SUBJECT: Manpower - Northern Italy.

TO: C.A. Section, A.O.

1. On 12 February, 1945, the Manpower Committee agreed to an Establishment of 62 Officers for Phase I - Northern Italy, remitting examination of requirements of a further 34 officers for Phase II to a later date.
2. On 4 March, I received a letter from S.O.A.O. 6th Army which stated in brief that G-1(Br.), A.F.H.Q. had "foreclosed" on 7 officers attached to his Refugee Branch from Replacement Units and ordered their return forthwith to Replacement Units.
3. I attach (Appendix "A") a list of 15 officers now doing duty with Refugee Branches of 5th and 6th Armies. There is no doubt in my mind that they are all essential. Those marked "X" have been ordered to Replacement Units.
4. When making my application DPA/29/ADM (copy attached) I only reckoned on having to supply 8 ~~officers~~ Refugee Officers to A.M.G. 5th and 6th Armies, as agreed by an earlier Manpower Board - vide my DPA/1/ADM dated 9 December, 1944. Quote:-

"It is understood that the Board have agreed:-

- (i) That officers attached to A.M.G. 5th and 6th Army in excess of 8 which is my agreed ceiling strength will be held additional to my establishment.
- (ii) That Allied Medical Officers and ORs will not count against this Sub-Commission's establishment personnel. "
5. It is obvious that now it will be necessary to hold on my strength an additional 7 officers in place of those ordered to be released. This is impossible with an Establishment of 62.
6. I request, therefore, that the agreement quoted in para 4 is implemented, or that authority be given for my present establishment to be raised to 69.

2. On 4 March, I received a letter from S.C.A.O. 8th Army which stated in brief that G-1(Er.), A.F.H.Q. had "foreclosed" on 7 officers attached to his Refugee branch from Replacement Units and ordered their return forthwith to Replacement Units.

(ii) That Allied Medical Officers and ORs will not count against this Sub-Commission's establishment personnel. "

5. It is obvious that now it will be necessary to hold on my strength an additional 7 officers in place of those ordered to be released. This is impossible with an Establishment of 62.

6. I request, therefore, that the agreement quoted in para 4 is implemented, or that authority be given for my present establishment to be raised to 69.

Subject: Officer Requirements - Northern Italy & Austria.

To: C.A. Section for Manpower Committee

1. At this date Displaced Persons and Reparation Sub-Commission hold 55 officers on their books with one officer (Lt.Col. KERR) awaiting re-assignment out of an Establishment of 57 officers.
2. Of the above 55 officers, 6 officers have been remarked or assigned for Austria. (Appendix "A"). Major DUBOIS and Captain KERRY have actually reported to the Austria Planning Set Up. I understand that further officers will be required for Austria and it is impossible to part with the above or give up more, unless replacements are forthcoming immediately. Camp Commanders require training like other men, and as their duty will be supervising Italian Military personnel it is essential that they be allied officers and NOT Civilians.

3. I have now studied in detail my requirements when North West Italy is occupied (Phase I), and the results are shown in Appendix "B". (under Phase I) a total of 64 officers.

It will be observed that in Phase I, five Group H.Q. are requested for ten "Centres" (each of 5,000)

They have the additional function of liaison with Military, Region and Provincial Headquarters.

In Phase II they will control a further 12 Centres (each of 5,000) and 20 Frontier Reparation Posts (each of 1,000)

4. For Phase II an extra 36 officers will be required for the 12 additional Centres and 20 Frontier Reparation Posts as shown in Appendix "B" (under Phase II)

5. I consider that if these officers cannot be obtained from within the ceiling allowed to the Allied Commission, immediate application should be made to A.F.d.C. for further officers for this very important commitment.

SUBJECT : Planning for North West Italy.

TO : V.P. Civil Affairs Section.

Ref. TS/15/11/CA, dated 17th January, 1945.

1. General.

Planning for North West Italy is based on the AMG Regions of Liguria, Piemonte, and Lombardia. Regional staffs are making detailed plans. The following scheme is identical to that forwarded on 6th February, 1945, with the exception of amended Carabinieri figures and the inclusion of information concerning Finance Guards.

2. Public Safety Officers.

The Public Safety Officers assigned to the Regions are set out in Appendix A.

3. Internal Security.

No internal Security troops will be available for Public safety duties.

The three Italian Garrison Battalions will be fully engaged on Guard duties on behalf of the military. The British (or Dominion) Division will not normally deal with the civil population but will only be called out to preserve order when all Italian resources have failed.

4. Italian Police.

The preservation of public order will therefore devolve on Italian Police agencies, that is, on the Carabinieri, the Agents of Public Security and the Finance Guards. It is expected that the Agents of Public Security and the Finance Guards will be found almost intact, but that the Carabinieri will have been disbanded.

5. Carabinieri.

While the closest co-operation is likely to be received from the agents of Public Security and the Finance Guards, the main burden of keeping public order will rest on the Carabinieri.

In addition to this concentration, a further 4000 CC.RR. have been earmarked in South Italy for forward move at short notice.

The forward movement of CC.RR. will be by direction of 5th Army. When the men to be moved are in forward areas, transport is undertaken by Army. When in rear areas the men are moved to a forward railhead by Transportation Sub-Commission and the journey completed by Army transport. All arrangements are co-ordinated by Public Safety Sub-Commission.

6. Finance Guards.

There are three Legions of Finance Guards in N.W. Italy. Particulars are as shown below.

Vercelli

Commanding General CG.FF. expects to find at least half of the strength detailed above, in N.W. Italy when liberated. 1200 CG.FF. are held in reserve in Rome and Naples. They will not be assigned to each of the three Legions, but will be sent forward and used to the best advantage in accordance with the existing conditions. The special importance of the ports in Liguria is well understood by the Commanding General and an officer will shortly be appointed to control a Genoa detachment.

The CG.FF. to be used for Frontier Control (see par 8) will be drawn from the reserve as necessary.

7. Agents of Public Security.

It is proposed to allow the existing organisation to continue, epuration proceedings following their normal course.

However, it is likely that several Questori may have fled or may have been removed by partisans or the C.L.N.A.I. This leaves the alternatives of either appointing a local candidate (probably already installed by the C.N.L.A.I.) or of transferring a Questore from a pool formed in Rome by the Ministry of the Interior. At present senior Public Security officials have been selected by the Ministry of the Interior for transfer to Northern Provinces if needed.

8. Frontier Control.

The frontiers to be considered are those of France and Switzerland.

Preliminary discussions have already been held with representatives of AFHQ, AAI, No.2 District, Finance Sub-Commission, the Ministry of the Interior, Carabinieri and Finance Guards. Before final plans can be made the outcome of discussions between AFHQ and SIARF are awaited.

- 4 -

The following principles are almost certain to be adopted :

- (a) As soon as North West Italy is occupied the frontiers will be closed.
- (b) At the later stage, civilians in possession of Military Travel Authorizations or Allied Force Permits will be allowed to cross the frontiers.
- (c) At a very much later stage the frontiers may be opened to the conveyance of commodities in accordance with plans made by Finance Sub-Commission.
- (d) The responsibility for controlling movement across the frontiers will rest on Allied NOT Italian authorities.
- (e) AFHQ will be responsible for planning the control of frontiers.
- (f) The enforcement of the control will be carried out by Allied personnel - probably C.I.C.
- (g) The assistance of Italian Police will be sought to augment Allied personnel in controlling frontiers.

The task of Public Safety will be to provide the Italian police to work under Allied supervision. The Fascist Frontier Militia will be disbanded, and its place taken by Carabinieri, Finance Guards and Agents of Public Security. The main work will be done by Finance Guards, and it is expected that most of them will be found at their frontier posts.

No firm arrangements will be made until AFHQ plans have been settled, but tentative proposals have been made for the following reserves to be held in readiness :

CC.RR.	100	(to be available within a few days)
CG.FF.	600	(to be available within a few days)
Agents	200	(to be ready within a fortnight if required).

9. Civil Disturbances.

The likelihood of demonstrations normally comes to the knowledge of the police at an early stage - in Italy, the proper agency for obtaining this information is the Questura. Prompt measures can then be taken to suppress any illegal manifestations - such as the unlawful posting of placards, unlawful assemblies, the holding of prohibited meetings and processions, the improper possession of weapons etc. This again, is largely the duty of the Questura, who have at their disposal the CC.RR.

If these measures have not the effect of quelling incipient trouble, then numbers of Police must be kept on reserve to disperse forcibly rioters and arrest those guilty of disturbing the peace. If necessary, arrangements must be made for calling out troops in aid of the civil power.

- 5 -

It is impossible to lay down any hard and fast rules of procedure for dealing with civil disorders. Each situation develops differently. Common sense and police experience are the only guides. To a large extent the control of a particular situation depends on the senior police officer at the scene.

10. Co-ordination with No.2 District.

On the 3rd January, 1945, a Police Conference was called at No.2 District Advanced HQs., attended by representatives of Public Safety Sub-Commission and all Regional Public Safety Officers. At this Conference, problems were discussed and agreement was reached on the manner in which they would be overcome.

To: C.A. Section for Manpower Committee (2)

1. At this date Displaced Persons and Repatriation Sub-Commission hold 55 officers on their books with one officer (Lt. Col. KERR) awaiting re-assignment out of an Establishment of 57 officers.

2. Of the above 55 officers, 6 officers have been earmarked or assigned for Austria. (Appendix "A"). Major DUFOUR and Captain Y. BERRY have actually reported to the Austria Planning Set Up. I understand that further officers will be required for Austria and it is impossible to part with the above or give up more, unless replacements are forthcoming immediately. Camp Commanders require training like other men, and as their duty will be supervising Italian Military personnel it is essential that they be Allied Officers and NOT Civilians.

3. I have now studied in detail my requirements when North West Italy is occupied (Phase I), and the results are shown in Appendix "B": (under Phase I) - a total of 64 officers.

It will be observed that in Phase I, five Group H.Q.s are requested for ten "Centres" (each of 5,000)

They have the additional function of liaison with Military, Region and Provincial Headquarters.

In Phase II they will control a further 12 Centres (each of 5,000) and 20 Frontier Repatriation Posts (each of 1,000)

4. For Phase II an extra 36 officers will be required for the 12 additional Centres and 20 Frontier Repatriation Posts as shown in Appendix "B" (under Phase II)

5. I consider that if these officers cannot be obtained from within the ceiling allowed to the Allied Commission, immediate application should be made to A.F.H.Q. for further officers for this very important commitment.

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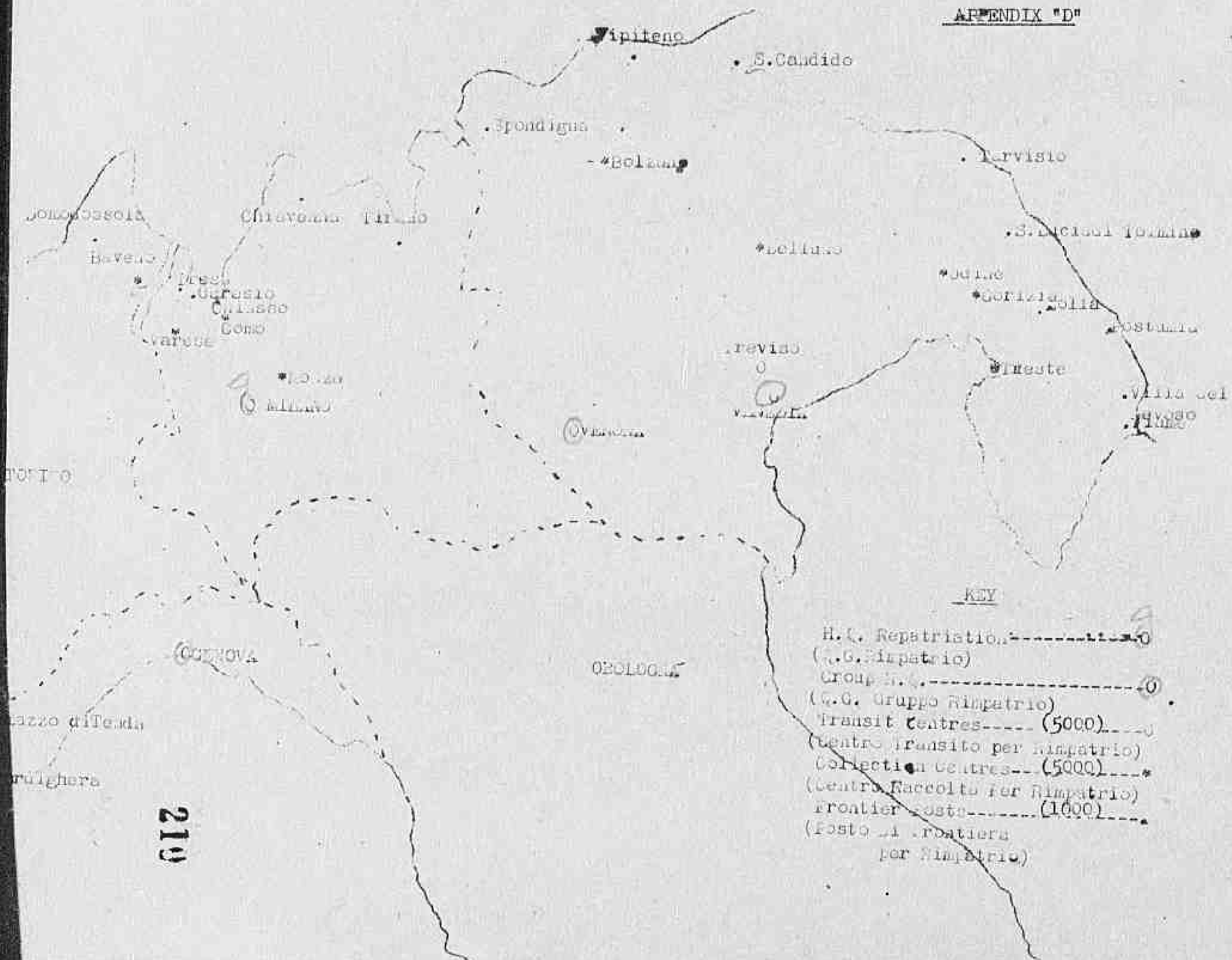

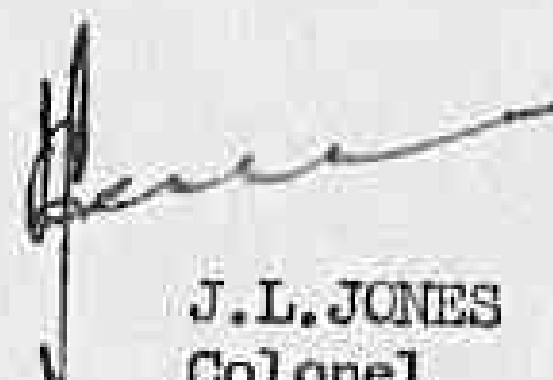

I consider that a minimum of 10 Medical Officers are required.

SUBJECT : Legal personnel and requirements.
TO : CA Sec.

1. The present strength of officers assigned to Legal Sub-Commission and available for legal work is as follows:

Nominally assigned - - - - -	87
Absent or shortly to become absent on duty - - - - -	<u>6</u>
Now available - - - - -	81

Of this total of 81 officers, the following number are earmarked for Austria;

British Officers (including Lt Col IGH Campbell) - - -	8
American Officers - - - - -	<u>4</u>
Total - - - - -	<u>12</u>
Available for future employment - - - - -	69

2. A small number of personnel has been interviewed with a view to appointment to Allied Commission and Legal Sub-Commission. So far, no success has been achieved in securing the services of any of these officers. In addition, Major K. D. Collins, an English Barrister, now employed by the Finance Sub-Commission, would be most useful if he could be transferred.

3. It is considered that the minimum requirements for Northern Italy involve the following personnel;

Lombardia Region (9 Provinces, including Milan) - - -	16
Piemonte Region (7 Provinces, including Turin) - - -	11
Liguria Region (4 Provinces, including Genoa) - - -	6
Venezia Region - - - - -	20 or more
Total - - - - -	<u>53</u>

4. It is assumed that in the early days of the occupation of Northern Italy, Emilia Region will be largely, if not wholly, under AMG. For this

purpose, 9 officers will be required. At a later stage, even if Military Government is continued, it may be possible to reduce this number by 3 or 4 officers.

5. It is assumed that Abruzzi-Marche and Toscana Regions will be still, in part at least, under AMG and that at least 3 officers will be required for Abruzzi-Marche Region and 6 officers for Toscana Region. Again, at a later stage, it may be possible to reduce these figures.

6. Southern Region: The AM Courts at Bari can be discontinued as soon as necessary. It is assumed however that courts will still be required in Naples Commune. It is thought that a minimum of 3 officers is required in Naples and probably one officer at least in Bari in view of the difficulties which have existed in the past with the Italian Courts in this area.

7. No legal officer is considered necessary in Sicily or Sardinia. If any part of Lazio-Umbria Region remains under AMG it may be necessary to retain 2 officers in that region, but it is thought that these can probably be released for other regions.

8. It is not possible to reduce the strength at Hq below 8 officers. One of these must be the Chief Judicial Officer. At present, this assignment is held by Lt Col I.G.H. Campbell; this officer is earmarked for Austria when that employment becomes operational, and his place will be taken by Lt Col Welsford. It is proposed to assign Lt Col Welsford to Liguria Region for the present on the clear understanding that he will be required for Hq immediately Lt Col Campbell is removed.

9. Attached hereto at Appendix A is the proposed plan for the allocation of legal officers in accordance with the foregoing observations.

The teams for Lombardia and Piemonte Regions are completed to the minimum scale and include no officers earmarked for Austria.

The team for Liguria Region is completed by the inclusion of Lt Col Welsford; if Lt Col Welsford is not available later for this appointment, his place will be taken by Lt Banno' from Southern Region.

The team for Emilia Region includes 3 officers earmarked for Austria.

The teams for Toscana, Venezia and Southern Regions include 2, 4, and 1 officers respectively who are earmarked for Austria.

10. It is not intended to withdraw any personnel from the regions with which they are now serving or to make any other changes in present organization until it becomes necessary to do so for the actual occupation of Northern Italy. It is understood that under the present appreciation

of the situation, Venezia Region has considerably lower priority than the other Northern Regions and for that reason the strength of that region has been sacrificed to the advantage of other regions.

11. It is pointed out that additional personnel are essential if Venezia Region is to be completed up to anything like an adequate strength and that this personnel cannot possibly be found, under anything like the conditions envisaged above, from the personnel now at the disposal of the Legal Sub-Commission. It is therefore strongly requested that additional personnel be made available so that it will be possible for the Legal Sub-Commission to adequately discharge its obligations when the north of Italy is occupied.

SUBJECT : Strength of Public Safety Sub-Commission.

TO : Vice President, Civil Affairs Section.

1. Request is submitted for increase of ceiling on Public Safety Officers. At present the ceiling is 135 not including Security Officers. On the basis of reasonable requirements for Public Safety the ceiling should be increased to not less than 160.

2. The basic unit for assignment to regions should consist of:

- 1 R.P.S.O.
- 1 A/R.P.S.O.
- 1 Fire and C.D. Officer
- 1 Prisons Officer
- 1 P.P.S.O. for each province.

3. In almost every region there is at least one city which, by reason of size or importance, requires the assignment of an additional Public Safety Officer.

4. Based on the foregoing, the minimum requirements of the four northern regions will be 56 officers. The minimum for other regions is as follows:

Toscana	15
Emilia	13
Abruzzi-Marche	13
Lazio-Umbria	13

These four regions are either army area or AMG wholly or partially. Most of Emilia is not yet occupied.

5. Southern Region has 10 officers, Sicily 2 and Sardegna 1. No increase is contemplated for these regions.

6. Fifth and Eighth Army AMG each have 5 officers assigned. This is considered to be a minimum requirement.

7. Headquarters of the Sub-Commission has 8 officers assigned which is a minimum.

8. Fire and Civil Defense Officers and Prison Officers are particularly needed. There are at present only 5 Prisons Officers and 8 Fire and C.D. officers under this Sub-Commission to operate in nine regions (Sicily and Sardegna not included). It is desirable that there be made available 5 additional Prisons Officers and 6 additional Fire and C.D. Officers. It is considered essential that there be a Fire Officer assigned to each port in addition to the Fire Officer assigned to the region.

TO: See Distribution.

In connection with the provision of Allied personnel for N. Italy, the C.O.S. has laid down:

- (1) Directors of Sub-Commissions will treat the provision of personnel for the Northern Regions as a first priority.
Personnel should in the first place be withdrawn from this Hq., leaving the bare minimum at Hq., necessary for efficient working.
Secondly Directors must if necessary be ruthless in withdrawing personnel from Southern Region, Sicily and Sardinia.
- (2) Personnel assigned to the Northern Regions in accordance with the foregoing should not be earmarked for Austria.

It is appreciated that this may give rise to some difficulty but if necessary the earmarking of officers for Austria must be revised.

Directors will contact the Regional Commissioners, of Liguria, Piemonte and Lombardia Regions at the earliest opportunity and agree with them the personnel to be posted to these Regions.
