1. Your 4/21.B/CA dated 3 May 45, subj: as above, refers.
2. Your attention is invited to restricted cable, HQ 15th Army Group, I-439, copy of which was furnished to the Allied Commission. That cable indicates the control lines which have been finally approved by AFHQ. This I think is in general agreement with the contents of your letter referred to in paragraph 1, above. Cable I-439 was further implemented on the 9th May by our cable I-443, a copy of which was forwarded to you for information. The former Rear Army Security Control Line, now renamed Security Control Line, which runs from the River FIEVE from mouth to road-river crossing G 6494 thence road VITTORIO VENETO B 6712 - PIEVE DI CADORE B 7562 - S. STEFANO DI CADORE B 8875 thence due north to Italo-Austrian frontier. Road and towns thereon to be exclusive repeat exclusive Army Zone and check posts to be sited just east of this line. Fifth Army to be responsible for organizing control from Italo-Austrian frontier to exclusive road junction B 6734 and Eighth Army from exclusive road junction B 6734 to coast.
3. Free movement is to be permitted throughout Italian territory north of the Restricted Line and the Restricted Line has been moved forward to coincide with the Economic Line understood to be established by ALCOM along the northern boundaries of RAVENNA, FLORENCE, PISTOIA, LUCCA and APUANIA Provinces.

SUBJECT : Control of Movement.

TO : Hq 15 Army Group G-5 Sec.

1 On the occasion of the hand-over of further territory to the Italian Govt on 10 May 45, it might be opportune to make alterations in the boundaries between

- (a) Army Zone and Restricted Zone i.e. Rear Army Control Line,
- (b) Restricted Zone and Free Zone i.e. Restricted Line.

It is, of course, fully realized that any decisions on this subject are entirely governed by the military requirements.

2 This Commission requests that you will consider the possibility of the following which is designed for ease of administration from the AMG point of view.

- (a) The Rear Army Control Line to be not further south than the northern boundaries of the Provinces of FERRARA, MODENA, REGGIO EMILIA, PARMA, PIACENZA and the western boundary of LA SPEZIA.
- (b) The Restricted Line to coincide with the Economic Line along the northern boundaries of the Provinces of RAVENNA, FIRENZE, PISTOIA, LUCCA, APUANIA.

3 The object of this proposal is to make the Restricted Line coincide with the Economic Line and give a "cushion" of 1 Province between the Army Zone and the Free Zone.

4 It may not be considered possible to accede to this request on the date mentioned. It would, however, be much appreciated if the various lines could be brought as near as possible to our suggestion by that date and allowed to reach it directly if it is considered feasible.

5 Any movement of the Rear Army Control Line further to the North is, of course, immaterial. The Restricted Zone would not be enlarged to the north until such time as the Economic Section of this Commission can agree to it. It is also presumed that you would require LIVORNO and ANCONA to remain "restricted".

Subject: Control Areas.

To : Distribution below.

1. In view of the large number of problems requiring coordination between Regions the Public Works and Utilities Sub-Commission has found it necessary to divide Italy into three large areas, South Italy, Central Italy and North Italy with an Area Engineer in each area to act as our field representative who will settle such problems as he can on the ground and to keep us fully advised on the progress being made in his area.
2. We have found that not only do the problems differ in each of these areas, but the habits of the people seem to differ and their requirements are different. Electric Transmission Systems and Military Highways are no respectors of administrative boundaries and must be treated from an overall viewpoint, bearing in mind the territory served. The division made fits these problems admirably.
3. We are now functioning very satisfactorily along these lines in South and Central Italy. Insofar as North Italy is concerned Region IX is more accessible from Milan than it is from Rome with the plain of the Po valley extending over about half of that Region and Route 9 is running in a straight line from Milan through Parma and Bologna to Rimini. The problems of North Italy, the industrial section of this country, can be solved by us advantageously if treated as an area, as outlined.
4. The Ministry of Public Works, finding itself short of key engineering personnel, is adopting this same system as it will be of material help in solving its personnel problem.
5. Should it be found desirable at some future date to reduce the control personnel of A.C.C. it is believed that other Sub-Commissions, or Administrative Branches, may find this to be a more convenient division for limited control purposes, than the present larger number of Regions.
6. This is sent to you for information.
7. Attached hereto is a small map showing these Areas and the various Regions.

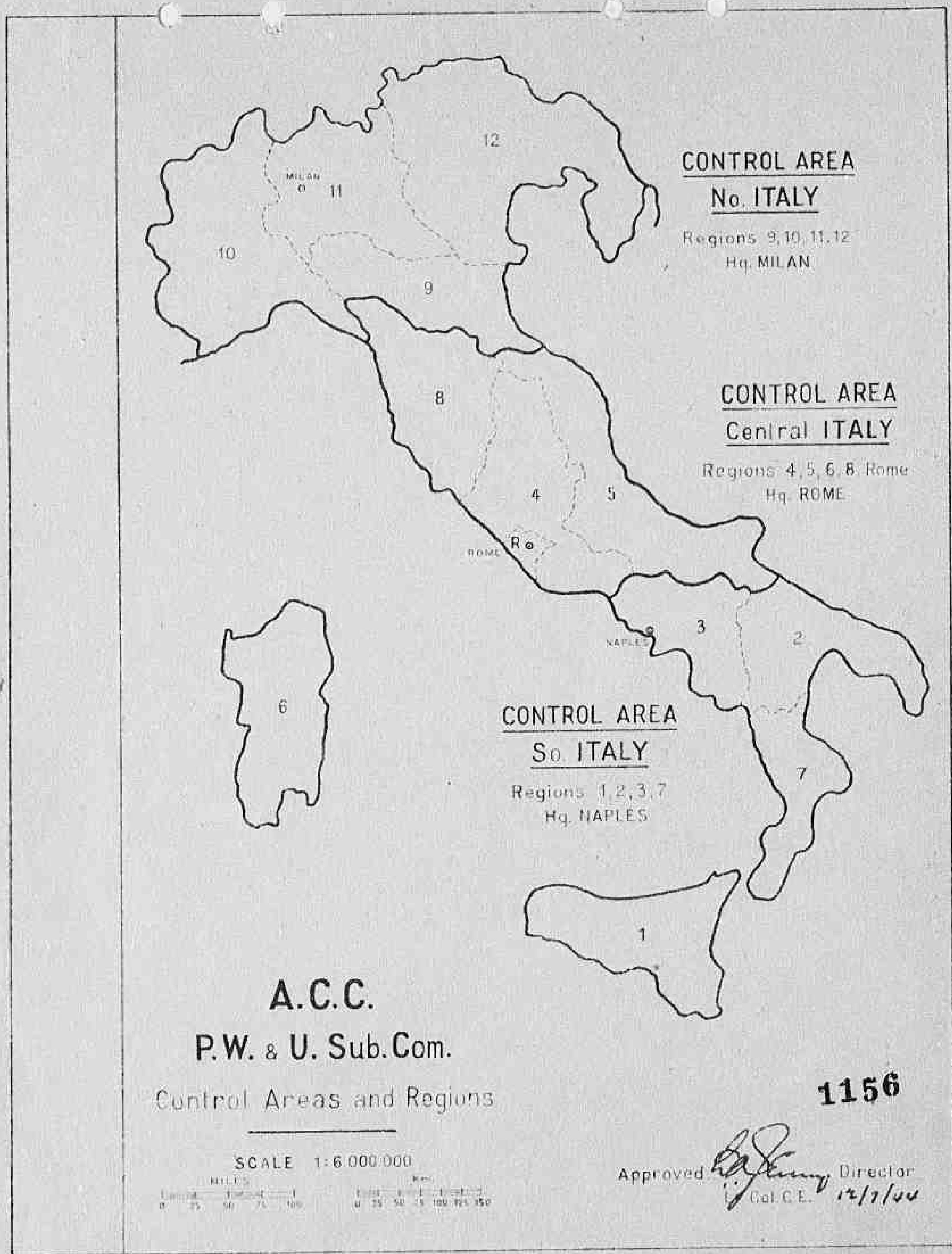

1. Consequent on the Eighth Army's advance an adjustment of its Rear Boundary has been made leaving only a small part of Campobasso Province within the Army area.
2. The only part remaining is forward of a line along the road CASTELLIONE - CARPINONE - ISERNIA thence South to the Provincial Boundary at VALLE AGRICOLA.
3. For the purpose of administration the whole of the Province of Campobasso will be turned over to Region V forthwith.
4. The following conditions will apply until further notice:-
  - (i) There will be no change in the security measures already existing in that portion of the Province still in the Army Area.
  - (ii) Stockpiles in ISERNIA and VENAFRO will remain under control Eighth Army and will be operated in conjunction with Region V Provinces as at present.
  - (iii) All refugee camps and mobile hospitals will remain under control Eighth Army.
