 2. The Gregorian University have asked our help in securing 2 truck tyres size 32 X 6 for a truck which hauls the necessary food stuffs.
 3. This University is a large and important one and of course it must be fed.

4. The other request is one that was made to me some time ago by Cardinal Gasparri for 4 used Jeep size tires for his Dodge car.
 5. When we first entered Rome the cardinal's car was stolen and smashed up by drunken allied soldiers.
 6. Maj.Gen. Harry Johnson had the car repaired and in view of the fact that the incident was an unfortunate one which the Cardinal made no complain about, Gen. Johnson promised that the allied authorities would do what they could to make amends in future.
 7. Because I worked under Gen. Johnson as well as under AMG in my Vatican relations job, Gen. Johnson told the Cardinal to apply to me for help when should need it.
 8. I have tried to get tires through RAAC without success. The Cardinal of course is not aware of the distinction between RAAC and AC and simply remembers what Gen. Johnson has said.
 9. Therefore if without upsetting other needs it should be possible to get these tires, I believe that it would increase respect for our promises if we could do so.

(c) In the case of G-4(A), the indent, or requisition, will be accompanied by either the old tire or tube together with a certificate of "fair wear and tear" signed by the responsible officer; or failing the return of the old tire or tube, a certificate of "droppage", i.e. a certificate to the effect that the item has been lost, damaged, or destroyed without fault or neglect by the party concerned in accordance with MTOUSA Circular No. 57. Headquarters G-4(A) will draw from Ordnance stores and will advise Regional Headquarters where and when to collect. In order to avoid undue loss of time which might be caused by application to HQ A.C., it has been arranged that application may be made direct to the nearest Medium Maintenance Ordnance shop where the exchange will be made on the same lines.

(d) Headquarters A.C. Commandant will indent in the same manner as above for W.D. vehicles and apply as below for requisitioned vehicles.

(e) AC/AMG regional pools, by which it is understood all requisitioned vehicles used by AC/AMG Officials and carrying the AC green and white registration permit. Applications for tires for these vehicles should be made directly to Commerce S/C, HQ A.C. on the forms provided. These tires and tubes will not be charged, but a Pro Forma invoice will be rendered for accounting purposes.

(f) Civilian applicants, by which it is understood vehicles owned and operated by civilians including E.M.A.C., and Italian officials, and carrying a yellow and white circulation permit with, however, the exceptions as given in the following paragraph. Such tires and tubes will be billed.

Note: In sending in particulars for tires and tubes sub-paragraphs e and f are entered on separate forms.

4. Regional Transportation Officers will not be responsible for the following:

- I. Pet. Sec., ARHQ, will collate CIP requirements and forward to this Headquarters.

II. Transportation S/C will collate and forward Italian State Railways requirements.

III. Public Works and Utilities S/C will collate and forward requirements of

(a) Regional Genio Civile

(b) Appaltatori

(c) Utility companies

IV. Headquarters Commandant will collate and forward requirements for Super Garage.

5. Instructions regarding retreading and repairing tires will follow at a later date.

6. In view of the great scarcity of rubber, it is strongly recommended that salvage tires and/or tubes be taken in equal exchange against fresh issues. Those taken in exchange will be collected as scrap rubber and held until arrangements have been made to receive same at Fivelli Depots.

7. Full justifications must accompany all demands for tires and tubes so as to include the following information:

(a) Complete data on tire and tube requirements for AC/AMG Regional Pools, civilian vehicles; by quantity and size.

(b) Show breakdown as to what quantities are for goods by categories, i.e. Agriculture and food stuffs, Industry and Commerce, Medical. Also personnel transport, bus services, etc.

8. For the guidance of the Regional Transportation Officer the following priorities are recommended:

CARS

1. A.C. Regional pools.
2. Italian Government Officials and monopolies.
3. Police, guard, and fire.
4. Agriculture and food.

5. Physicians and ambulances.
6. Provincial and Communal Administration.
7. Industry and commercial haulage control of concerns of national interest.

TRUCKS

1. A.C. Regional pools.
2. Police, guards, and fire.
3. Food and Agriculture haulage.
4. Medical and hospitals.
5. Provincial, Communal Administration and municipalities.
6. Industry and Commercial haulage for concerns of national interest.

9. Approved demands for other than W.D. vehicles, should be sent in monthly by regions and units for all outstanding requirements to this HQ to arrive during the first week of each month.

10. As supplies become available, the largest possible allocation will be made to each region and units by the AC Priorities Board, as far as other than W.D. vehicles are concerned. Approved requirements, except for those noted in para. 4, will be met by Regional Transportation Officers from the release orders sent to them, bearing in mind the suggested priorities listed in para. 6 c above.

11. Prices as attached list are understood ex depots and regional accounts will be forwarded at first of each month, for the preceding month.

12. Regional Headquarters will be invoiced directly for all tires and tubes issued. Two accounts will be forwarded each month, i.e., a cash account for items issued for sale (civilian), and a Pro Forma account for those released for military use; vide para 3, (e) and (f).

13. All regions, as well as units listed in paragraph 4, will submit monthly reports to tire section, Commerce Sub-Commission. These reports will show distribution of tires and tubes per category and individual vehicle.

14. Accounting will continue to be as set out in Finance Sub-Commission memorandum, ref. 13617/F/A, dated 9 January 1945, of which a copy is attached, and of which the last paragraph should be corrected by substituting Commerce Sub-Commission for Transportation Sub-Commission.

2. Regional Transportation Officers should report to the Regional Supply Accountant each month the numbers and classes of Tyres and Tubes sold by them to civilians. All cash collected in connection with such sales should be deposited in AFM No 1 Account and reported to the Regional Supply Accountant. The responsibility for collection will be that of Regional Transportation Officers. Sales to Motor Truck Pools for purposes of Accounting should be treated as sales to civilians.

This procedure will remain in force as long as the Transportation Sub-Commission and Regions remain responsible for distribution of Tyres and Tubes.

Reference our 5/9.2/CA dated 30 March 1945.

1. The question of the supply of tyres for the High Commissioner for Defascism is rather exceptional. Under the Armistice Terms the Italian Government has undertaken to destroy the Fascist regime and to remove fascists from positions of authority and this Commission is responsible to the respective Allied Governments to see that this is effectively done. Transport and other stores and facilities requisite for this purpose are, in fact, required by the Allied Commission for its function of ensuring that the Armistice Terms are carried out.
2. The Defascist Decrees which have been passed contain time limits within which action has to be taken. These time limits are running out and the progress made is not keeping pace. The Italian Government state that they are greatly hampered in making enquiries, both as to the suitability of persons for appointment to posts in the operation machine, and as regards conducting investigations against suspected persons, by lack of transport. In view of the relatively early expiration of these time limits, this lack of transport is of importance to the Allied Commission itself.
3. It is understood that a suggestion has been made that the High Commission should defer its demands until the Italian Government has been able to appoint a distributing agency for tyres and that it should then submit this request to that agency. It is further understood that there is little prospect of such agency having at an early date even a small amount of tyres for automobiles.
4. It is regretted therefore that this proposal cannot be regarded as satisfactory since this Commission has the duty of ensuring that defascism is *effected* and the tyres, which are essential to this purpose, would not be received in sufficient time.
5. May arrangements please be made as a matter of urgency for the issue of 11 tyres and tubes, size 600/16.

3. It is requested, therefore, that 11 tyre and tubes be made available immediately to the High Commissioner for Sanctions Against Fascism to enable his office to proceed with defascism activities and thus avoid the possibility of any added liability for the Public Safety Sub-Commission.

NOTE

On 19 February last the Civil Affairs Section of the Allied Commission assigned 4 tires for cars out of 20 which were requested from the Headquarters of Region IV with letters No. 16 AC/ 1667 of 6 and 24 November 1944.

More recently an authorization was granted to mount five jeep tires on the Mercedes 82796 which was requisitioned for this High Commission.

However, the problem of tires for cars assigned to this High Commission still remains to be solved; and it will become more serious with the coming of summer since the tubes, having been repaired already a number of times, will not withstand the heat and will burst.

TO : Economic Section

1. The request for tyres and tubes is becoming so pressing that, unless a decision be immediately arrived at regarding the method of allocating at least part of our limited availability, there is a possibility of grave repercussions in several of our activities.

2. In order to determine a firm basis for a priority schedule, a signal was sent out to all Regions requesting complete data on tyre requirements for civilian vehicles by amount and size. To date three Regions only have replied and of these only one reply (Sardinia) furnishes complete data.

3. The requests for tyres and tubes amount to 35,880 and 32,665 respectively. Availability is 2585 tyres and 2833 tubes. Various sizes are required but the only ones that we need consider for the moment are those for which we have any sizeable availability. These are as follows:

4. Agriculture Subcommittee states that it is in urgent need of 300 tyres and tubes in order to ensure the massing of oil.

Public Works and Utilities Subcommittee states that it is unable to carry out the repair and rehabilitation of powerhouses, bridges, etc., through lack of tyres for their vehicles and requests at least 100 tyres for cars and 100 tyres for trucks.

C.I.P. states that the delivery of petrol will be seriously impeded unless at least 25 600 x 16 tyres and tubes are made available to them.

Industry Subcommittee states that there is urgent need of meeting the requests of the I.S.R. in full, that it, insofar as sizes are available.

5. The importance of the work carried out by these four units seems to call for a special priority and it is therefore submitted that a special issue, once and for all, of 100 tyres be made to Agriculture, that the Public Works and Utilities receive 100 car tyres and 100 truck tyres, that C.I.P. receive 25 tyres, I.S.R. 40 tyres for cars and 5 tyres for trucks.

6. The balance of availability to be allocated as follows:

- a) 10% Emergency Reserve;
- b) 20% AS HQ Pool, including Ministries;
- c) 70% to Regions, Italian State Railways, ENAC.

The basis of allocation of the 70% balance to be the percentage of availability against demand, of each unit, which presumably reflects its immediate needs. The attached chart reflects certain modifications made at the request of ~~Industry~~ ^{Transportation} Subcommittee.

Regional Transportation officer to allocate his quota in relation to immediate needs.

7. Future availability from sources outside this theatre is given as 14,556 tyres and 15,367 tubes of various sizes, but no advice has been received as to shipment.

Pirelli Factory at Tivoli are ready to start manufacture of tyres and tubes as soon as a continuous flow of necessary materials is assured. The estimated daily output is 10 tyres per day gradually increasing to 200 per day over a period of 2-1/2 months.

8. Exhaustive data are being sought from the Regions as to number of cars and trucks licensed in each province, category of users, etc., but it will be appreciated that this information will not be obtainable at this Hq for some weeks.
