Instances have been reported where the owners or managers of industrial and business concerns have been removed by unofficial internal commissions of workers or employees and replaced by nominees of such commissions. Immediate steps will be taken to prevent action of this kind and to ensure that where for political or other reasons a concern cannot continue to operate under the existing management the control is vested in properly qualified personnel.
2. With this object in view D.S.C.A.O.'s are directed in appropriate cases to appoint Receivers of industrial and commercial concerns in accordance with the provisions of HQ ALCOM Directive AC/4183/L dated 17 March 1945.
