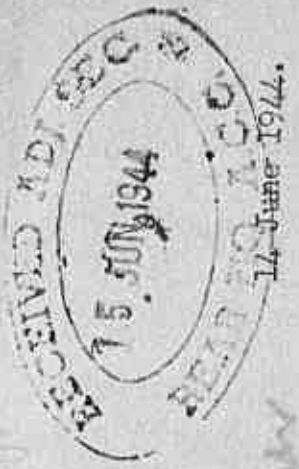

1. INFORMATION.

Reference Movement Order No. 1, dated 10 June 1944.

2. INTENTION.

ADVANCE HEADQUARTERS will move to ROME in two convoys on 15 June 1944.

3. METHOD.

- a. Comdr. Convoy A: Colonel M. H. MEANEY
- Comdr. Convoy B: Lt Colonel H. F. W. MILLAR

b. Vehicle Loading Table: See Appendix "A".

c. Assembly Area A & B Convoys: PIAZZA PROVINCIA and VIA ARMANDO DIAZ, NAPLES.

Assembly Time: Convoy A complete 2330 hours, 14 June 1944.  
Convoy B complete 0030 hours, 15 June 1944.

- d. (i) Start Point: W corner of PIAZZA PROVINCIA.
- (ii) Start Time: Convoy A, 0005 hours  
Convoy B, 0100 hours

e. Route: Route 7 - See Appendix "B".

f. Halts: 10 minutes halt at 10 minutes to every second hour.  
One hour halt after each 5 hours.  
Vehicles will not close up at halts, and will pull well into the side of the road.

Convoy Group Commanders will check vehicles and personnel at each halt.  
Road sentries will be posted at each halt.

All vehicles will be numbered serially with numbers on tailboard, i.e., A1 or B1, etc.  
In each convoy, leading vehicle will carry a blue flag, and rear vehicle a green flag.

Repellent ointment will be applied to exposed parts of the body during hours sunset to one hour after sunrise.

(iii) Atabrine will be issued with rations.

(iv) Discipline - Drivers will adhere to density laid down.  
No personnel will dismount from vehicles until ordered to do so by Convoy Commanders.  
Breakdowns will be notified to Convoy Commanders as soon as possible.
