Reference telephonic conversation 30 April 45 (Major PALMIDRI Lieut BANNO) MALAPARTE CURZIO BUCKERT imprisoned 22 March 45 at request of Provincial Epuration Delegation and charged with violation article 3 of Law 27 7 1944. MALAPARTE released night 22 March 45 by Major NIOT (A) and Lieut TURNER and Captain DE GIBANI (RCC) purporting to be acting on orders of Colonel COMMING Asst Chief of staff, Q-2 PBS MAIN. Avv MANGINI Provincial Epuration Commissioner claims to have objected to release of MALAPARTE. Investigation is being completed by Public Safety Section in connection with another matter and complete report will be made to Public Safety Sub Commission

Dear Major Palmieri,

I can give you ~~some~~ exact information on the arrest and later release of the writer Curzio MALAPARTE.

The arrest was effected by order of the deputy Procuratore of the Kingdom Savarese under Art 3 of DL 159 of 27 Jul 1944. Savarese interrogated Malaparte and later ordered his transfer to the judicial jails of Naples.

The release was imposed by Major FIOT of CIC of Naples in spite of the opposition of Mr. Mancini, delegate of the High Commission for sanctions against fascism. The intervention of Col. Simpson, Regional Officer of the Province of Naples was useless.

I have been told that Malaparte has stated, not according to the truth, that his arrest had been determined by the charge of having killed a partisan in Florence. This statement was unfounded because, as I said above, the arrest had been determined under Art 3 of the Decree on sanctions against fascism for actions carried out in the years 1920-1925 which appear to be proved by his own admission in the newspaper "La conquista dello Stato" in 1926.

It seems that Col CAMPING of the Allied troops in Leghorn was very much concerned with the release of Malaparte.

If I will be in possess of further information I shall forward them to you.

I would like to know, however, which data, if any, besides the above mentioned, may be of interest to you.

Caro Maggiore,

Sono in grado di darle alcune informazioni abbastanza precise sull'arresto e il successivo rilascio dello scrittore Tazio Malaparte.

L'arresto venne disposto su mandato del sostituto Procuratore del Regno Severese, in base all'art. 3 della legge 27 luglio 1944, n. 159. Il severese interrogò il Mal parte e, successivamente, lo fece tradurre alle carceri giudiziarie di Napoli.

La scarcerazione venne imposta dal Maggiore Fiat del P.I.C. di Napoli, nonostante l'opposizione dell'avv. Mancini, delegato alla Alta Commissione per le nomine contro il fascismo. Inattualmente intervenne il Col. Dugazon, capo regionale della Provincia di Napoli.

Vi si dice che il Malaparte abbia, contro verità, affermato che l'arresto suo era stato determinato dalla imputazione di aver ucciso un partigiano a Firenze. L'affermazione non aveva base in quanto l'arresto, come ho precisato, era stato determinato in base all'art. 3 della legge sulle sanzioni contro il fascismo per azioni espletate dal Mal parte tra il 1936 ed il 1935 e che mi si dice risultasse da una sua lettera inviata merittà sul giornale "Le conqui-
