SUBJECT : Nazi War Criminals

TO : Ministry of Foreign Affairs
(for Marchese Cittadini - Cesi)

- 1 Will you please note that APHQ has now laid it down that requests to trace or arrest wanted war criminals can only be complied with if it is supplied with:
 - a) sufficient particulars of the wanted persons to enable them to be identified.
 - b) Particulars (in English) of the facts alleged.
 - c) A very brief summary (in English) of the evidence connecting them with the crime.
- 2 The list enclosed in your 6/3609/1687 of 28 Sep has therefore been returned to enable you to supply the further particulars which will be necessary.
As to item 1. The identification and the facts alleged appear to be sufficiently identified; but a short summary of the evidence will be required.
As to item 2. There is no identification. You will doubtless be able to ascertain what unit was at present at the time and place mentioned, possibly even the names of the officers; arrangements can then be made for you to conduct an interrogation, after which you should be in a position to supply the particulars to enable this case to be put forward.
