- 1 For two reasons it has not always been possible to draw the staffs required from Regions I, II and III as suggested.
 - a in some cases the staffs of these Regions have already been reduced to a minimum and no further officers can be spared from that territory.
 - b the persons particularly appropriate and required for senior appointments in Region VIII are located elsewhere.
- 2 In discussing the question of ceilings it was made plain that in some cases (legal in particular) Region VIII could only be staffed if some of the territory at present occupied was restored so that some of the staff at present employed there (e.g. Naples) could be released. This still applies, legal have no spare staff and cannot earmark persons unless they know what areas are going to be released and when. Further, release of territory does not result in instant availability of staff. Legal anticipates that from one to two months must elapse from release of territory before any appreciable number of legal officers could be withdrawn from it.
- 3 Subject to these remarks the persons to be earmarked are as shown on the attached list.

1. Reference your 4/20A/AS dated 6 May 1944 unless Region III becomes unoccupied this Sub-Commission cannot supply legal officers for Region VIII as all legal personnel will be fully engaged in Regions I - VII. Even after restoration to the Italian Government there will, in the light of experience gained in Regions I and II, be a substantial time lag of 1-2 months before personnel can be released from Region III.

2. It should be mentioned that with the present TO/WE for legal officers it will be necessary to reduce Region III (now 26 officers) to 16 before all the needs of Region IV (16 officers) and Region V (10 officers) can be met and further distribution from these Regions cannot be envisaged without a breakdown of the Legal administration.

3. It is stressed that in order to supply legal officers for Region VIII an increase in the TO/WE is essential.
