There seems very little stress in promoting this change and when the bulk of the movement with other countries has ceased or is rapidly diminishing.

DPR is closely connected with other AC functions it is inappropriate and inconvenient that it should be divorced from them and that these respective functions should come under separate commands. Unless of course AFHQ is prepared to set up special services.

There is no reason why the change should facilitate the handling over to UNRRA. As UNRRA HQ is in Rome the contrary would seem to be the case.

Civil Affairs was created to relieve AFHQ from the burden of dealing with civilians. The proposal is the negation of the reasons for forming AC. It seems to be designed to

relieve G. of the burden of DPR. - It would also appear that if DPR is a part of AFHQ - it should be **5326** to correspond with the AC. Govt. through AC.

I have discussed this with the Director of DPR. He says that it is ~~not~~ ^{not} this matter. It was their work is nearly finished. In his view DPR has been hampered all the way along by being ~~absent~~ ^{absent} of AC. AC was never given enough transport - camp sites ~~or personnel~~ - he feels that DPR should have been an army unit and it would have been got these requirements soon after. On making requests it was always told it must come from AC - and AC had never supplied. Logically it should have been no harder for AC to obtain supplies for DPR than for DP. itself, if it had been independent.

The matter has been brought to a head now by the fact that AC has been given an arbitrary ceiling which will not allow for ⁴⁴⁴ ~~444~~ sufficient personnel for DPR. DP feels if it is off on its own it will get what it wants - If that is so there is no reason why the ceiling should not be increased by the number which it will get.

DPR states that in Europe generally Representation ~~is~~ is considered as a separate responsibility.

If DP gets its own personnel from AFHQ it will be a mixed force partly AC and partly AFHQ. It would prefer to be all the same.

SUBJECT : Proposed War Establishment D.P. & R. Sub Comm. *23 OCT 1945*

TO : Executive Officer (B).

FROM : G-1 (B), H.Q., A.C.

1. Originally the question of Displaced Persons and Repatriation was a local Italian one and under War conditions was primarily a refugee problem. It has now become a general question, involving movement throughout G.M.F., and thereafter into B.A.O.R., Mideast etc.

2. It is suggested that the time has now come to transfer the D.P. & R. Sub Commission and all subsidiary D.P. Units to A.F.H.Q., so that control and administration may be undertaken centrally. All personnel employed in D.P. & R. would then be held on an A.F.H.Q. War Establishment under the direct control of G-5 Section.

3. In this way the following advantages, inter alia, would accrue.

- (a) Direct control of D.P. & R. policy by A.F.H.Q.
- (b) Direct reinforcement of D.P. & R. camp staffs by A.F.H.Q.
- (c) Speedier adjustment and transfer of personnel as UNRRA assumes responsibility for D.P. & R.

(a) Location of all D.P. Control Camps (total ten) together with the number of Officers and O.Rs actually employed in each camp. Against each name it should be clearly shown whether the officer or O.R. is held on the Camp Establishment (CM/976/1) or on A.C. Establishment.

(b) Location of all D.P. Assembly Centres (total eleven) with details as in (a) above, the Centre Establishment being CM/975/1.

(c) Location of all Camps other than those in (a) or (b) above which are run entirely by D.P. & R. Sub Commission with personnel held on A.C. Establishments.

(d) Location of all Camps run by UNRRA in which there are personnel held on A.C. Establishment who are employed either as Camp Staff or Liaison Officers.

(e) Details of all personnel held on A.C. Establishment, other than those required above, who are working in any other capacity under the supervision of D.P. & R. Sub Commission. The exact nature of their duties should be stated.

The above return should include American Officers and E.M., their nationality clearly indicated by the insertion of the sign (A) after their names. The term 'A.C. Establishment' will for this purpose be held to include CM/266/2 and 2675th Regt.

Reference our DPR/16/ADM dated 14 September 1945.

1. I understand that the establishment of A.C. Officers for this Sub-Commission (on December 1st) has been forwarded to AFHQ as 50 instead of the 62 as required in our DPR/16/ADM dated 14 September 1945 (copy attached) which shows our requirements on 1st December 1945.

2. The establishments indicated therein are cut for too near the bone to allow of any further paring such as the suggestion that 50 A.C. Officers are sufficient. It will be observed that only 3 "single" Camps have been shown with 3 Officers each - the other Camps have been allotted 2 Officers each.

This in effect means that between leave LIAP, sickness etc., that there will be rarely more than 1 Officer in each Camp. At the moment we have only 1 remaining Officer in most of our Camps - although in "theory" we should have nearly an average of 2 per Camp.

3. It must be remembered that most of these Officers now in our Camps have had no leave or rest. It is sometimes forgotten that the Officer in charge of a Refugee Camp is on duty for 24 hours each day and he seldom has a responsible N.C.O. to help him in any way.

4. It is essential that the establishment of this Sub-Commission on 1st December should be fixed at 62 Allied Commission Officers and 175 Allied Commission EM/ORs.
