SUBJECT: Return of civilians to their homes.

TO : Headquarters,
Allied Armies in Italy,
C. M. F.

1. I refer to this HQ letter Ref: 75/ dated 1. August 44.
2. The Italian Government has been approached on the lines of this letter and are formulating a plan for the implementation of the decision to return agriculturists to their homes.
3. The Italian Government state, and I agree with them, that it would be impossible to set up rapidly the organisation necessary with civilians. The Carabinieri are fully employed in preserving law and order. The Italian Government has submitted a request for 934 effectives from the Italian Army in order to man the transit point mentioned in para. 4 of my letter. These transit points will be the key to the smooth and rapid working of the organisation envisaged and they consider that these cannot be maintained without military discipline and organisation.
4. I have approached the G.O.C., M.M.I.A. who opposes the removal of these men to deal with civilian refugees and is unwilling to take up the matter with you in view of your 1605/50/56/C.SBI dated 24 July.
5. I wish to urge in the strongest possible manner that these effectives from the Italian Army be provided.
6. In making the decision that the repatriation of agriculturists should commence when the plans of the Italian Government were prepared and the organisation was ready to carry them out, I had the following considerations in mind:-
 - (a) The Allies are importing food into Italy. Great areas of farm land are lying untilled. Their rehabilitation will save Allied shipping and supplies.
 - (b) The urge of great masses of people to move home can only be restricted by employing regularised movement. This necessitates the use of force. Such force involves the employment of resources including men and transport.

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(c) Unauthorized mass migration must create disorder and affect Allied Lines of Communication. This has been brought to my notice forcibly by your own Headquarters, by A.F.H.Q. and by several Regional Commissioners, who have commented on the serious effects which this uncontrolled movement is creating.

7. The best method of restricting this mass migration is to initiate a regular controlled flow of movement. I am satisfied that the Italian Government can do this provided, and only provided, that they are furnished with the troops for which they have asked.

8. I fully appreciate the strict necessity of employing the Italian Army for military matters, and for military matters only. I submit, however, that this is a matter which affects not only the Italian but the Allied military effort. I cannot emphasize too greatly the dangers of uncontrolled movement of a quarter of a million people. It must lead to disorder. It can be prevented. I submit that the provision of 934 men from the Italian Army requested by the Italian Government is a small price to pay for the avoidance of these dangers.

9. An early decision is necessary. We cannot have a repetition of 2000 refugees crowded in a disorderly and unhealthy mass on Naples Station. We cannot see trains loaded with military supplies being over-loaded with returning refugees. We cannot have uncontrolled migration into devastated areas of hungry and homeless people.

10. I would ask therefore, that the provision of the troops asked for by the Italian Government be made at the earliest possible moment in order that the Italian Government may set about its task of proper control of a potentially very dangerous situation.

CABLE RECEIVED FROM LEMMAN 23 JULY IS PARAPHRASED AS FOLLOWS:

"WHENIN ALGIERS I DISCUSSED PROBLEM OF ITALIAN OBSERVERS MISSION WITH GENERAL WILSON. (FOR UHRA FOR COCHRAN FROM LEMMAN HUB 200) AT THAT TIME EMPHASIS WAS ON SMALL MISSION OF 3 OR 4 INDIVIDUALS TO OBSERVE DISPLACED PERSONS PROBLEMS. UPON RETURN PROBLEM FURTHER EXPLORED. NOT FEEL IT DESIRABLE TO BROADEN MISSION AGAINST POSSIBLE DENOIGN BY CENTRAL COMMITTEE OR COUNCIL INDICATING DESIRABILITY MORE EXTENSIVE EXAMINATION ITALIAN RELIEF AND REHABILITATION SITUATION. ACCORDINGLY HAVE APPROVED COMPLETE BUDGET FOR FOLLOWING 16 POSITIONS: CHIEF OF MISSION, INDUSTRIAL REHABILITATION SPECIALIST, ADVISOR ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL PROBLEMS. (NO COMMANDER IN CHIEF AFHQ FOR G-5 FOR SPOFFORD ACTION REPEAT FOR INFORMATION TO ACC ROME FOR KERRY UHRA SIGNED BOND FROM COCHRAN GARG) CHIEF MEDICAL OFFICER, AGRICULTURAL REHABILITATION SPECIALIST, REQUIREMENTS AND SUPPLY SPECIALIST, TRANSPORTATION SPECIALIST, CHIEF WAREHOUSEMAN, WELFARE SPECIALIST. 4 DISPLACED PERSONS SPECIALISTS, ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS, 2 STENOGRAPHERS. PLEASE DISCUSS WITH GENERAL WILSON AND OBTAIN APPROVAL AGAINST ABOVE CONTINGENCY. IN ANY EVENT OBTAIN IMMEDIATE APPROVAL FOR WILLIAM WALK, ADVISOR ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL PROBLEMS, WHO WILL OBSERVE ECONOMICAL FINANCIAL AND DISTRIBUTION PROBLEMS IN ITALY. WALK PROCEEDING ALGIERS. MEANTHILE, KEEP KERRY INFORMED OF DEVELOPMENTS." URGE

WMM/ REQUEST FOR APPROVAL BE TAKEN UP WITH GENERAL WILSON WITH PARTICULAR EMPHASIS ON IMMEDIATE APPROVAL OF WALK. PLEASE ADVISE ME ALGIERS REPEAT CAIRO

(TO COMMANDER IN CHIEF AFHQ FOR G-5 FOR SUPPORTED ACTION REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO ACO ROOM FOR KENNY UHRA SIGNED BOND FROM COCHRAN (A/C) CHIEF MEDICAL OFFICER, AGRICULTURAL REHABILITATION SPECIALIST, REQUIREMENTS AND SUPPLY SPECIALIST, TRANSPORTATION SPECIALIST, CHIEF WAREHOUSEMAN, WELFARE SPECIALIST. 4 DISPLACED PERSONS SPECIALISTS, ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS, 2 STENOGRAPHERS. PLEASE DISCUSS WITH GENERAL WILSON AND OBTAIN APPROVAL AGAINST ABOVE CONTINGENCY. IN ANY EVENT OBTAIN IMMEDIATE APPROVAL FOR WILLIAM BARK, ADVISOR ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL PROBLEMS, WHO WILL OBSERVE ECONOMIC, FINANCIAL AND DISTRIBUTION PROBLEMS IN ITALY. HELIX PROCEEDING ALGIERS. MEANWHILE, KEEP KENNY INFORMED OF DEVELOPMENTS." URGE **AWAW** REQUEST FOR APPROVAL BE TAKEN UP WITH GENERAL WILSON WITH PARTICULAR EMPHASIS OF IMMEDIATE APPROVAL OF BARK. PLEASE ADVISE ME ALGIERS REPRAT CAIRO

REFERENCE YOUR CD 2369 OF 25 JULY. IMPORTANCE OF PLANS TO BROADEN MISSION FULLY APPRECIATED. IT IS NOT HOWEVER FELT THAT AT THIS STAGE IT WOULD BE DESIRABLE TO GIVE UNQUALIFIED APPROVAL TO PROPOSAL, STILL LESS AGREE TO RESURRECTION OF MISSION OF THE SIZE SO SUGGESTED. UNTIL POSITION OF HERRA IS MORE CLEAR IT IS FEARED THAT ANY BROADENING OF THE MISSION AS SUGGESTED MIGHT LEAD TO DUPLICATION AND OVERLAPPING WITH ACC WHOSE RESPONSIBILITIES ARE AT PRESENT CONSIDERABLE. RELUCTANT NOW TO ADD ANOTHER TO THESE RESPONSIBILITIES WHICH MIGHT BE BURDENSOME. ALTHOUGH WILLING TO RECONSIDER IN MAY 8 WEEKS. PARA REQUESTED ACCEPT WALK ON BASIS ATTACHED TO ACC AND UNDER ITS ORDERS
