1. GOC 3 District has expressed concern at the number of applications which are being put forward for marriages with Italian girls, and wishes all possible means to be taken to discourage them. He wishes officers commanding units, before forwarding such applications, to satisfy themselves that the applicants are fully aware, both of their responsibilities and of the disadvantages inherent in these marriages.
2. The GOC considers that as a general rule Os C units should not consider applications until the parties have had a six months acquaintanceship. When an application comes up for consideration, the applicant will be interviewed and must be warned of the dangers involved, and that a further period of six months waiting is to be imposed before submission to the GOC for his consideration.
3. It is desirable that the matter be brought early to the notice of the chaplain of the appropriate denomination of the soldier concerned, and that his aid be enlisted before the application is formally considered by the CO.
4. It is in any case essential that applicants shall sooner or later be interviewed by the chaplain of their own denomination, and in all cases submitted to this HQ, a certificate will be forwarded that this has been done.

It is understood to be the policy of the Roman Catholic Church that no priest shall perform the marriage ceremony between a British soldier and an Italian girl without the formal permission of the competent military HQ, and further, that any parish priest, on being informed of any intention to marry in such circumstances, is charged to bring the matter to the notice of the nearest CP (RC).

They were bitter and despised enemies, and though it would be wrong to keep old wounds open, very many families in Great Britain have lost husbands, fathers, sons and brothers fighting against Italy. They will not be likely to welcome as a neighbour an Italian wife.

(b) Acquaintanceship in Italy must almost invariably be superficial and of brief duration. Marriage on such slight foundations must be a very hazardous venture. A large number of Italian families are filled with the idea that the standard of life in Great Britain is very high, and that the British soldier is a very good match. Many are prepared to go to great lengths to secure a British soldier as a husband for their daughters. Men have found themselves hustled from a passing infatuation into a hasty marriage.

- (c) In the great majority of cases there is the difference of religion, which is a greater obstacle in the way of a happy marriage than is commonly realised by the average British soldier. This is an aspect on which the chaplain will be best fitted to advise, and it is an aspect which is of profound importance.
- (d) It is important to remember the difference in living conditions between the Italian people and our own. Such things as different styles in cooking may seem trivial, but are apt in time to become real difficulties in the way of a happy married life.
- (e) It is the duty of any man contemplating marriage to consider the security he has to offer his wife, and to reflect on the change in his conditions, which may follow his return to civil life at the close of hostilities.
6. After these considerations have been laid before the applicant and he has been given time for reflection, if he is still of the same mind, the usual investigations as laid down in GRO 162/44 will be instituted. Os C units will satisfy themselves that both parties are free to marry. Army records are not always reliable in this respect and cases have been known of men recorded as single who are in fact married. At least one case is known of a man, who subsequently turned out to have a wife in England, going through a form of marriage with an Italian girl. Evidence must be produced from the Police or a JP or Minister of Religion.
7. After this, and after a further period as prescribed in para 2 above, the case may be submitted through this HQ to GOC No.3 District.

(b) *Loss of Pay (Non-commissioned men)*

(i) *Army Order 14/43 para 16 (h)*

«A soldier paid under scale D suffering from venereal disease or its effects, due to his own fault, or from the results of alcoholism, as certified by the medical officer, shall not be regarded as having maintained his standard of physical efficiency, and from the date inclusive on which such inefficiency became apparent he shall be reclassified in Class (ii). On his return to ordinary duty such soldier may be restored to the class previously held as from the date on which he is certified as physically fit to carry out his full duties by a specialist in venereal disease (if reclassified for that reason) or the medical officer of his unit (if reclassified for alcoholism, or for venereal disease should specialist opinion not be available at the time), provided that the commanding officer is then satisfied that the soldier is in all respects again qualified for his former classification; otherwise it will be restored when the commanding officer is so satisfied. A soldier of the rank of private or its equivalent paid under Scale A will be dealt with similarly except that he will not be reduced below Class (i)».

(ii) *Army Order 14/43 para. 8*

«The initial grant of any increase of pay for length of service shall not be made if, at the date the increase becomes due, the soldier is suffering from venereal disease or its effects, due to his own fault, or from the effects of alcoholism, as certified by the medical officer any increase withheld for these reasons shall be allowed only from the date on which the soldier is certified as physically fit to carry out his full duties by a specialist in venereal disease (if the increase is withheld for that reason) or the medical officer of his unit (if the increase is withheld for alcoholism or for venereal disease should specialist opinion not be available at the time)».

(c) *Loss of Pay (Tradesmen)*

«Should a soldier after having been placed in a class subsequently fall below the standard prescribed for that class or fail to show diligence in his duties, he shall be disgraced to a lower class or he may be removed from the tradesmen's groups altogether».

162. Marriage Regulations—Italy and Sicily

1. Marriages between persons one of whom is a member of the United Kingdom military forces or is a British national subject to United Kingdom military law may be solemnized in Italy or Sicily in accordance with the following regulations and not otherwise.

2. Two alternative forms of marriage are authorized:—

- (a) Marriage «in the lines» in accordance with Section 22 of the Foreign Marriage Act, 1892, by a Chaplain or Appointed Officer.
- (b) Marriage by the appropriate authorities under local Italian law.

3. A person wishing to marry will apply for permission on Form A (see appendix) giving full particulars and indicating which type of marriage he or she desires.

Form A will be submitted (in duplicate) to his or her CO with Form B on reverse.

If the other party to the proposed marriage is NOT either,

- (a) A member of the United Kingdom Naval, Military or Air Forces, or
- (b) A British national, subject to United Kingdom military law, the applicant will also complete (in duplicate) Form C, which will be submitted to the CO with Forms A and B.

4. The CO will point out to the applicant that whilst marriage in the lines is valid by the law of the United Kingdom, it may not be recognized by the laws of other countries. If, therefore, the parties do not propose to live in the United Kingdom, they should either be married by the local Italian law or, after a marriage in the lines, be remarried in the country where they settle.

If the applicant wishes to be married according to local law, the CO will also point out that military consent does *not* dispense with the necessity for complying with the requirements of the local law, and that it will be the applicant's duty to fulfil those requirements.

5. The CO will satisfy himself from unit records and such other inquiries as he may consider necessary, (a) that the nationality of the *applicant* is as stated; (b) that the applicant is over 21 years of age and free to marry; (c) that it is not otherwise undesirable for the marriage to proceed.

He will then forward the papers, with his recommendation on Form B, to Bde or Area HQ.

6. (a) Where the case is NOT one in which Form C is required, the Bde or Area Comd will give his decision on Form B.

(b) Where Form C is required, the Bde or Area Comd will forward the papers with his recommendation on Form B to the Corps or District Comd who will take such steps as may be necessary to satisfy himself that there is no security objection and that it is not otherwise undesirable for the marriage to proceed. He will return the papers, with his decision on Form B, to the Bde or Area HQ.

The authority of the Corps or District Comd may be exercised on his behalf by his senior Administrative Staff Officer.

7. Bde or Area HQ will dispose of the papers, if the application is approved, according to the type of marriage desired, viz., to the appropriate Chaplain or Appointed Officer or, if a local marriage is specified, to the applicant himself. In the latter case the applicant will be informed that he must produce Form B to the local marriage authorities, whether clerical or civil, in addition to fulfilling all the requirements of the local law.

His attention will also be drawn to the note at the foot of Form B requiring the production to his CO of a Marriage Certificate for registration after the marriage (see para. 14 (c) on page 5).

Its advantages are—

- (a) No money passes and there is, therefore, no risk of loss.
- (b) The soldier does not himself receive any documents, which are kept securely in the UK.
- (c) It entails a minimum of accounting in the unit.

4. Units ex-MEF should note (*vide* MEGO 22 and 881/43 Section A5)—

- (a) that a soldier can under the Savings Bank (Active Service) Scheme, save either by making a fixed allotment, or by making a casual deposit (on AF 01727A) to his credit with The Post Office Savings Bank (Army Branch).
- (b) that money to a soldier's credit in excess of £3 at the Post Office Savings Bank (Army Branch), may, if desired, be used to purchase National Savings Certificates.

5. In connection with the Savings Bank (Active Service) Scheme, attention is drawn to ACI 1759/43. The Regimental Paymaster, Post Office Savings Bank (Army Branch), 129-137, Marylebone Road, London, NW 1, has now taken over all work in connection with the maintenance of Savings Bank Accounts of Army Depositors and is also available as a depository for the safe custody of Army Savings Books. It is emphasized that the transfer of the Post Office Savings Bank accounts of Army Depositors to the Post Office Savings Bank (Army Branch) has been made for administrative convenience only and does not in any way alter or vary the Post Office Savings Bank rules governing Savings Bank Accounts, and a soldier's deposits in his Savings Bank Account cannot be attached for any Army debt or liability.

6. There has been a good response by most units in this theatre to the demand for saving, but it is stressed that it is the duty of every officer to bring to the notice of all his men the need for increasing economy and the advantages of maximum saving.

The money invested will not only help the country now, but it will be available to the soldier on demobilization.

All commanding officers will therefore ensure that there is set up in their units the necessary machinery to implement the Savings Bank (Active Service) Scheme or, if preferred, the Outright Purchase (Overseas) Scheme.

161. VD Discipline

1. Concealment

By King's Regulations, para 555, a soldier who is suffering from VD must report himself sick without delay. Concealment of the disease delays treatment and causes a loss of manpower to the Army.

Concealment is a serious crime and will henceforth be dealt with by a court martial in all cases, charges being preferred under Sec 11 of the Army Act.

2. Financial Penalties

Owing to the prevalence of VD in this theatre it is of the utmost importance that all ranks should be acquainted with the possible financial consequences of contracting the disease due to their own fault. The following will be read on parade at the earliest opportunity and thereafter quarterly:—

(a) Hospital charges

A soldier admitted to hospital on account of VD or its effects due to his own fault is required to pay hospital charges of 1/6d a day (*vide* Allowance Regulations, para 63 (D) extract below).

(b) Loss of Pay (Non-Tradesmen)

Where a soldier is suffering from VD or its effects due to his own fault and is unable to carry out his normal duties he will be reclassified as laid down in para 16 (b) Army Order 14/43 (extracts below). This means in effect that he loses what was formerly known as war time and special proficiency pay. In addition a soldier suffering as above is not entitled to the initial grant of any increase of pay for length of service (*vide* para. 8 of Army Order 14/43—extract below). Full particulars are given in GRO 617/43.

(c) Loss of Pay (Tradesmen)

When a tradesmen is suffering from VD or its effects due to his own fault and is unable to follow his trade he may be degraded to a lower class or removed from the tradesmen's groups altogether (*vide* RW Act 820).

(d) Loss of Paid Acting Rank

Paid acting rank is relinquished from the date of admission to hospital (GRO 101/43). Soldiers who revert to private or equivalent suffering from VD as above are not given an unpaid lance corporal stripe on such relinquishment as in other cases (GRO 707/43).

(e) Result of decrease of Pay

A decrease in pay results in an automatic decrease in the amount of the qualifying allotment payable to a wife.

3. Authority

The following extracts from regulations are the authority for the above financial penalties:—

(a) Hospital charges

Allowance Regs, para 63

«When patients are admitted to military hospitals the daily rate of charge will be as follows:—

(d) Soldiers (including reservists called out for duty or training)

(i) Normally—nil.

(ii) If suffering from sickness due to their own fault—1/6d (men)».

(b) *Loss of Pay (Non-commissioned men)*

(i) *Army Order 14/43 para 16 (b)*

«A soldier paid under scale D suffering from venereal disease or its effects, due to his own fault, or from the results of alcoholism, as certified by the medical officer, shall not be regarded as having maintained his standard of physical efficiency, and from the date inclusive on which such inefficiency became apparent he shall be reclassified in Class (ii). 162. Marriage Regulations—Italy and Sicily

- (a) Marriage «in the lines» in accordance with Section 22 of the Foreign Marriage Act, 1892, by a Chaplain or Appointed Officer.
- (b) Marriage by the appropriate authorities under local Italian law.

7. Bde or Area HQ will dispose of the papers, if the application is approved, according to the type of marriage desired, viz., to the appropriate Chaplain or Appointed Officer or, if a local marriage is specified, to the applicant himself. In the latter case the applicant will be informed that he must produce Form B to the local marriage authorities, whether clerical or civil, in addition to fulfilling all the requirements of the local law.

His attention will also be drawn to the note at the foot of Form B requiring the production to his CO of a Marriage Certificate for registration after the marriage (see para. 14 (c) on page 5).

8. Where both parties to the marriage are members of the United Kingdom military forces or British nationals subject to United Kingdom military law, each will make an application and obtain the consent required by para. 6 above, and the two applications will be co-ordinated.

9. Where the other party to the marriage is a member of the United States forces or a Dominion force, the consent in writing of the Commanding General of the United States force or of the Officer Commanding the Dominion force (as the case may be), or of a person to whom authority has been delegated by either of them, will be obtained and forwarded to Corps or District HQ before the consent of the Commander (as required by para. 6 (b) above) is given.

10. In considering whether permission to marry should be given, COs and Commanders will bear in mind that the general policy is to dissuade members of the forces from marriage overseas. If both the parties are domiciled in the same country, the advantages of waiting until they return home should be pointed out. Marriage with a person belonging to a different country, particularly by young soldiers, is open to obvious risks of future unhappiness, and it is important that every reasonable effort be made by COs (with the help if necessary of the Chaplain) to protect them from improvidence and impetuosity.

With this object in view, consent should be refused outright if the authority concerned is not satisfied that a reasonable basis for a happy marriage exists, and in other cases a period of at least 60 days should be imposed between the date of the application and the date on which the marriage is authorized, unless there are circumstances making this delay undesirable or unnecessary.

11. The expression « Chaplain » means a Chaplain to the Forces or a minister of religion duly appointed as Officiating Chaplain (KR 1940, para. 1613), subject in the latter case to the concurrence of the DCG, AFHQ. Any case of doubt as to a Chaplain's commission or authority should be referred to AFHQ (G1 B).

The form of service to be used by Chaplains in solemnizing marriages will be that prescribed by the Church in which he is ordained or ministers.

12. Officers of the staff of the JAG are hereby designated Appointed Officers for the purpose of solemnizing civil marriages under Section 22 of the Foreign Marriage Act, 1892, in accordance with the provisions of this GRO.

The form of marriage to be used by Appointed Officers is set out in Appendix D.

13. When the parties desire a religious marriage ceremony to be conducted by a minister of a religion or denomination which is not represented by any Chaplain as defined in para. 11 above, such ceremony must be in addition to, and not in substitution for the solemnization of the legal contract, whether by Chaplain or Appointed Officer.

14. (a) A Register of Marriages (AB 113) will be maintained only by GHQ 2nd Echelon.

(b) When a marriage in the lines (see para. 2 (a)) has been solemnized, the Chaplain or Appointed Officer will complete three copies of AF A43a, which will be signed by all concerned.

In completing this form, the Chaplain or Appointed Officer will insert before his signature the words « In accordance with Section 22 of the Foreign Marriage Act, 1892, » and will sign with his appointment (CF or Appointed Officer as the case may be).

One copy of AF A43a will be forwarded by the Chaplain or Appointed Officer to the ACG, who will be responsible for ensuring that it is sent to GHQ 2nd Echelon. The second copy will be marked « Duplicate » and will be retained by the Chaplain or Appointed Officer until the end of the war or until he returns to the United Kingdom, when he will send all completed forms to the Registrar-General, Somerset House, London.

The Chaplain or Appointed Officer will mark the third copy « Triplicate, » delete the certificate at the bottom of the form which begins « The above marriage has been duly registered by me . . . » and hand it to the parties for retention in case a record of the marriage is not received by the Registrar-General and AF A43b (see below) does not reach the parties.

On receipt of AF A43a, DAG, GHQ 2nd Echelon, will make a copy of it in AB 113 and send the original form to the Registrar-General, Somerset House, London. He will also complete AF A43b and send it to the Chaplain or Appointed Officer for handing to the parties free of charge.

(c) When a marriage has been solemnized in accordance with local law (see para. 2 (b)), the applicant will (immediately) produce to his CO a certified extract of the entry in the local Marriage Register. The CO will complete AF A43a from the particulars given in the marriage certificate and forward it to GHQ 2nd Echelon with the casualty notifying the marriage. The marriage certificate will immediately be handed back by the CO to the applicant.

In completing AF A43a, care should be taken that the particulars recorded are in exact accordance with those contained in the certificate produced. The copy signatures should be preceded by the word « (Signed) ».

On receipt of AF A43a, DAG, GHQ 2nd Echelon, will make a copy of it in AB 113 and send the original form to the Registrar-General, Somerset House, London.

(d) The certified extracts on AF A43, required by KR 1940, para. 1741 (b), will be rendered half-yearly in accordance with that paragraph.

A stock of AFs A43a will be held by ACsG and DACsG and SCsF (RC) and may be obtained from them.

FOREIGN MARRIAGE ACT, 1892, Section 22

Instructions for the guidance of appointed officers officiating at civil marriages under the orders of the Commander in Chief, Allied Forces, Mediterranean Theatre.

1. Before an appointed officer solemnizes any marriage within the lines, he must be in possession of the Notice of Marriage (Appendix A) and certificate of approval (Appendix B).

2. The appointed officer will maintain a book in which, before he solemnizes any marriage, the parties appearing before him will subscribe a declaration of freedom to marry. (See form of ceremony and specimen page below.)

3. The marriage must be solemnized with open doors (i.e. doors not so closed as to prevent persons from entering) and in the presence of the contract-

ing parties, the appointed officer, and two credible witnesses, who must in all cases be provided by the parties to the marriage. The appointed officer must not under any circumstances allow any religious service or ceremony whatever to be used at a marriage solemnized by him. The giving and receiving of a ring does not, however, constitute a religious ceremony and may, therefore, be allowed.

4. The appointed officer should always insist upon seemly behaviour by the parties and witnesses, as befitting the importance of the occasion.

5. On the completion of the ceremony the parties will sign AF A43a (in triplicate), the wife signing in her pre-marriage name. The witnesses will then sign, and finally the appointed officer. The latter will insert before his signature «in accordance with Section 22 of the Foreign Marriage Act, 1892,» and below his signature «Appointed Officer.» Particulars of the parties may conveniently be entered on AF A43a before the ceremony.

FORM OF CEREMONY

For the solemnization of a marriage by an officer or other person (not being a Chaplain) officiating under the orders of the Commanding Officer of a British Army serving abroad, within the meaning of Section 22 of the Foreign Marriage Act, 1892.

PROCEDURE

The parties being standing before the officiating officer, with their witnesses, the following procedure is adopted by the officer solemnizing the marriage:

1. SECTION 22 of the FOREIGN MARRIAGE ACT, 1892, is read:—

Foreign Marriage Act, 1892. An Act to consolidate Enactments relating to the Marriage of British Subjects outside the United Kingdom.

Be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:.....

It is hereby declared that all marriages solemnized within the British lines by any chaplain or officer or other person officiating under the orders of the Commanding Officer of a British Army serving abroad, shall be as valid in law as if the same had been solemnized within the United Kingdom, with a due observance of all forms required by law.

2. Para. 8 of GRO 162/44 AUTHORIZING THE OFFICIATING OFFICER TO PERFORM THE MARRIAGE, is read, viz.:—Officers of the staff of the J.A.G. are hereby designated Appointed Officers for the purpose of solemnizing civil marriages under Section 22 of the Foreign Marriage Act, 1892.

3. To the BRIDEGROOM.

Repeat after me, giving your name and the Bride's name in full:

I do solemnly declare that I know not of any lawful impediment why I may not be joined in matrimony to

4. The Second Declaration is made by the Male Party:

I call upon the persons here present to witness that I (naming himself) do take you (naming the other party by her maiden name) to be my lawful wedded wife.

5. If a ring is used, it is now put on.

6. The Second Declaration is made by the Female Party:

I call upon the persons here present to witness that I (naming herself by her maiden name) do take you (naming the other party) to be my lawful wedded husband.

7. The pronouncement of the marriage is made by the Officiating Officer:

By the pronouncement of these declaratory and contracting words by both parties, you (naming the husband) and you (naming the wife by her married name) have become man and wife, and I now register your marriage in the presence of you both and of the witnesses.

163. Candidates for Transfer to the Army Educational Corps

1. Waiting lists of candidates for transfer to the Army Educational Corps will be compiled at AFHQ as follows:—

(a) Officers recommended for transfer to the AEC.

(b) Other Ranks recommended for emergency commissions in the AEC.

(c) Other Ranks recommended for transfer with a view to employment as serjeant instructors.

Candidates will be selected from the lists for transfer to, or commissions in, the AEC as required, to fill vacancies.

2. (a) Officers and other ranks who are desirous of inclusion in the waiting lists will apply as shown in para 4 below.

(b) Candidates who have previously submitted applications under GRO's 305/43 or 596/43 and have been interviewed by an AEC Interviewing Board and recommended for transfer, but who have not so far been transferred, will, if so desirous, be included in the waiting lists provided they have the necessary qualifications listed in para 3 (a) and (b). Candidates who have previously submitted applications and have been rejected may, if they wish and if they have the necessary qualifications, re-submit their applications.

(c) Applications from the following cannot be considered:—

- (i) Officers holding regular commissions.
- (ii) Officers holding substantive or war substantive rank higher than major.
- (iii) Other ranks serving on normal Regular Army engagements.
- (iv) Tradesmen in Groups A and B.

3. (a) To be eligible for inclusion of his name in the waiting list a candidate under para 1 (a) or (b), must:—

- (i) be over 33 years of age, or in medical category «B»;
- (ii) be an honours graduate with experience of teaching and/or education administration;
- (iii) in the case of an other rank candidate for an immediate emergency commission in the AEC, be recommended by a War Office Selection Board.

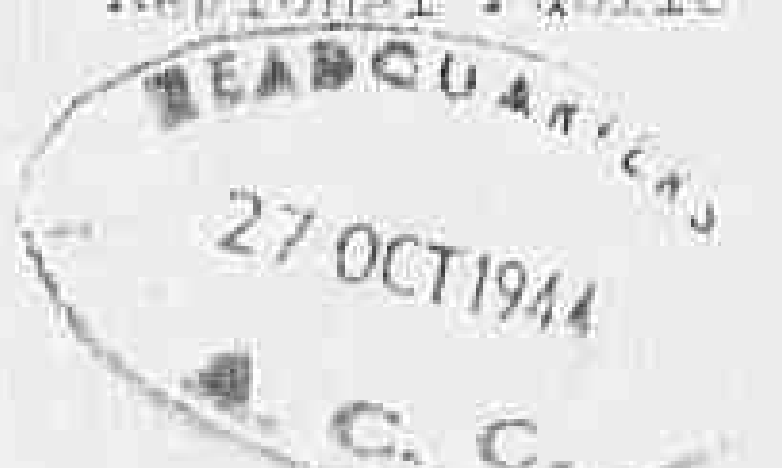

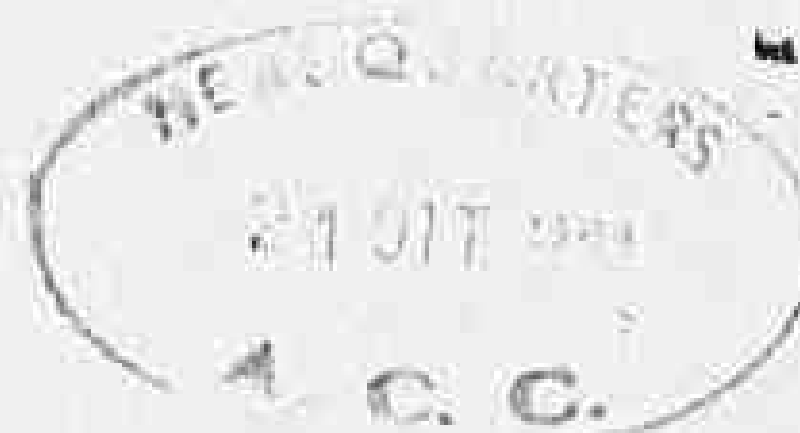

When the Germans violently took possession of two private cars, belonging to Dr. IMPARATO Emilio (living at Castellammare di Stabia), he denounced the fact to the P.S. of Castellammare on the 1st October and 25th of December 1943 asserting that on the 24th September of the same year, some German officers, with the complicity of Miss DELLA ROLA and others, sacked his garage and took away two cars of about a hundred thousand lire. Consequently DELLA ROLA was denounced to the Police Authorities on the 12th of March 1944 for complicity in the sacking and robbing of the said garage.

Through confidential information it appears that she did not lend a real collaboration to the Germans, but was only implied in the case as an interpreter and she could not refuse for fear of retaliation.

When the Allies came to Castellammare she sympathised with them and even got officially engaged to one of the soldiers.

She has been a member of the Juvenile Fascist Organisation, but did not partake in any political activity.

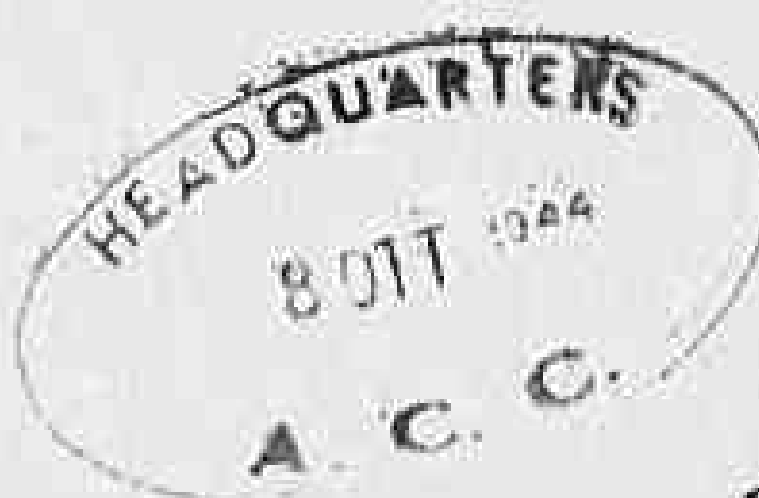
