With reference to your A 018 of 20 Oct 45 which was addressed to the Executive Commissioner.

- 1 The situation as regards vacancies on the Allied Commission TO/VE is as follows:

As far as British Officers are concerned there are vacancies at present on the W/E to cover the suggested increase of staff. It is anticipated, however, that these vacancies will cease to exist with effect from 1 Dec 45 when a new W/E will come into force.

G-1 (B) stated that covering approval would be necessary from GMR for use to be made of these W/E vacancies.

No information is available as to whether any vacancies are available on the American T/O.

- 2 No police officers are at the moment available for duty with MIA. It is estimated that after the hand-over of the Northern Regions, 10 Officers will be surplus to Public Safety Sub-Commission requirements. It would be essential that any officers attached to MIA should be employed on purely police duties. No staff officers, other than police officers are assigned to Public Safety Sub-Commission.

1. Reference this office letter G-1B/302/1/0 of 10 Oct (Liaison and AMG Teams) and Executive Commissioner's letter 611/EC of 17 Sep (organization and Functions of A.C.).

1. On GHQ CMT instructions a British WE is, ^{being} prepared for HQ AC, which will be quite distinct from the ones being prepared for Liaison and AMG Teams. It is anticipated that this WE will come into effect during December and all nominations for it should be of personnel who will not be released from the Army before at least the early months of 1946.

2. Will you therefore submit a nominal roll by Sub-Commissions showing the British officers selected. Attached for easy reference is a list of the assignments to be filled. As information is now to hand as to which American officers are available it is requested that a nominal roll of them be submitted as well.

3. Approximate over-all parity between British and American officers is hoped for, but you are not asked to consider this factor as an over-riding one in selecting officers.

No Civilians should be included even if filling present WE vacancies. They are regarded as an increment.

4. In making your nominations the question of rank must not be forgotten. An excess of high ranks is to be avoided if possible.

5. No details are required at this stage affecting EM/ORS.

SUBJECT : Proposed - Establishment for AGS/AC

TO : Vice President, Economic Section
Vice President, Civil Affairs Section.

1. The enclosed tables show the suggested Establishment recently submitted to A.F.H.Q. They are sent to you now for information with the following comments from this Branch.

(a) While modifications in detail are certain the total figure of 1389 all ranks must be looked on as the final limiting factor; it is possible that it may be reduced.

(b) The EM/OR figures are provisional and have not been worked out in detail. They provide a warning, however, as to the possible size of staffs.

(c) The suggested method of reaching these figures is by a gradual thinning out coincident with the closing down of Regions. By 1 Dec 45 the new Establishment should be achieved.

2. When Sub Commissioners etc plan their readjustments they should aim at having within their strength at 1 Dec only deferred Release Officers or those with Army Service Group numbers of 25 or higher or American Officers whose retention is certain for at least 3 months. Parity between American and British Officers is aimed at and should always be borne in mind, but it is to be understood that it will be impossible to attain it in many cases.
