SUBJECT: Chain of Command - Regions still under Army Control.

1. It has been brought to the Chief Commissioner's notice that Sections/Sub-Commissions of this Headquarters have, on occasion, issued directions to Regions in the North, on the assumption that Regional control has been effected. This is not the case. It must be realized that, until you are notified to the contrary, the greater part of the North is still under the administration of SCAO FIFTH or EIGHTH Army, as the case may be, and directions must not at this stage be issued to Regional Commissioners direct, but to SCAO's of Armies. There is no objection to copies being sent to Regional Commissioners for information.

2. In order that there shall be no misapprehension please note that the following Regions are still under Army control:

LOMBARDIA, PIEMONTE, LIGURIA and the following Provinces of EMILIA Region: BOLOGNA, MODENA, REGGIO EMILIA, PARMA and PIACENZA. VENEZIA Region less the Provinces of ROVIGO, PADOVA, VENEZIA, TREVISO, which have just been handed over to Regional control.

18. Rome Area Allied Command deal principally with the Sindaco or his representative. Any requisition affecting monuments, museums, etc, would be referred to Monuments, Fine Arts & Archives Sub-Commission AC.

19. Comparatively few schools have been requisitioned by the Military, but are chiefly occupied by refugees and political parties. Since it is not anticipated that military requirements in this respect will increase no problem is envisaged.

Derequisitioning of essential farm buildings and experimental institutes etc, and encroachments and damage during military exercises

order that CRE may deal with Genio Civile other than through AMG.

Provision of Transport for Civilian Labour employed by Military

11. Road transport as requested by Rome Area Allied Command will be arranged through Dr Tanfani, head of the Uffici Trasporti di Roma, 16, via Sellustio.
12. Tram and train services as requested by Rome Area Allied Command will be arranged through Capt Dean, Transportation Sub-Commission AC.

Signal Communications

13. No difficulty is anticipated since Major Hawke is remaining in Rome for the present. It is not yet known whether he will be attached to Rome Area Allied Command as Signals Liaison Officer, or whether he will be transferred to the Allied Commission. HQ AMG Lazio-Umbria Region will inform Rome Area Allied Command when a decision is known.

Electricity

14. A civilian electricity commission has been set up which will screen civilian demands.
15. This Commission will also arrange running schedules for tramways and railways under CRE's direction.
16. The Electricity Companies will apply for petrol, etc, to the Chamber of Commerce and for tyres to the Prefect.

Medical

17. The changeover has been discussed by the Medical Branches concerned and no difficulties are anticipated.

Accommodation, Quartering and Requisitioning

18. Rome Area Allied Command deal principally with the Sindaco or his representative. Any requisition affecting monuments, museums, etc, would be referred to Monuments, Fine Arts & Archives Sub-Commission AC.

19. Comparatively few schools have been requisitioned by the Military, but are chiefly occupied by refugees and political parties. Since it is not anticipated that military requirements in this respect will increase no problem is envisaged.

Derequisitioning of essential farm buildings and experimental institutes etc, and encroachments and damage during military exercises

20. Rome Area Allied Command will deal with applications for the derequisition of property. HQ AMG Lazio-Umbria Region will arrange for claims in connection with damage arising from military exercises to be referred to Genio Militare.

Local Purchase

21. There are no difficulties regarding Local Purchase at present. Major Cooper, Food Sub-Commission AC will be contacted should any problems arise.

Souvenirs for Troops

22. To avoid overcharging, HQ AMG Lazio-Umbria Region will provide Provost Marshal with a list of reasonable prices for souvenirs.

Date of closing down of HQ AMG Lazio-Umbria Region

23. HQ AMG Lazio-Umbria Region will cease to function by 1 Apr 45. It is understood that Rome and Viterbo Provinces closed down at midnight 28 Feb 45. Frosinone, Littoria and Rieti Provinces, and the Headquarters in Rome, will close on 15 Mar 45.
