Guarding of Allied Installations and the Use of Enemy Material

(a) The guarding of vital allied installations and dumps of captured enemy material is the responsibility of G (SA) as a key unit of areas and sub-areas. It is realized that it is not possible to get all dumps of captured enemy material, but all on dumps and dumps containing valuable capt will be guarded. Every effort is being made to reduce the number of these dumps.

(b) List of installations and dumps for which Plans and Reports/Sub-Plans are now responsible is at Annex 12.

(c) Inquiry for the collection of captured enemy material will be issued by the French this H, and subsequent inquiry on disposal of material will be issued on received from higher authority. If dumps are controlled or destroyed, within the 72 hour of these orders, one gdn consequently received in numbers, this will be reported to this H.

(d) Material will be released from those dumps only on authority from the French this H. If any release authority will continue to be accepted up to 15 Jul, and thereafter only on dumps listed in Annex 'D'.

Reliefs will take place as follows :-

(a) GSA at present being found by GSA/AM Group in ELCHAM and B. M.

225 1st - 1st will arrange for their relief by 55 1st Regt (AMT) Group) as soon as possible after 20 Jul.

2. Allocation of responsibilities in the theatre

(a) Internal security duties are the responsibility.

9 Frontier Control

- (a) Frontier control in the responsibility of a Frontier Counter-Intelligence det under the op control of JFH. This CIO det will continue to be tasked in its duties by Allied and SW-INT Regs, and their duties will remain the same as those laid down in IV Corps letter HQ 3833 dated 23 Jan 45. The relevant principles laid down in that order are detailed at Appx 'H'.
- (b) Details of rd blocks being issued to assist the CIO in frontier control are at Appx 'I'. Gds will NOT be taken off these rd blocks without application to them H. As soon as the regt HQ/COM. Groups are in Italy, it will relieve 6 (24) and Div of the running of rd blocks detailed in Appx 'I'.
- (c) 6 (24) and Div will ensure that No limits are attached within 15 of the Franco-Italian border.
- (d) 5 (24) and Div will ensure that facilities are given for the existence of a French Transit Co. for 24 and explained pursuant to Appx far as long as they need exists.

10 Maint of low and order

- (a) The initial responsibility for maint of low and order is an AG one. For it is through the Carabinieri are under control of AG. If the Carabinieri prove insufficient, the local comd will provide all assistance at the request of the local AG authority. Where possible Italian troops should be used initially in preference to Allied troops, but this must be left to the discretion of the local AG.
- (b) If there is a possibility of the becoming involved in a purely civil disturbance, all troops will be confined to barracks. A disturbance in which all personnel are involved is a full responsibility and will be dealt with accordingly.
- (c) In all cases of riots or civil disturbances, whether or not Allied or Italian troops are used, a request will be rendered through the usual

10 Maint of law and order

(a) The initial responsibility for maint of law and order is on the GIB. For the purpose the Carabinieri are under control of GIB. If the Carabinieri prove insufficient the local GIB will provide all assistance at the request of the local GIB authority. Where possible Italian GIB should be used initially in preference to British GIB, but this must be left to the discretion of the local GIB.

(b) If there is a possibility of the becoming involved in a purely civil disturbance, all GIB will be confined to barracks. A disturbance in which all personnel are involved in a civil disturbance and will be dealt with accordingly.

(c) In all cases of riots or civil disturbances, whether or not allied or Italian GIB are used, a report will be rendered through the usual channels to this HQ. An initial report will be made by tel to G(ops); a written report giving full circumstances will be made as soon as possible to G(ops) with a copy to G(1).

(d) All cases of sabotage will be reported to the nearest PS Sec. and through the usual channels to G(1) through this HQ. Location of PS Secs is given at Apr X '41.

(e) Orders for employ out of GIB in aid of the civil power are given at Apr X '41.

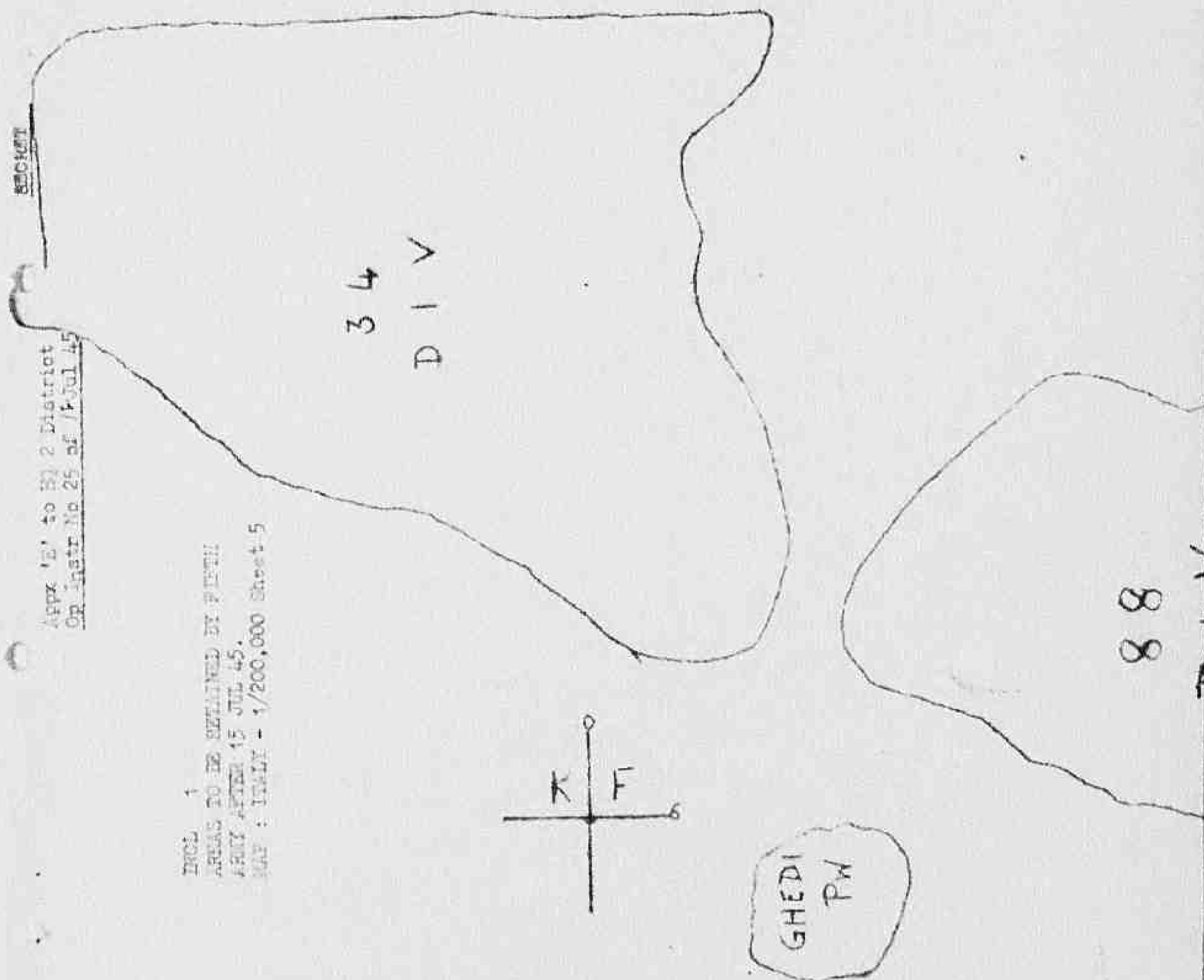

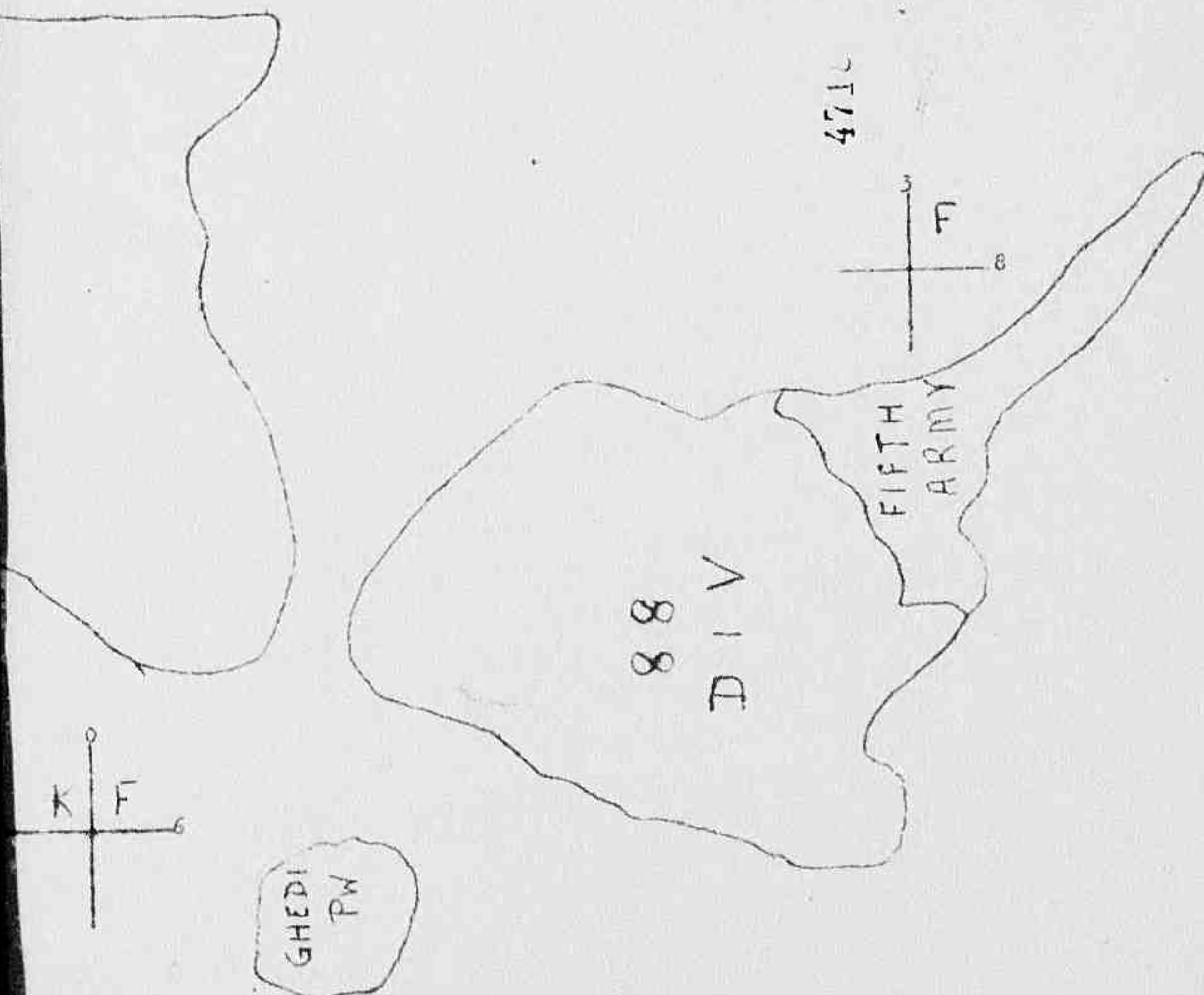

FRONTIER CONTROL

1. The Italo-Swiss and Italo-French frontiers are opened for the crossing of authorized individuals as indicated in this order, but 2 District will continue the existing task of seeing both frontiers. The will be assisted in effecting the closure by Carabinieri (CCRN) and Finance Ops (CCF) which will be posted by 12. Comds of units on the frontier will maintain close contact with these Italian GPs and co-ord their dispositions with them. Allied tps will respect them in the performance of their mission. These Italians have been directed to report any allied persons and endeavoring to violate the frontier regs.
2. 2 Frontier Counter-Intelligence out posts by Lt Hubert/LF, under op control of A.H., is posted in 2 District areas as follows:-

2 agents at CIRIO (2-6238)
2 agents at JURY, CHIAZZO (2-1005)
2 agents at VARE (2-5352)
1 agent at 20 CHIAZZO (2-5441)
1 agent at CL VARE (2-1003)
1 agent at 20 (2-1040)
1 agent at 20 (2-9285)
1 agent at 20 (2-1047)
Lt Hubert (2-5352)

This set is empowered to authorize the crossing of either frontier in accordance with directives of CCF. Tps and/or CCF or CCF, on to either of frontiers will allow passage to persons designated by these agents.

3. Recognized crossing pts are of two kinds; those for Through Traffic, and those for Frontier Traffic. Area 4 - 7 deal with Through Traffic; Areas 8 and 9 with Frontier Traffic.

4. Authorized Personnel (for through traffic)

Recognized crossing points on the French frontier are at 243 Lory (2-1187) and 244 (2-4403). The guided crossing pts on the Swiss frontier are at 245 CHIAZZO (2-1505) and 246 (2-5352).

5. Procedure for Movement (for 243)
