SUBJECT: Coal for Bomba Cement Works.

1. Ref. our R5/518/55/1 of 15 October 1944 and attached Mat 10.
2. May an allocation of Sardinian Coal please be made to Bomba Cement Works (Bomba, Chieti province,) ? This could come from any Puglia port by schooner to Torino di Sangro (Chieti) or by rail to Torino di Sangro or S.Vito (Chieti), preferably not more than 2 wagons at one time.
3. Besides the Regional Engineer who is most anxious to get cement production going, the Devastated Areas are now interested not only for the cement but to give employment as Bomba is in Devastated Area District.

1. Reference is made to letter by this Section to Italian Ministry of War (9/8.4/44) dated 2 Dec 44 wherein it is laid down that MCM for Mine Clearance Squads must be indented for through Italian Ministry of War channels.
2. Before demands for MCM can be made by Liaison Officers transport will have to be provided. This will have to be found from Civilian sources and Regions should give all assistance in this, either by hire or by requisitioning.
3. The Italian Government have given instructions to their Liaison Officers to visit Regional HQs. One of the questions they will raise will be the provision of transport. The Liaison Officers should know their requirements and where the transport is required.

SUBJECT: Line Clearance - Petrol.

TO: Ministry of War
Italian Government
Via XX Settembre
ROME

1. It has been decided that the supply of petrol oil and lubricants to all Italian line clearance units will be handled through the "Line Clearance" in accordance with the supply to the Italian Army (on operational units).
2. Demand and distribution will be dealt with as follows:
 - a) Our Liaison Officers will be responsible for originating the demands and forwarding them to our Ministry. The demand will be supported by vehicle figures as is done at present.
 - b) Our Ministry will include these demands in the consolidated monthly demand presented to Land Forces Sub-Commission (LFA) stating at what points the supplies are required.
 - c) Supplies will then be made available at the points required through the local Italian Command.
 - d) Accounting for the petrol will be handled in a similar way as now in force for the supply to Italian Army units in rear of Army boundaries.
3. This letter has been agreed by Land Forces Sub-Commission.
