MEMORANDUM FOR: Executive Commissioner, Hq. ACC

1. I have informed the Undersecretary of the Presidency of the Council of Ministers, Sig. Fernaltea, that Ministerial Undersecretaries now in Rome may now be permitted to enter their respective Ministries. Their functions will be limited to personnel reorganization, "house-keeping", and related organizational problems in order that when the government is transferred from Salerno to Rome, the Ministries will be set up and ready to function. In the meantime, the Government will continue to operate in Salerno.

SUBJECT : Passes for ROME.

TO : All Admin Sub-Commissions.

- 1 ACC Officers the procedure is laid down in 750/2 GA of 5 Jun.
 - a This Section has been informed that endorsement of applications by the VP will facilitate and expedite the granting of passes.
 - b Sub-Commissions desiring to obtain such an endorsement will attach to the application a memo addressed to the VP containing a short statement as to the reasons for the visit and a certificate that the visit is essential and cannot without detriment to ACC work be deferred to a later date. Below their signature they will add an endorsement "Approved" addressed to the Security Branch and signed by the CSO for VP Adm Sec.
- 2 Italian Officials : the procedure is laid down in 751/7 of 7 Jun.
 - a The CC desires that visits by Italian Nationals should be confined to the minimum.
 - b Applications for passes for Ministers and Under Secretaries will be submitted to the Secretary General.
 - c Applications for other Italian nationals will only be granted in exceptional circumstances, and will be submitted through the VP in manner similar to that described in para 1 b above.

SUBJECT: Rome Planning.

TO : V.P. Admin. Section.

1. With reference to your 4/25.2/AS of 6 June 1944, the date after which the parties of Italian Officials may be permitted to enter Rome cannot yet be given.
2. The composition of the parties should be re-examined in view of recent political changes.
3. Attention is directed to the provisions of letter ^{751/7}~~752/7~~/CA of 7 June 44, which will have to be observed in each individual case of Italian Officials comprising these parties. Arrangements to obtain the necessary authorities and passes may be taken in hand now.
