits, in a person being screened, as evidence that "he has distinguished himself in the struggle against the Germans".

Who more than the soldier who fought against the Germans in regular formations of the Army, can say that he was distinguished in the struggle against the Germans? Evidently war is something more than a struggle, in that a struggle can be waged with other means than weapons, and participants are thus not exposed to the major risks of those who use only the latter means.

And now, Excellency, I turn to you, as soldier to soldier, not to recall to you the gains openly recognized and the many times expressed gratitude of the Allies, but to ask you that this sentence which is ruining a family, which is trying to blemish the record of a soldier, be reviewed in a spirit of justice and objectivity.

Excellency, I neither ask honours nor compensations, things which he who has fought for a just cause does not ask, but I ask for justice and work for myself and peace for my family.

Excellency, I beg your authoritative intervention with the High Italian Authorities which, I repeat, do nothing in this period but recall the cobelligerence of Italy in order to obtain favourable treatment from the Allies, in order that the said Authorities themselves commence to carry out at least a programme of justice towards those who were an integral and indispensable part of this cobelligerence.

Perhaps the new Leaders no longer remember the speeches which, ~~Exagg~~ Badoglio, Bonomi, Casati, Togliatti, made to us in barracks, in the field, on the radio, etc., when our work was necessary for them to prove to the Allies their reason for being Ministers!

Excellency, with this act of yours, the friendship cemented during 22 months of common anxiety, sacrifice, hopes, and sorrows, with many English and American colleagues, will surely be enlarged and strengthened.

Excellency, I am at your disposal for all that you may consider necessary for the better seeing through of my case.

Commandant, as then, I place myself at your orders.

Dear Admiral,

We highly regret the very poor and needy conditions of parents, widows and orphans of the Martyrs of Liberty of Chieti. Moreover, we wish to point out that the "National solidarity" bonus of lire 20,000 assigned by the Government since last June has not yet been granted. The "Liberation" bonus of lire 5,000 and the "Presente alla Bandiera" bonus granted by the War Ministry have not yet been paid.

This Association which is deeply concerned with the very needy conditions of the relatives of the glorious soldiers fallen for the National and Allied cause urgently asked the local and central Authorities to see that the said bonuses be duly paid. However, no action whatsoever is yet being taken.

In the name of the victims of the Nazi invader and fascist traitors, I earnestly beg you, dear Admiral, to take into consideration this extremely pitiful case and urge the competent Authorities' action in favour of relatives of the Martyrs of Liberty.

Trusting in your high sense of justice and your full understanding, I wish to thank you and express you my deep gratitude.

Because of my sympathy for the allies and because I expressed my anti-fascist feelings in the London press and wrote to a few members of parliament, I have been savagely persecuted by the authorities of my country.

As you can ascertain from the inhabitants of the town all pretences were good to have me arrested. In jail, I was put in underground cells and fed on bread and water.

All the prisoners can give evidence about the persecution of which I was a victim. Though I was ill, the Doctor could do nothing for me, for the director of the prison showed his fascist faith by putting me in a cell. While I was in jail, my worst persecutors were the jailers Roselli and De Notaris. Roselli even dropped a pencil under my bed to have me punished and locked up. (The possession of a pencil is a serious offence)

To drop my name in the town, it was rumored in town that I was a British spy and belonged to the Intelligence Service, so that all fascists persecuted me.

When I was in jail, the people who proved most ferocious against me were: the Justice Minister and his friend the Justice Roselli, who tried to have me deported (cf. Bonini file at the Justice). Judge (Judge) of Roman origin, supported me, for he persecuted all those who were against fascism and nazism. Judge Gordano (now in charge of the separation of the province) carried on the proceedings, though he knew the charges were false. All my appeals were rejected by the Viterbo Magistrate and I was compelled to appeal to Rome.

Roselli, Spertuso, chief of the 'Polizia Primitiva' and he thrown in jail for a year for an offence which I hadn't committed. No action was taken against this fascist, even when I went to Minister against the proof of my innocence.

I was always being followed by the police. I had to give account of all my trips and wasn't allowed to leave my house between sunset and sunrise.

I was working in brown coal, but one day the Florence police warned the managers of many mines that they were no longer to supply me. The railways were forbidden to let coal carts to me. I was to starve.

I ask for the punishment of all those who persecuted me, and wish to report weekly to this Allied Command

It is a mother who is applying to the human comprehension and to the sentiment of justice of the nearest Allied Authority in Italy: the mother of the Italian Air Force Brigade General Arrigo TESSARI, who was Undersecretary of the Italian Republic Air Force.

Since 6 months the son is imprisoned in the judicial jail of Belluno (Veneto) awaiting to be judged for some crimes which he did not commit.

A short story of General's life and of the events which led to the present sad situation is necessary.

General **TESSARI** is the first born of a soldiers' family. A brother of him, who was granted the silver medal of military bravery, lost his life during the first world war (1916). An other two brothers are Officers.

General TESSARI's career had only one purpose: the interest of his mother country and the military honour. He is a combatant of the first world war and during the same he awarded the silver medal of military bravery as an Alpine Infantry Officer.

Later on he became an Air Force Officer and since then he performed a continuous series of braveries: he was granted other 3 silver medals and 2 war promotions.

On September the 8th 1943, having abandoned his military charges because of the incapacities, 1 competences and basenesses of the fascist rulers, he was awaiting for new events.

Then he was invited to take the charge of Undersecretary of the Italian Republic air force: he refused 3 times to take this charge affirming that he was not a politician. But on march 1944 he was compelled to take this charge which he accepted unwillingly. His activity as Undersecretary is known and he is blameless.

Never was he a fascist.

On August 1944, after less than 5 months of his new charge, in consequence of a very bad quarrel with the Germans, he resigned and retired to private life, continuing to help people who had need and were oppressed just as he did during his political charge.

And now, he who had as his only ideal the honour, the justice, the

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And now, he who had as his only ideal the honour, the justice, the freedom, is groaning since May 1945 in a prison as a common offender.

The mother who is applying to you with deep sorrow, begs you to examine the case of General TESSARI in order to grant him, if not the complete freedom, the treatment of a prisoner of war in England or in the U.S.A., and this also in consideration that in consequence of an order given by an U.S.A. Army Command he was released from prison, but the Partisans wanted him in prison again.

Two months ago the Italian Government issued an order according to which General TESSARI should be handed over to the Allied Nations as a prisoner of war, but this order had not yet been fulfilled, and I don't know the reason for.
