SUBJECT: Civilian Movement.

TO : P.O., Florence.

1. Permission has been granted by the competent military authorities for the withdrawal as from midnight on the 24th November of the existing restrictions on civilian movement within the City of Florence and that part of Florence Province which lies south of the River Arno.

2. You should accordingly take immediate action by means of a Local Order to inform the public that within this area the provisions of Proc. No. 1, Art. V, para 46 will no longer apply and that (subject to the next following paragraph) civilians will be permitted to circulate without requiring a pass.

3. A pass will still be required by any civilian who proposes:

- (a) to travel from the City of Florence or the southern part of Florence Province into any other Province.
- (b) to travel from the southern part of Florence Province into that part of Florence Province which lies north of the River Arno (other than the City of Florence) irrespective of the distance involved.
- (c) to travel within that part of Florence Province which lies north of the River Arno (including the City of Florence) a distance of more than 10 Kms. beyond his own home.

4. The Order should not be posted anywhere north of the River Arno except within the City of Florence.

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5. In order that there may be no delay in the issue of the proposed Order, authority is hereby given to proceed without further reference to this HQ. Copies of the Order should, however, be forwarded to this HQ in due course for purposes of record.

6. Your Public Safety Officer will take the necessary steps to assist security agencies in the reorganization of check posts to conform with the above arrangements.

Joint Chiefs of Staff request your views on application of American Commission for protection and salvage of artistic and historic monuments in war areas for their representatives to proceed to ROME.

The Commission has authorized Doctor WILLIAM HELL DINSMORE to represent it in ROME and desires that he be accompanied by his wife ZILLAH PIERCE DINSMORE and Secretary KATHLEEN MARY SPRINGER. It is believed Doctor DINSMORE was in ROME as representative of the Commission during June 1944. He states he is acting Director of American Academy in ROME and proposes to use the Academy in cooperation with MFAA Officers of the Subcommittee for monuments, fine arts and archives of the ACC; cooperating with relief agents in case of creation of relief labor projects involving restoration of cultural monuments and cooperating with armed forces in any way possible.

He advises also that he has indorsement of Division of Cultural Operation of State Department and Major General FREDERICK H OSBORNE.
